TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Tortuguero Canals Boat Safari** — Glide through jungle waterways spotting caimans, monkeys, toucans, and sloths from a small boat.
- **Rainforest Aerial Tram & Zip Line** — Ride a gondola through the canopy of a private rainforest reserve, with optional zip lines and guided nature walks...
- **Sloth Sanctuary Visit** — Meet rescued two- and three-toed sloths up close at a working sanctuary along the Estrella River, with a gentle canoe...
- **Cahuita National Park & Beach** — A coastal rainforest park where jungle trails meet white-sand Caribbean beaches — easy wildlife spotting (howler...

BEST WALKS

- **Parque Vargas & seafront** ~1.5 km · 1 hr · easy — The town's leafy central park, famous for the sloths that sometimes hang in its trees, leading along the Caribbean seafront promenade...
- **Mercado Central** ~1 km · 45 min · easy — Limón's bustling covered market — tropical fruit, spices, and local Caribbean food.
- **Playa Bonita** ~4 km / short taxi · 1–2 hrs · easy — A pretty palm-fringed beach just west of town, popular with locals — best reached by a quick taxi if you want sand close to the ship.

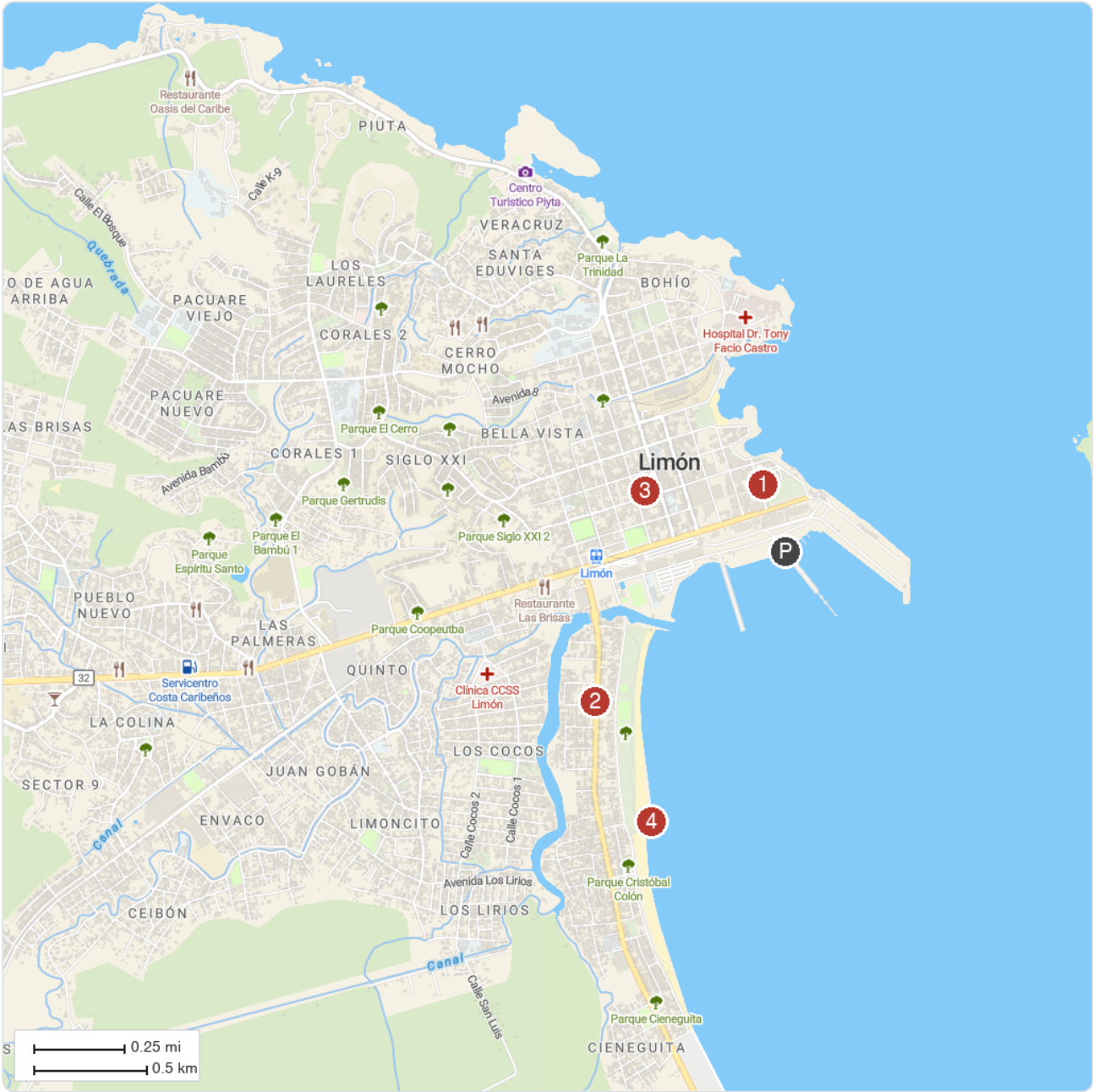
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Book a wildlife tour — that's the point. Limón town has little for sightseeing; the rainforest, canals, and sloths inland are what make this port special.
- Expect rain, embrace it. This is true rainforest — sudden downpours are normal even in dry season. A light rain jacket and quick-dry clothes beat an umbrella.
- Bring insect repellent. Jungle and canal tours mean mosquitoes — pack repellent and wear light long sleeves for the boat rides.
