- **Pula Arena & Roman Monuments Walk** — Enter one of the world's best-preserved Roman amphitheaters, explore its underground gladiator galleries, then follow...
- **Istrian Truffle & Wine Experience** — Head into the Istrian hills to taste black and white truffles paired with local Malvazija white wine and Teran red.
- **Verudela Peninsula Beaches** — Hop a city bus or taxi to the Verudela Peninsula for Ambrela Beach (pine shade, sunbeds, cafes) and the photogenic...
- **Rovinj & Istrian Coastal Towns** — If your call is long enough, a guided trip to the beautifully preserved fishing town of Rovinj — with its colorful...
- **Coastal Cycling & Kayaking** — Rent e-bikes near the port and ride the flat Lungomare coastal path to quiet coves, or book a sea kayaking tour around...

BEST WALKS

- **Roman Monuments Loop** 1.5 km · 45–60 min · Easy — Walk from the Riva waterfront to the Arena, then wind up through the old town past the Arch of the Sergii, Forum Square and the Temple...
- **Market & Hidden Mosaic Stroll** 1 km · 30 min · Easy — From Forum Square, detour to the 1903 iron-and-glass Pula Green Market for local olive oil, truffle products, and fresh figs.

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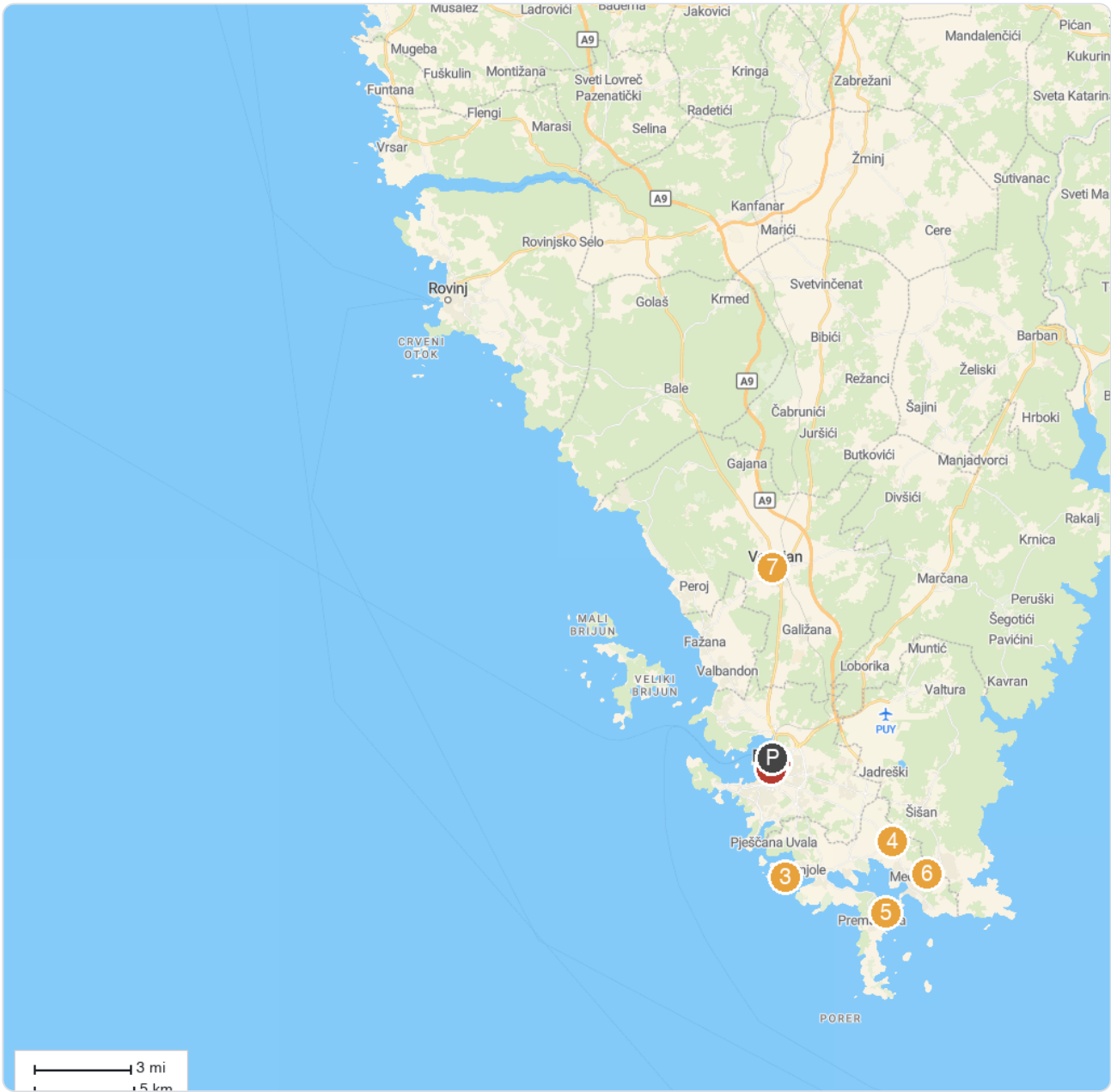
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
