TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Colosseum, Roman Forum & Palatine Hill** — The core of ancient Rome — the Colosseum's 50,000-seat arena, the ruined heart of the Forum, and the hilltop gardens of...
- **Vatican Museums & Sistine Chapel** — One of the world's great museum complexes ends in Michelangelo's Sistine Chapel ceiling — stunning even with the crowds.
- **Trastevere & Campo de' Fiori Walk** — Rome's most atmospheric neighbourhood — cobblestone lanes, medieval churches, ivy-covered façades, and genuinely good...
- **Roman Food & Market Tour** — Explore Testaccio market — Rome's most authentic neighbourhood market — followed by cacio e pepe, supplì (fried rice)...
- **Borghese Gallery & Villa Borghese Gardens** — Rome's finest baroque sculpture collection — Bernini's Apollo and Daphne, Canova's Pauline Bonaparte — in a sun-dappled...

BEST WALKS

- **Ancient Rome: Colosseum to Capitoline Hill** 2–3 hrs · Moderate · Mostly flat with some steps — Start at the Colosseum, walk through the Roman Forum entrance, climb Palatine Hill for panoramic views, then descend to Capitoline...
- **The Centro Storico Loop: Pantheon to Campo de' Fiori** 1.5–2 hrs · Easy · Flat cobblestones — Rome's medieval heart — start at the Pantheon (still free to admire the exterior; small interior fee), walk south past Largo di Torre...

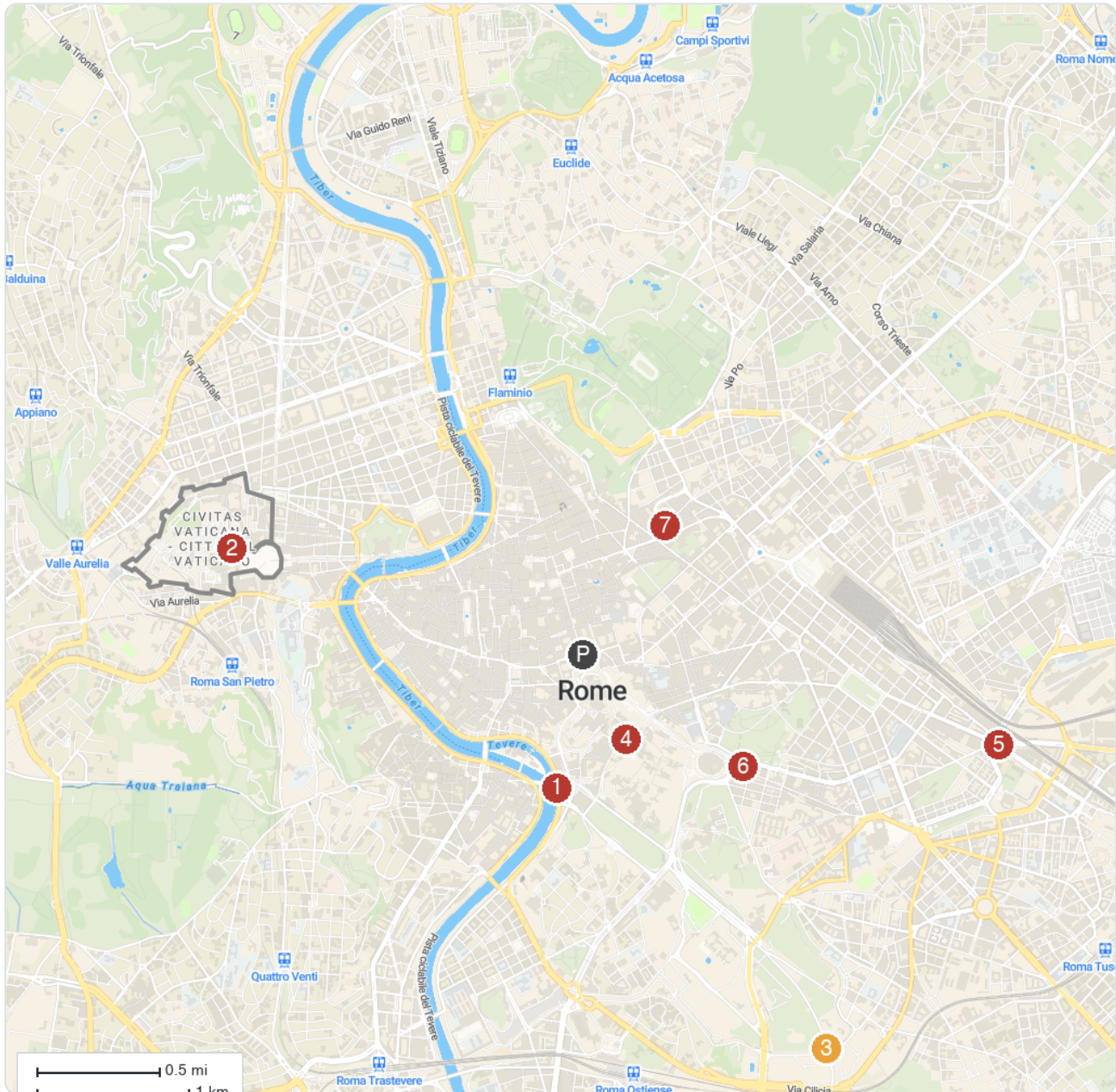
