TOP THINGS TO DO

- Museu do Douro** — The region's top museum sits steps from the pier in the historic Casa da Companhia.
- Quinta Wine Tasting** — Several prestigious estates sit within a 10-minute taxi ride.
- Douro Historic Train to Tua** — On select weekends (June–Oct), the restored Douro Historic Train runs from Régua along the river to Tua, hauled by a...
- Lamego & the Sanctuary Staircase** — Fifteen minutes by taxi, Lamego is a baroque gem crowned by the Sanctuary of Nossa Senhora dos Remédios with its famous...
- Miradouro de São Leonardo de Galafura** — One of the finest viewpoints in the entire Douro Valley, about 20 minutes from town by taxi.

BEST WALKS

- Riverfront & Railway Station Walk** 1.5 km · 20–30 min · Flat · Free — From the pier, follow the Ecopista riverfront promenade east to the Régua railway station (10 min).
- Town Centre & Museu do Douro** 1 km · 15–20 min · Easy · ~€6 museum — Head directly from the pier to the Museu do Douro (5 min walk) for wine history and a riverside tasting.

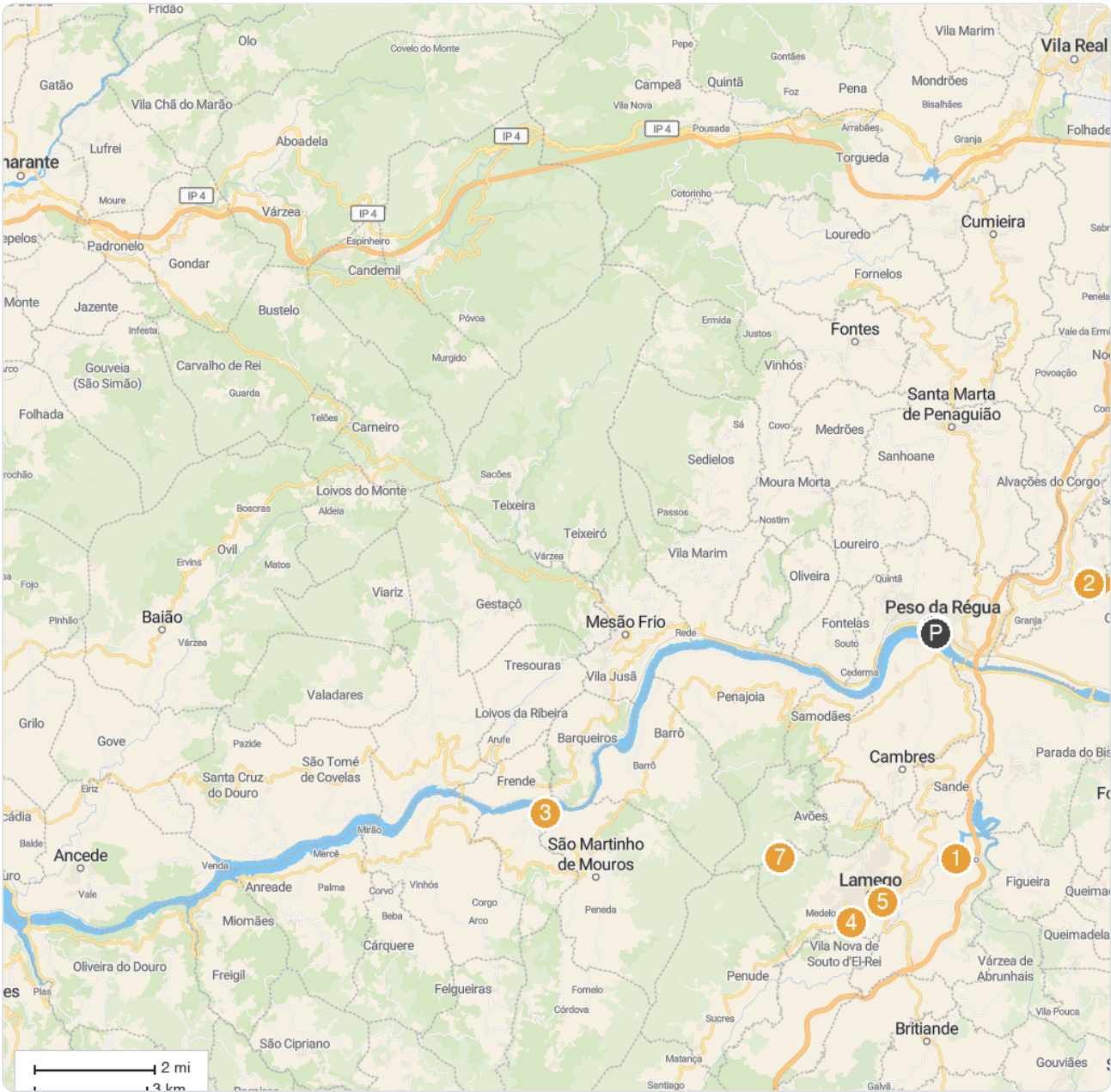
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Summer heat is serious. The Douro Valley regularly hits 38–42°C in July–August. Bring a hat, sunscreen, and water before leaving the ship.
- Buy wine to ship, not carry. Most quintas and wine shops in Régua offer international shipping — don't struggle with heavy bottles
