- **Parque Aiken del Sur** — Explore this private 250-hectare reserve with native forests, waterfalls, and well-marked hiking trails just 15 minutes...
- **Río Simpson National Reserve** — Drive through dramatic river gorges and visit the reserve's visitor center, waterfalls, and Patagonian birdlife about...
- **Laguna San Rafael Glacier** — Cruise by catamaran through fjords to the iconic San Rafael Glacier, a UNESCO site, with opportunities for close-up...
- **Coyhaique & Puerto Aysén** — Visit the regional hub of Coyhaique for local crafts and cuisine, plus the historic suspension bridge at nearby Puerto...

BEST WALKS

- **Coastal Promenade** Easy — A relaxing walk along the waterfront, offering views of the Pacific Ocean and surrounding mountains.
- **Town Center Loop** Moderate — A short walk through the residential areas and local markets of Puerto Chacabuco.
- **Nature Trail** Easy — A walk through the outskirts of town into the surrounding greenery.
