TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Église Saint-Jean-Baptiste & Royal Wedding Trail** — France's grandest Basque church and site of Louis XIV's 1660 wedding.
- **Basque Food & Market Morning** — Hit Les Halles covered market for local cheeses, jambon de Bayonne, and fresh seafood, then walk Rue Gambetta for a...
- **Grande Plage Beach** — The crescent-shaped town beach is sheltered by three stone dykes, making it one of the calmest swimming beaches on the...
- **Day Trip to San Sebastián, Spain** — A 30-minute train ride crosses the border to one of Europe's great food cities.
- **Biarritz by Train** — The glamorous surfing resort 15 minutes north by train.

BEST WALKS

- **Town Centre Loop** 1.5 km · 40 min · flat — From the tender pier, walk to Place Louis XIV, into Église Saint-Jean-Baptiste, down pedestrian Rue Gambetta (stop at Maison Adam for...
- **Promenade & Grande Plage** 2 km · 50 min · flat — Head south from the tender pier along the Promenade de Jacques Thibaud hugging the beach.

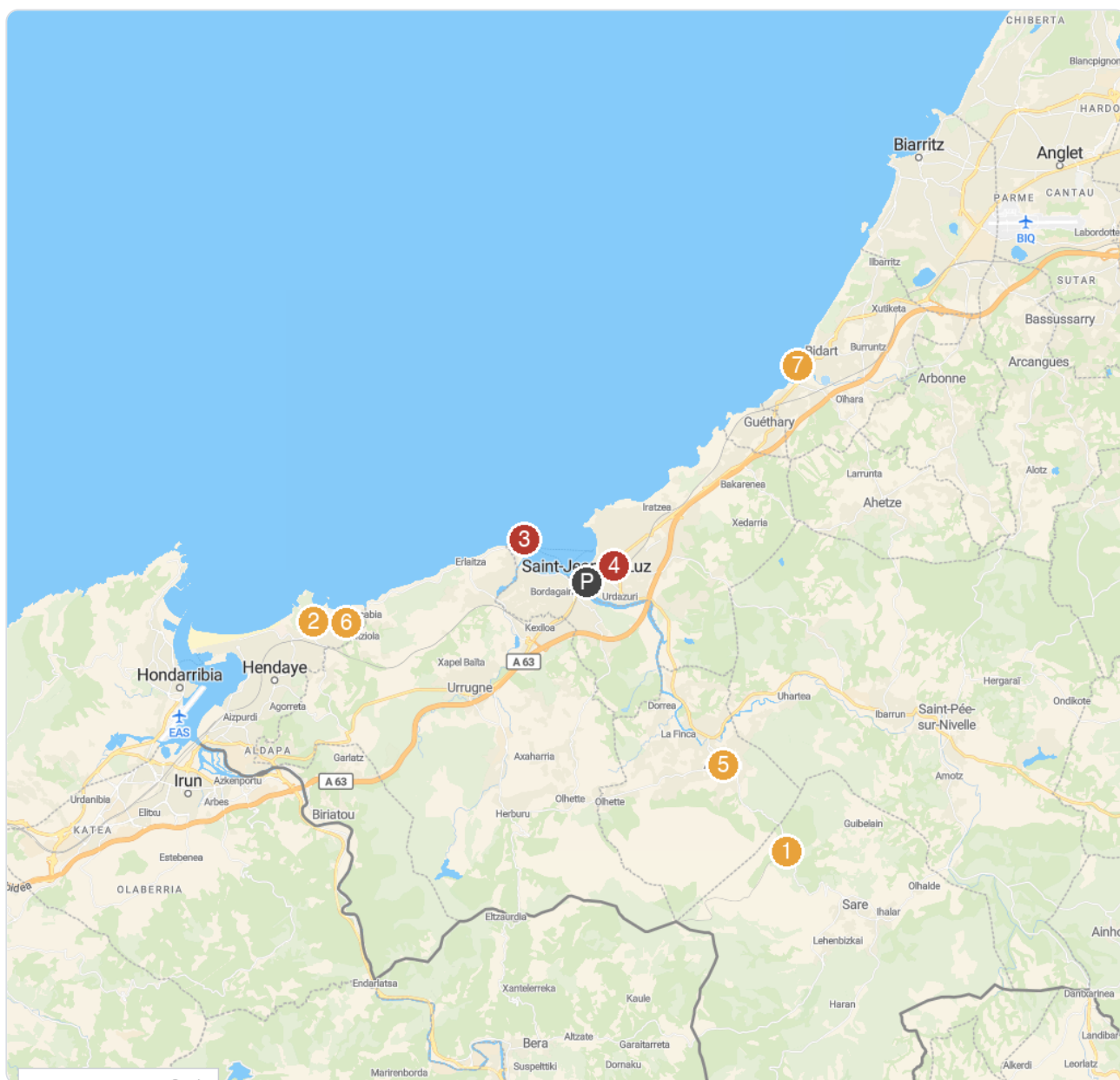
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
