- **City Center Shopping & Dining** — Explore the high-end boutiques and gourmet restaurants in the center of Punta del Este, known for its luxury and...

BEST WALKS

- **Beachfront Promenade Walk** Walk from the port along the coast of Playa Brava, enjoying the ocean breeze and the high-end architecture. — A relaxing stroll that takes you from the port to the iconic 'Los Fingers' sculpture.
- **City Center Exploration** Walk through the main shopping streets and visit the local markets. — A guided walk through the heart of the city's luxury shopping district.
- **Casapueblo Walk** Explore the white-washed walls of the museum and the surrounding cliffs. — A walk through the art gallery and the surrounding nature reserve.

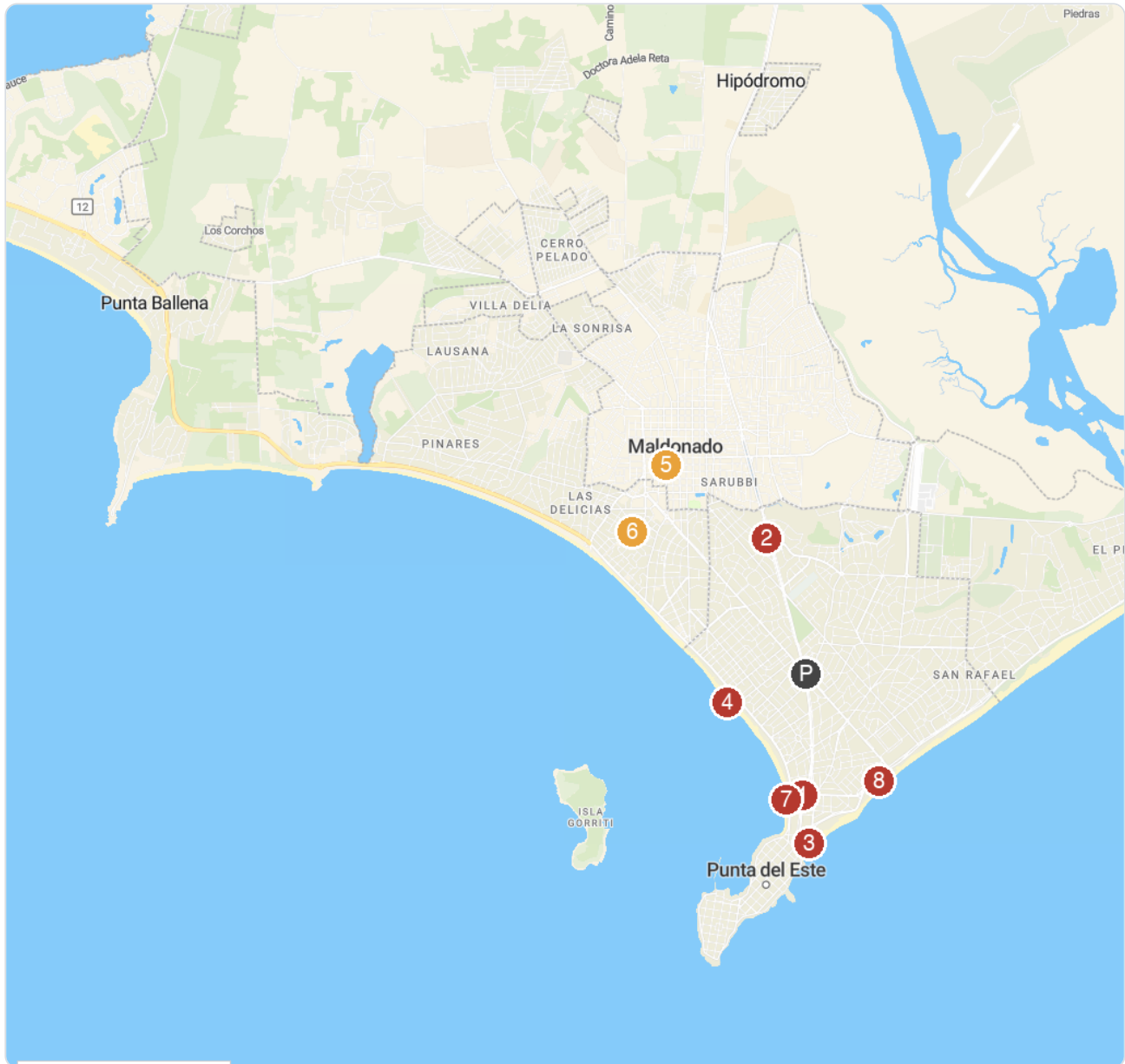
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
