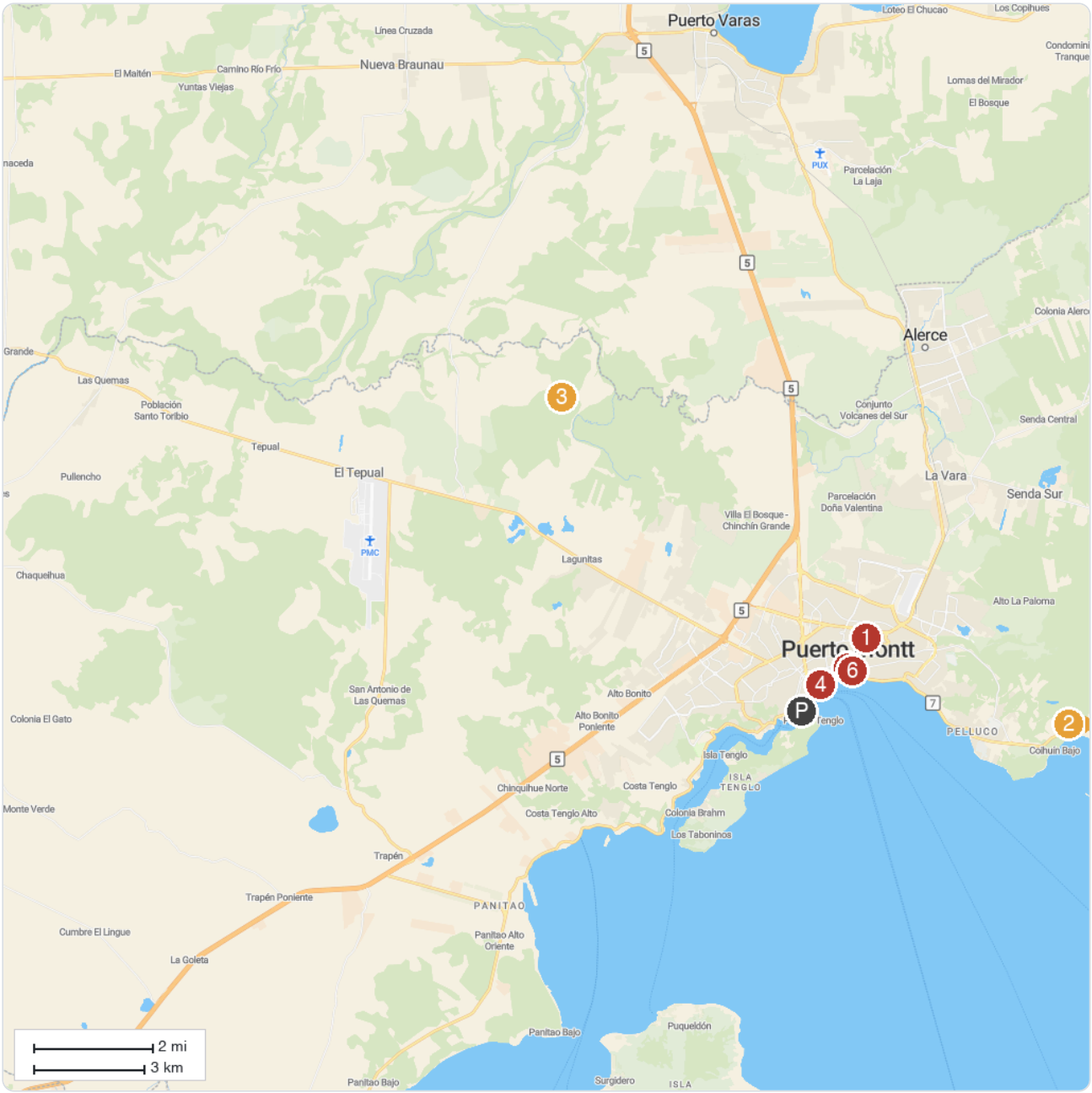
## KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
