- Golden Circle** — Iceland's classic trio: the erupting Strokkur geyser, the thundering Gullfoss waterfall, and Þingvellir National Park...
- Blue Lagoon Geothermal Spa** — Soak in milky-blue, mineral-rich geothermal water amid a black-lava landscape near the airport.
- Whale Watching from the Old Harbour** — Head into Faxaflói Bay to spot minke and humpback whales, white-beaked dolphins, and puffins (in season) — departing...
- South Coast Waterfalls & Black Sand** — A longer run to the Seljalandsfoss and Skógafoss waterfalls and the dramatic Reynisfjara black-sand beach — Iceland's...

BEST WALKS

- Old Harbour to Hallgrímskirkja** ~3 km · 1.5–2 hrs · easy — From the harbour past the mirror-clad Harpa concert hall and the Sun Voyager sculpture, up Skólavörðustígur's rainbow street to the...
- Tjörnin pond & city hall loop** ~2 km · 1 hr · easy — A gentle loop around the central pond, past the City Hall, the Settlement-era streets, and Austurvöllur square by the parliament and...
- Laugavegur shopping street** ~1.5 km · 1 hr · easy — The main downtown street — design shops, wool, cafés, and street art running through the lively heart of the capital.

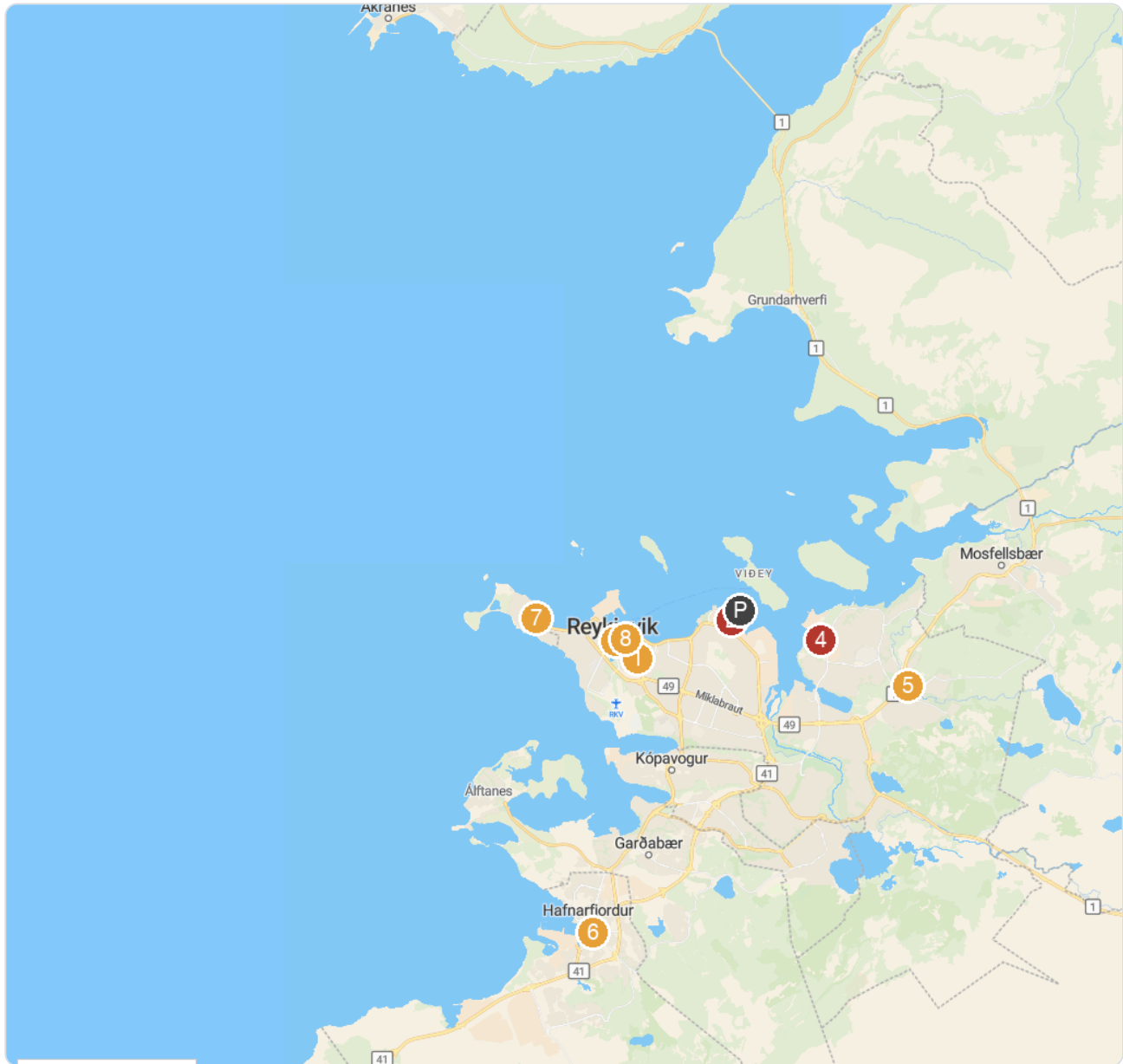
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
