GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Two pier terminals: Porto Malai (south) and Langkawi Cruise Terminal near Kuah; most large ships dock directly

Best For: Nature lovers, duty-free shoppers, beach days, and cable-car thrill-seekers

Walk to center: Porto Malai: 5 min to Resorts World complex; Kuah Jetty: 10 min walk to Eagle Square and town

Don't Miss: Langkawi SkyCab & Sky Bridge on Gunung Machinchang and a mangrove kayak in Kilim Karst Geoforest Park

 Getting around:  **Taxi**  RM 80–100 (~\$17–22 USD) to Kuah Town ·  **Rideshare**  Grab

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Langkawi SkyCab & Sky Bridge** — Ride one of the world's steepest cable cars to the summit of Gunung Machinchang (708 m), then walk the 125 m curved Sky...
- **Kilim Karst Mangrove Tour** — Boat through the UNESCO-listed Kilim Karst Geoforest Park past limestone sea caves, watch wild eagles snatch fish...
- **Pantai Cenang Beach Day** — Langkawi's most popular beach is about 15 minutes from the cruise terminals.
- **Island Hopping** — A classic Langkawi half-day: speedboat to Dayang Bunting Marble Geoforest Park to swim in the freshwater Lake of the...
- **Kuah Town & Eagle Square Walk** — Eagle Square (Dataran Lang) is a 5-minute walk from Kuah Jetty — a giant eagle sculpture overlooking the sea, flanked...

BEST WALKS

- **Kuah Waterfront & Eagle Square Stroll** 1–1.5 hrs | Easy | From Kuah Jetty terminal — Walk south from the Kuah Jetty terminal along the waterfront promenade to Eagle Square (Dataran Lang), where a monumental eagle statue...
- **Porto Malai Waterfront Walk** 30–45 min | Easy | From Porto Malai terminal — A casual stroll along the Porto Malai waterfront adjacent to Resorts World Langkawi, with views over the straits toward Thailand.

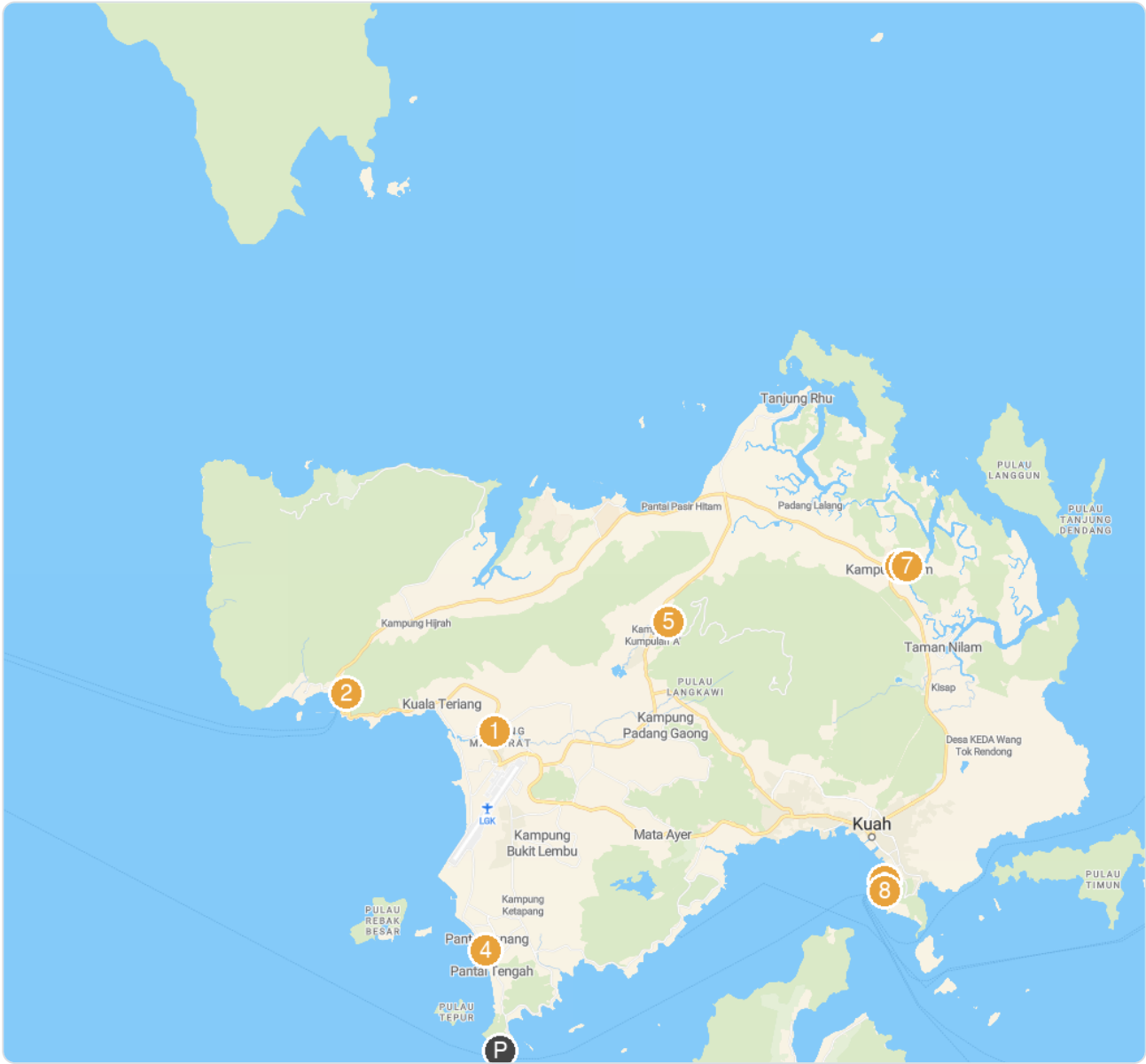
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
