TOP THINGS TO DO

- Stone and Man carvings walk** — A guided walk through the town to see the unique stone carvings and the 'Man' carvings, which are whimsical and...
- Fjord Cruise to the Icebergs** — A boat trip from the harbor into the surrounding fjords to witness massive icebergs drifting from the glaciers.
- Hiking to the Overlook** — A trek up the rocky hills surrounding the town to get a panoramic view of the colorful houses and the surrounding fjord...
- Visit the Local Museum** — Explore the history of the South Greenlandic people and the traditional hunting and fishing practices of the region.

BEST WALKS

- The Artistic Path** Art & Culture — Follow the signs for the stone carvings, which are integrated into the town's natural rock formations.
- The Harbor Walk** Shopping & Dining — Stroll along the waterfront to visit local craft shops and enjoy a coffee at a local cafe.
- The Hilltop View** Nature & Views — A short but steep climb to the highest point in town for a breathtaking view of the colorful houses below.

- Don't miss the Stone and Man open-air sculptures scattered throughout town — a 1990s project by local artist Aka Høegh.
- Visit Mindebrønden, Greenland's only public fountain, at Torvet square — carved from sandstone with bronze whales.
- Step inside Qaqortoq Museum, housed in the town's oldest building (1804), next to the fountain.
