TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Old Town Walking Tour** — The UNESCO core — the House of the Blackheads, Town Hall Square, Dome Cathedral, St.
- **Art Nouveau District** — The world's greatest concentration of Jugendstil architecture, centered on Alberta iela — a riot of sculpted faces...
- **Riga Central Market & Soviet History** — The vast market in former Zeppelin hangars, plus the Corner House and Occupation Museum telling Latvia's 20th-century...
- **Rundāle Palace** — A baroque 'Versailles of Latvia' with formal French gardens, about an hour south of Riga — a lavish day trip for palace...

BEST WALKS

- **Old town highlights loop** ~2.5 km · 1.5 hrs · easy — From the riverfront to Town Hall Square and the House of the Blackheads, past the Dome Cathedral, the Three Brothers, the Cat House...
- **Art Nouveau on Alberta iela** ~2 km · 1 hr · easy — A stroll up Elizabetes and Alberta streets to admire the most spectacular Jugendstil facades, ending at the Art Nouveau Museum.
- **Bastion Hill & canal** ~1.5 km · 1 hr · easy — The leafy park and canal ringing the old town, past the Freedom Monument and the Latvian National Opera.

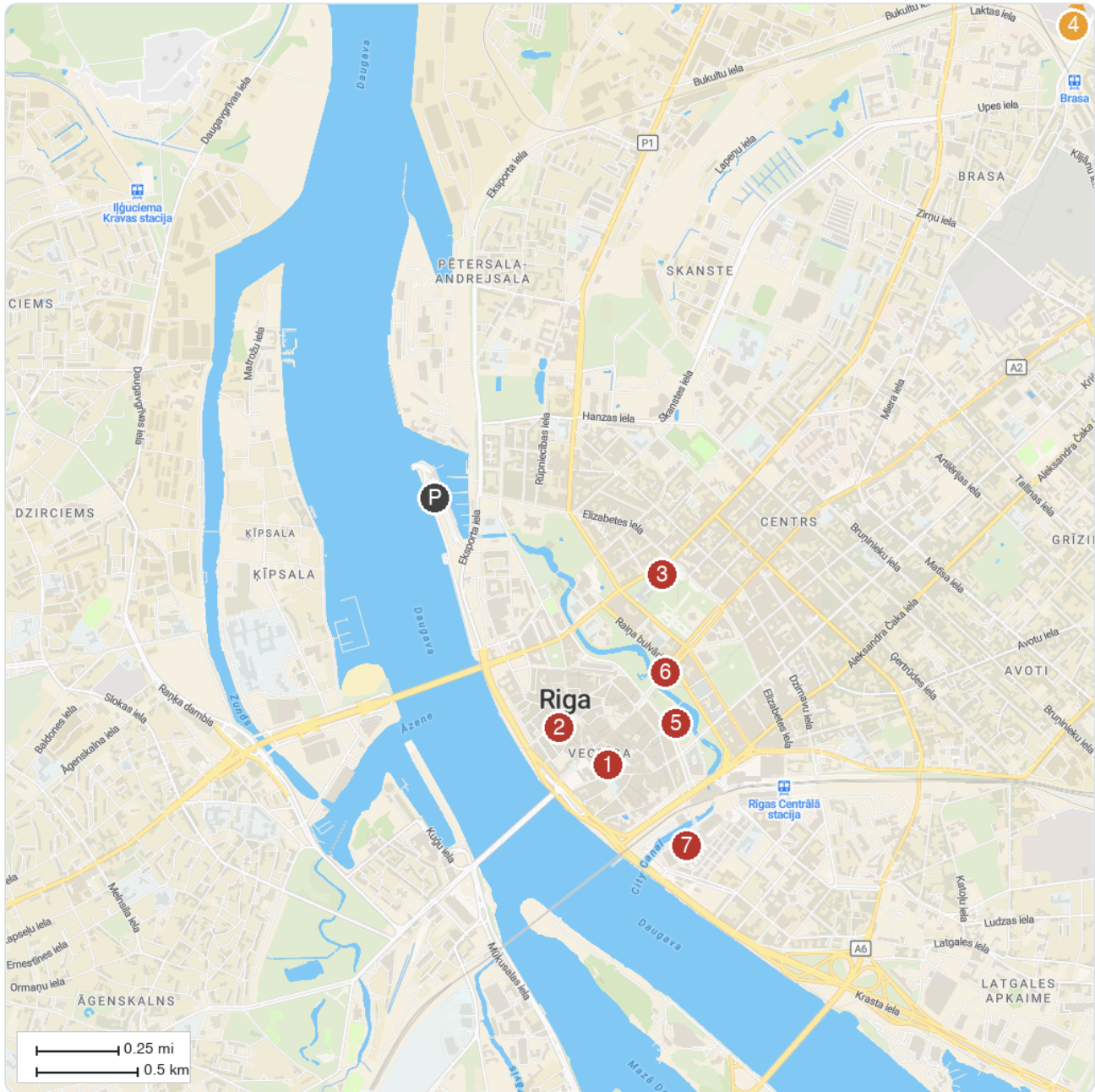
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- See both architectures. Riga's magic is the medieval old town plus the Art Nouveau quarter — do both for the full picture; they're a short walk apart.
- Visit the Central Market. Housed in old Zeppelin hangars, it's one of Europe's largest — a vivid, authentic stop near the old town.
- Euros and cards. Latvia uses the euro and is card-friendly; keep a little cash for the market and small cafés.
