GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Ross Gaudreault Terminal (Quai 21/22) or Terminal 30 — both dockside, no tender

Best For: History, architecture, French-Canadian food, scenic walks

Walk to centre: 5-10 min walk to Place Royale / Petit Champlain in Lower Town; funicular or stairs to Upper Town

Don't Miss: Terrasse Dufferin at sunset and a poutine in the Old City

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Old Quebec Walking Tour** — Wander the cobblestone streets of UNESCO-listed Vieux-Québec: Place Royale, the Funicular, Terrasse Dufferin, and the...
- **Montmorency Falls** — At 83 m (272 ft), Montmorency Falls is 30 m taller than Niagara.
- **Plains of Abraham** — Battlefields Park was the site of the decisive 1759 battle between British and French forces.
- **Île d'Orléans** — Cross the bridge to this rural island in the St.
- **Sainte-Anne-de-Beaupré Shrine** — One of North America's oldest pilgrimage sites, this spectacular basilica about 35 km east of the city is adorned with...

BEST WALKS

- **Lower Town Loop: Waterfront to Place Royale** 1.5 km · 30-45 min · Easy (flat) — From the terminal, walk the Promenade Samuel-De Champlain along the St.
- **Upper Town: Château Frontenac & the Walls** 2.5 km · 1-1.5 hrs · Moderate (uphill) — Take the Funicular up from Petit Champlain to Dufferin Terrace, beside the Château Frontenac.

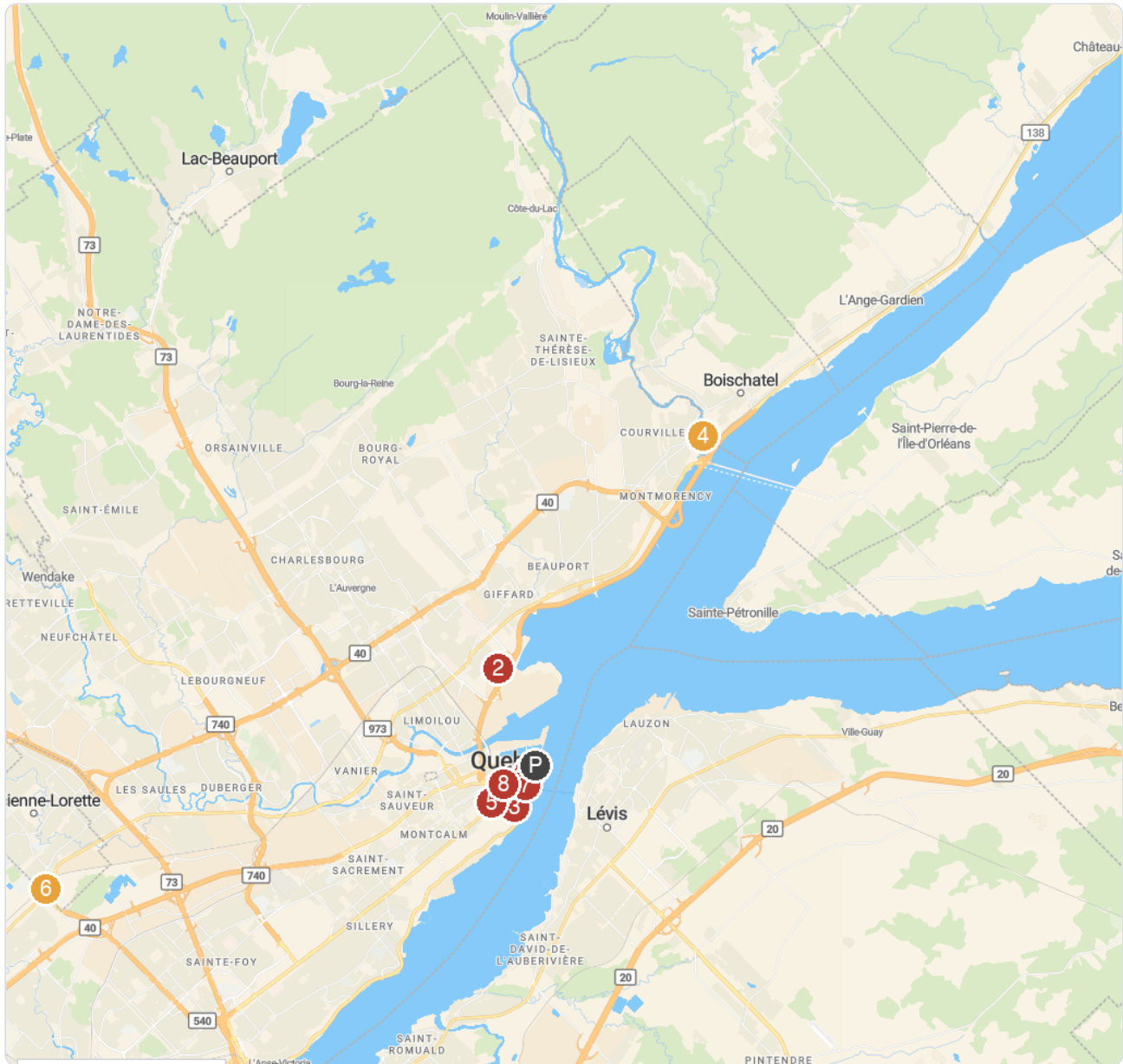
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Cash in CAD: Most places accept credit cards, but small vendors and market stalls in Petit Champlain prefer cash. ATMs are available at the terminal and throughout the Old City.
- Wear your best walking shoes: Cobblestones and steep inclines are everywhere between Lower and Upper Town. Heels are a bad idea — leave them on the ship.
