

Reine, Lofoten, Norway

One of the world's most photographed villages, Reine sits at the foot of jagged granite peaks in Norway's Lofoten archipelago — a compact gem of red fishermen's cabins, turquoise fjords, and world-class hiking above the Arctic Circle.

GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tender only — ships anchor in the fjord; tenders land at the small harbor pontoon in the village center

Best For: Dramatic scenery photography, Reinebringen hike, fjord boat cruises, Arctic seafood

Walk to Center: Steps off the tender — you arrive directly in the village

Don't Miss: Reinebringen summit views, Sakrisøy yellow cabins, Anita's Sjømat fishburger

Getting around: **Taxi** NOK 230–440 (~\$22–\$42) for short regional trips · **Rideshare** not available

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Reinebringen Hike** — Lofoten's most iconic hike: roughly 1,970 Sherpa-built stone steps to a summit with sweeping views over Reine and the...
- Reinefjord Boat Cruise** — Classic or electric boat tour into the inner Reinefjord, gliding past sheer mountain walls to reach roadless hamlets...
- Sea Kayaking the Fjord** — Guided kayak tours depart directly from Reine harbor, offering a water-level perspective of the soaring granite peaks...
- Bunes Beach via Ferry** — Take a local ferry from Reine to roadless Vindstad (20 min), then hike 45 minutes over an easy pass to a vast...
- Norwegian Fishing Village Museum (Å)** — The village of Å, 10 km south, is a preserved 19th-century fishing community with a cod-liver oil factory, a bakery...

BEST WALKS

- Village Stroll & Sakrisøy** 3 km · ~45 min one-way · Easy — Walk from the tender pier through Reine's red rorbu cabins and across the bridges to Sakrisøy, where the cabins are painted vivid...
- Reinebringen Trailhead Walk** 1.5 km · ~20 min · Easy flat approach — From the tender pier, follow the path along the E10 (with a pedestrian tunnel bypass) to reach the base of the Reinebringen trail.

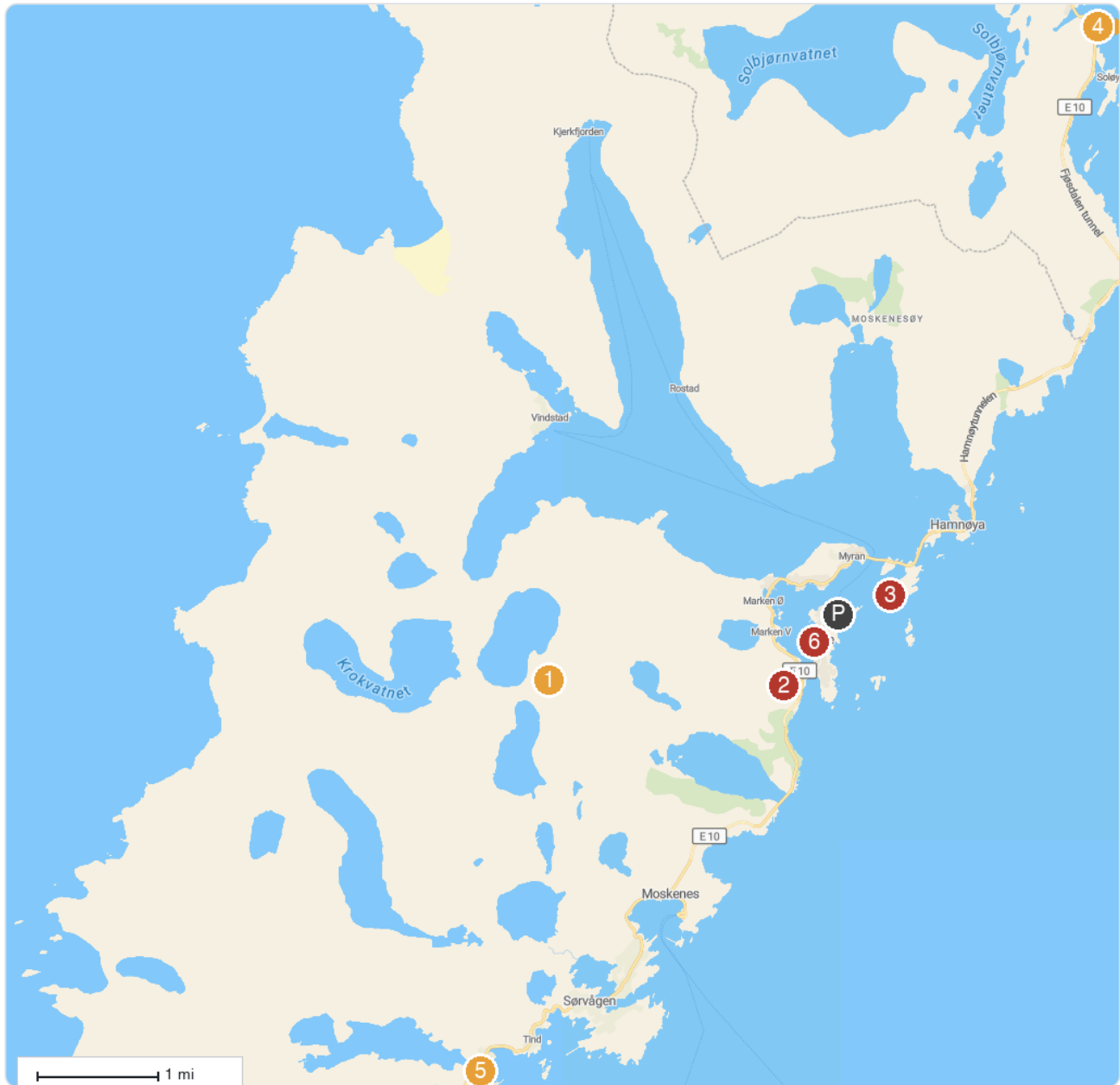
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
