TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Medieval Old Town Self-Walk** — The Old Town of Rhodes is a UNESCO World Heritage city of 200,000 sq m enclosed by 4 km of crusader walls.
- **Lindos Acropolis & Village** — The whitewashed clifftop village of Lindos, 50 km south, has an ancient acropolis with a Doric Temple of Athena and...
- **Valley of the Butterflies (Petaloudes)** — From late June through August, thousands of Jersey tiger moths mass in this lush valley about 26 km southwest of Rhodes...
- **Catamaran Cruise to Anthony Quinn Bay** — Anthony Quinn Bay (Vagies Bay), named after the actor who fell in love with the island filming 'The Guns of Navarone,'...
- **Archaeological Museum of Rhodes** — Housed in the original Hospital of the Knights of St.

BEST WALKS

- **Freedom Gate** → **Street of the Knights** → **Palace of Grand Masters** ~1.2 km · 30–45 min · easy — The spine of the medieval city.
- **Old Town Loop** — **Jewish Quarter & Turkish Quarter** ~2 km · 1–1.5 hrs · easy — From Hippocrates Square (the commercial heart) head south to the Kahal Shalom Synagogue — the oldest in Greece, still active — then...
- **Mandraki & the New Town waterfront** ~2 km · 45 min · easy — If you've had enough medieval cobblestones, the Mandraki waterfront has a pleasant promenade past the three bronze deer, the Windmills...
