GETTING ASHORE

- Docking:** Pier — ships dock directly at cruise terminal, no tender
- Best For:** Colonial Antigua, volcano hikes, Mayan archaeology
- Walk to Center:** Terminal only; no walkable town — taxis/tours needed
- Don't Miss:** Antigua Guatemala — UNESCO World Heritage colonial city

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Antigua Guatemala** — Guatemala's showpiece colonial city is a UNESCO World Heritage site packed with cobblestone streets, crumbling...
- **Pacaya Volcano Hike** — One of Central America's most accessible active volcanoes, Pacaya lets you walk to within meters of lava flows.
- **Iximché Mayan Ruins** — The former capital of the Kaqchikel Maya kingdom, Iximché is less visited than Tikal but equally atmospheric — ancient...
- **Antigua + Coffee Plantation** — Combine a walk through Antigua with a visit to a working coffee finca in the highlands, learning how Guatemala's famous...
- **Mangrove Kayaking** — Paddle through coastal mangrove channels near the port, spotting birds, crocodiles, and marine life.

BEST WALKS

- **Terminal Market Stroll** 30 min · Flat · Free — Within the cruise terminal complex you'll find a covered handicrafts market with Guatemalan textiles, jade, wooden masks, and coffee.

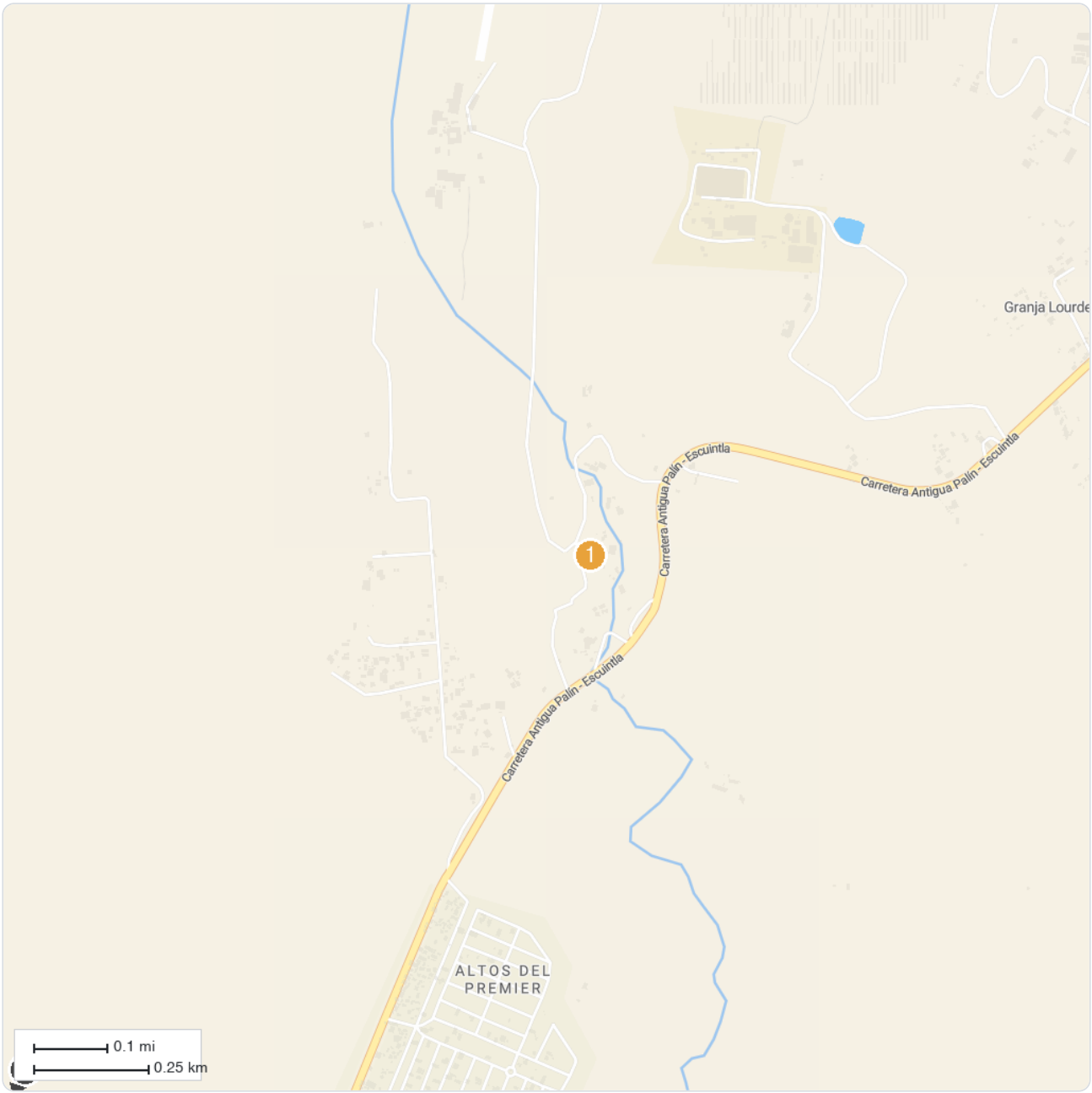
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Allow time for Antigua's traffic. The 90 km drive can stretch to 2 hours each way. Don't try to cram Antigua into a 6-hour call — you'll feel rushed.
- Tikal is not a day-trip option. It's 11+ hours each way by road. If Tikal is on your bucket list, add a pre- or post-cruise land extension.
