Docking: Pier — ships berth alongside the Seine quays; no tender required

Best For: Medieval architecture, Joan of Arc history, Monet art, Normandy cuisine

Walk to center: 15–25 min (1.2–1.8 km) along flat riverside promenade

Don't Miss: Rouen Cathedral (Monet's muse), Place du Vieux-Marché, Gros-Horloge clock

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Joan of Arc Trail** — Visit the Old Market Square where she was executed in 1431, the striking modern Church of Saint Joan of Arc, and the...
- **Rouen Cathedral & Monet's Muse** — Explore the magnificent Gothic cathedral Monet painted over 30 times, housing the tomb of Richard the Lionheart's heart.
- **D-Day Beaches (Normandy)** — The WWII landing beaches — Omaha, Utah, Gold, Juno, Sword — are about 2 hours by road.
- **Monet's Garden at Giverny** — Claude Monet's legendary home and water-lily garden (inspiration for his famous series) is about an hour (≈45 min–1 hr...
- **Honfleur & the Normandy Coast** — The postcard-perfect harbor town of Honfleur — tall slate houses, art galleries, and fresh seafood — is about 50...

BEST WALKS

- **Medieval Heart Walk** 2–3 km · Flat · 90 min — The essential Rouen circuit: from the quays, walk to the Gros-Horloge, continue to Rouen Cathedral, then loop to the Aître...
- **Rue Eau-de-Robec Stroll** 1 km · Flat · 30 min — A picturesque pedestrian lane with a small stream running through it, lined with colorful half-timbered houses, artisan boutiques, and...

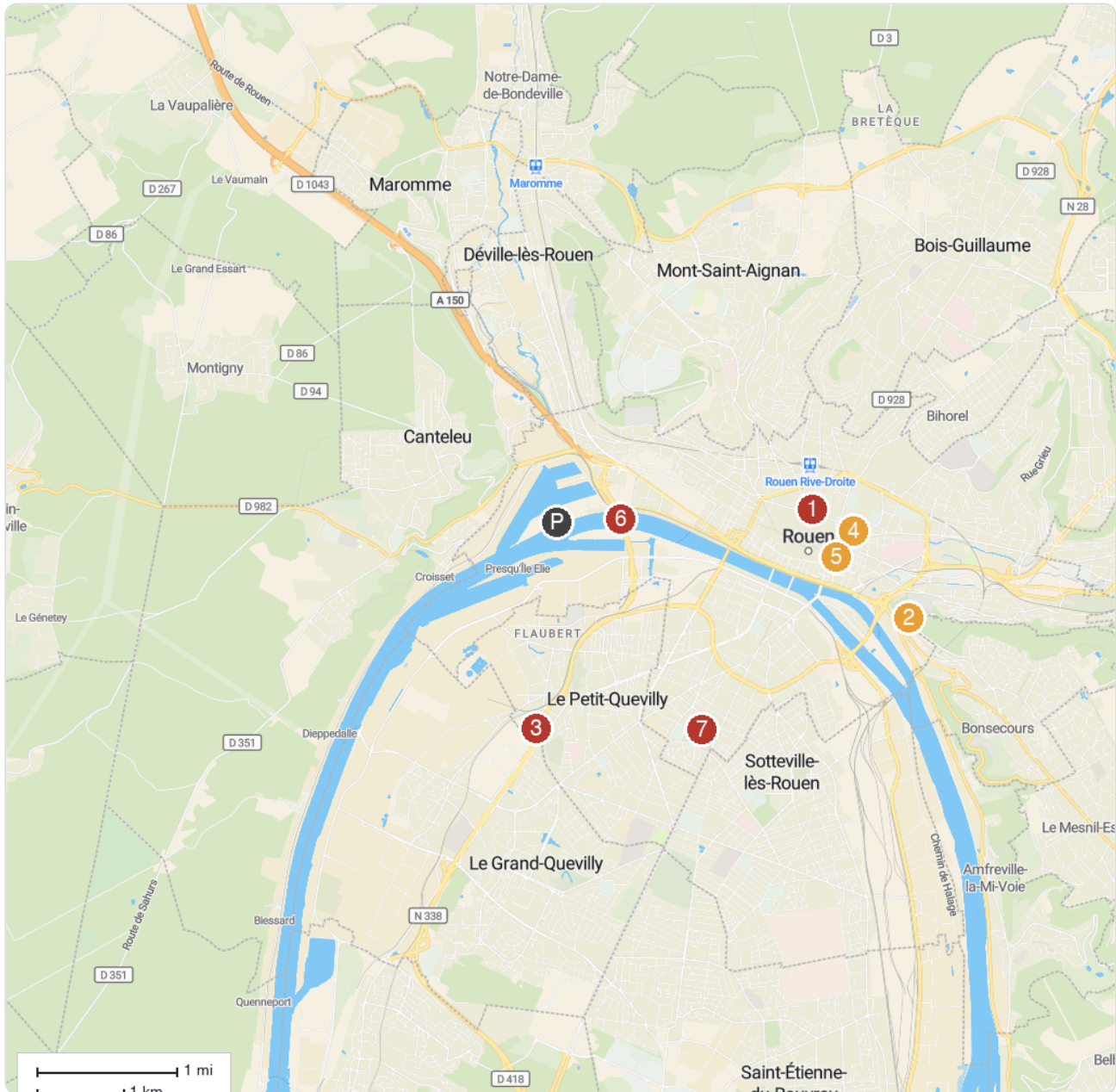
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
