

Saint John, New Brunswick, Canada

Canada's oldest incorporated city sits where the Saint John River meets the Bay of Fundy — twice a day the river literally reverses course, and cruise ships dock minutes from a walkable uptown full of Victorian brick and a market that's been running since 1876.

GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Marco Polo or Diamond Jubilee terminal; 5-min walk to uptown

Best For: Reversing Falls, Bay of Fundy whale watching, historic uptown

Walk to centre: 5 minutes flat from all three berths

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Reversing Falls Rapids** — The Bay of Fundy's massive tides push the Saint John River backwards twice a day — whirlpools, standing waves, and a...
- **Bay of Fundy Whale Watching** — Humpback, finback, and minke whales feed in the nutrient-rich Bay of Fundy waters.
- **Uptown Historic Walking Tour** — Trinity Royal Preservation Area protects blocks of Victorian brick and sandstone rebuilt after the Great Fire of 1877.
- **Saint John City Market** — Canada's oldest continuously operating farmers' market (1876) fills a stunning barrel-vaulted iron building.
- **St. Martins Sea Caves & Covered Bridges** — Drive 45 minutes to the fishing village of St.

BEST WALKS

- **Uptown Core Loop** 1.5 km · 30-40 min · Easy, flat — From the cruise terminal, walk up to King's Square, cut through to the Saint John City Market on Charlotte Street, browse the stalls...
- **Harbour Passage Waterfront Trail** 4 km return · 1-1.5 hrs · Easy, paved — Harbour Passage is a paved multi-use 'red brick road' trail that follows the inner harbour west from the cruise terminals.
