

Puerto Williams, Isla Navarino, Chile

The world's southernmost city sits on Isla Navarino, across the Beagle Channel from Argentina — a wind-scoured frontier town of 3,000 souls, fresh king crab, and the last stop before Cape Horn and Antarctica.

-  Pier (new dock, small-ship focus)
-  Typical call: 6-8 hrs
-  Chilean Peso (CLP) — one ATM, carry cash
-  Spanish (little English outside museum)
-  Sub-Antarctic: cold and windy year-round

GETTING ASHORE

- Docking:** New multipurpose pier — 150m access bridge + 130m berthing head (Phase 1 complete); large ships may still anchor and tender
- Walk to Centre:** 10-15 min flat walk from pier to Plaza de Armas (~1 km)
- Best For:** Expedition cruisers, history buffs, Yahgan culture, Antarctica homeport
- Don't Miss:** Centolla (king crab), Martin Gusinde Museum, Micalvi yacht club bar

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Martin Gusinde Anthropological Museum** — One of South America's finest small museums, detailing the Yahgan people who survived sub-Antarctic conditions with... explore miniature forests of mosses...
- **Cerro Bandera Hike** — A strenuous 3-4 hour round-trip climb above town leads to a Chilean flag and sweeping views of the Beagle Channel...
- **Yelcho Monument & Micalvi Yacht Club** — See the replica bow of the Chilean Navy tug Yelcho that rescued Shackleton's crew from Elephant Island in 1916 (the...)
- **Omora Ethnobotanical Park** — About 4 km west of town, Omora is famous for 'tourism with a hand lens' — visitors
- **Centolla (Southern King Crab) Lunch** — Puerto Williams is one of the best places on Earth to eat fresh centolla pulled from the Beagle Channel.

BEST WALKS

- **Waterfront & Town Loop** 1.5 km · 25-30 min · Easy · Flat — From the pier, walk the Costanera (waterfront road) west past the Yelcho monument and Micalvi to the Plaza de Armas, then cut through...
- **Villa Ukika Walk** 2 km one-way · Easy · Flat gravel road — A short walk east of town leads to Villa Ukika, a small settlement where descendants of the Yahgan people live.
