- **Boa Viagem Beach** — Recife's long urban beach with reef-protected pools and a palm-lined promenade — a relaxed swim and a coconut (mind the...
- **Frevo & Carnival Culture** — Recife and Olinda are the home of frevo, the frenetic carnival dance — visit the Paço do Frevo museum or catch a street...

BEST WALKS

- **Recife Antigo loop** ~2 km · 1.5 hrs · easy — From Marco Zero square along restored Rua do Bom Jesus past the first synagogue in the Americas and colorful colonial buildings of the...
- **Olinda hill climb** ~2 km · 1.5 hrs · moderate (hilly) — Up Olinda's cobbled lanes past the Sé cathedral and São Bento monastery to the Alto da Sé viewpoint over the coast — best by taxi up...
- **Boa Viagem promenade** ~2.5 km · 1 hr · easy — The palm-lined beachfront promenade of Recife's main beach — joggers, kiosks, and reef pools at low tide.

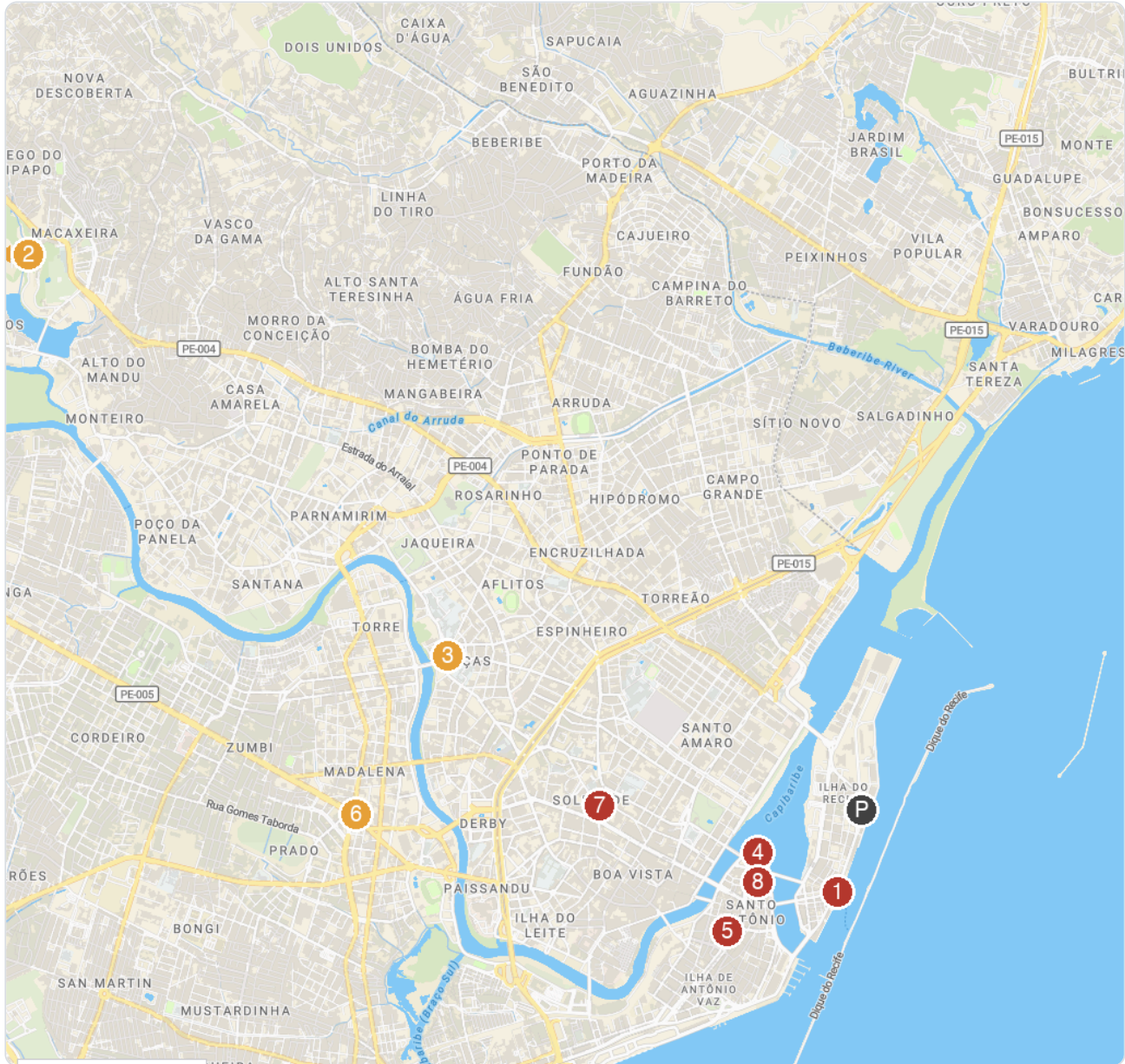
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
