TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Ravenna UNESCO Mosaic Walking Tour** — A guided sweep through the greatest hits: Basilica of San Vitale, Mausoleum of Galla Placidia, Neonian Baptistery, and...
- **Basilica of Sant'Apollinare in Classe** — About 5 km south of the city, this isolated 6th-century basilica has a stunning apse mosaic in an almost empty nave...
- **Emilian Food & Wine Experience** — Emilia-Romagna is Italy's culinary heartland.
- **City by Bicycle** — Ravenna is pancake-flat and bike-mad — locals cycle everywhere.
- **Bologna Day Trip** — Italy's underrated food capital is about 75 km away (roughly 1 hr by train from Ravenna station).

BEST WALKS

- **The Mosaic Circuit** 3 km · 2-3 hrs · Easy — The classic self-guided loop hitting the main mosaic sites.
- **Piazza to Dante Stroll** 1.5 km · 30 min · Easy — A short walk from the central square through the medieval streets to Dante's Tomb and the flooded crypt of San Francesco.

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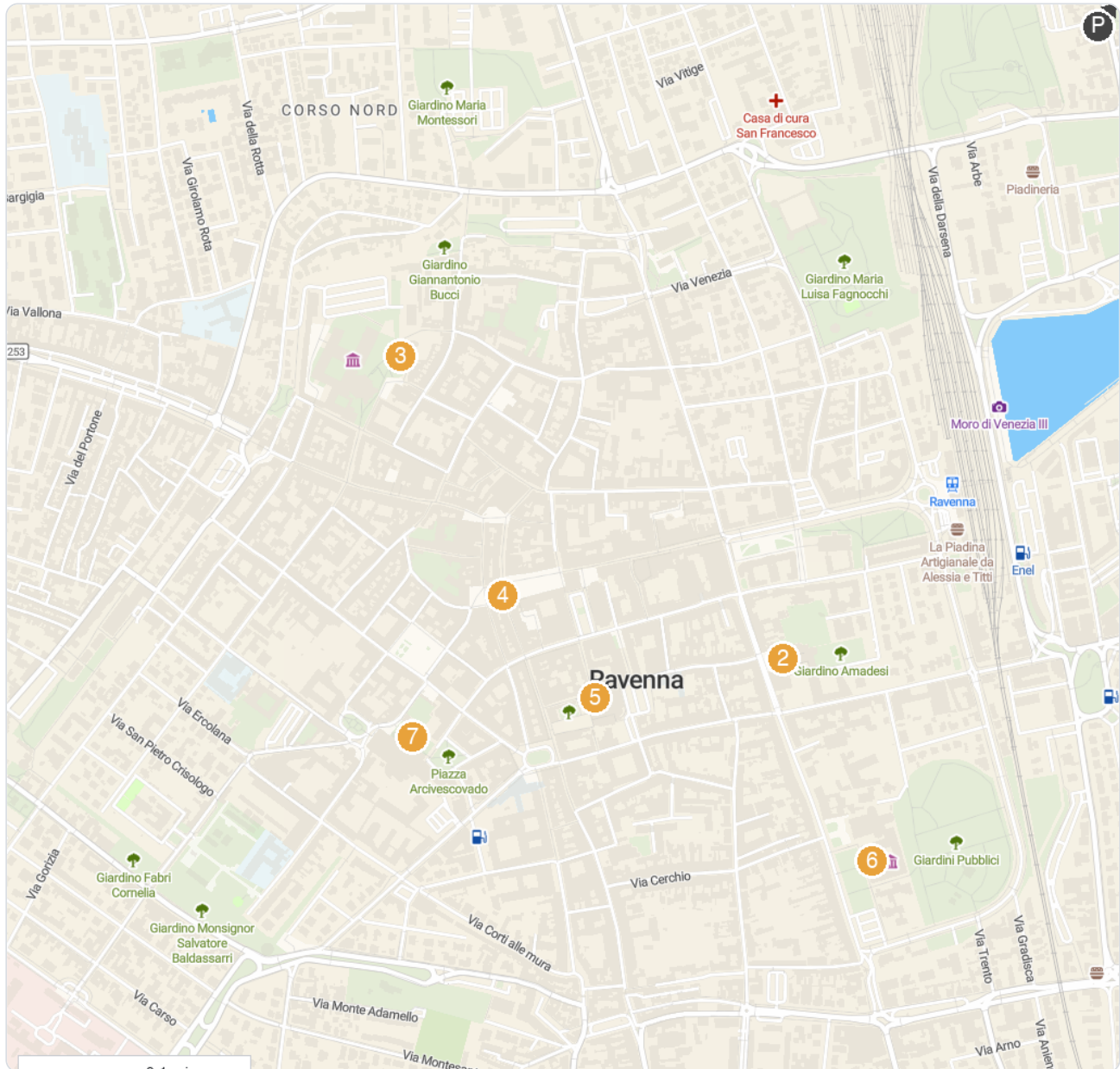
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Buy the combined pass. The 5-site Ravenna pass (≈€14.50) covers San Vitale, Galla Placidia, Sant'Apollinare Nuovo, the Neonian Baptistery, and the Archiepiscopal Museum — the only...
- Cover up for the basilicas. Shoulders and knees must be covered to enter any of the mosaic churches. Bring a scarf or light layer — the dress code is enforced.
- Book the ship's shuttle early. The cruise line shuttle is the easiest way to town but fills up fast. Alternatively, the public bus (Line 90)
