- **Hohensalzburg Fortress** — One of Europe's largest preserved medieval castles perches dramatically on a clifftop above the city.
- **Mozart's Birthplace** — At No. Cathedral where Mozart was baptized...
- **Old Town Altstadt Walking Tour** — Stroll Getreidegasse's famous wrought-iron guild signs, visit the Baroque Salzburg
- **Sound of Music Highlights** — Visit Mirabell Gardens where Maria and the children sang 'Do-Re-Mi,' see Nonnberg Abbey (the real Maria's convent), and...
- **Salzburg Café & Food Culture** — Coffee at Café Tomaselli (Austria's oldest café, est.

BEST WALKS

- **Mirabell to the Fortress** 2.5 km · 30 min walk · easy terrain — Cross the Staatsbrücke bridge from Mirabell Gardens into the Old Town, stroll Getreidegasse, visit the Cathedral, then continue to the...
- **Old Town to St. Peter's Cemetery** 0.5 km · 10 min · flat — From the Cathedral, walk through the DomQuartier courtyard to St.

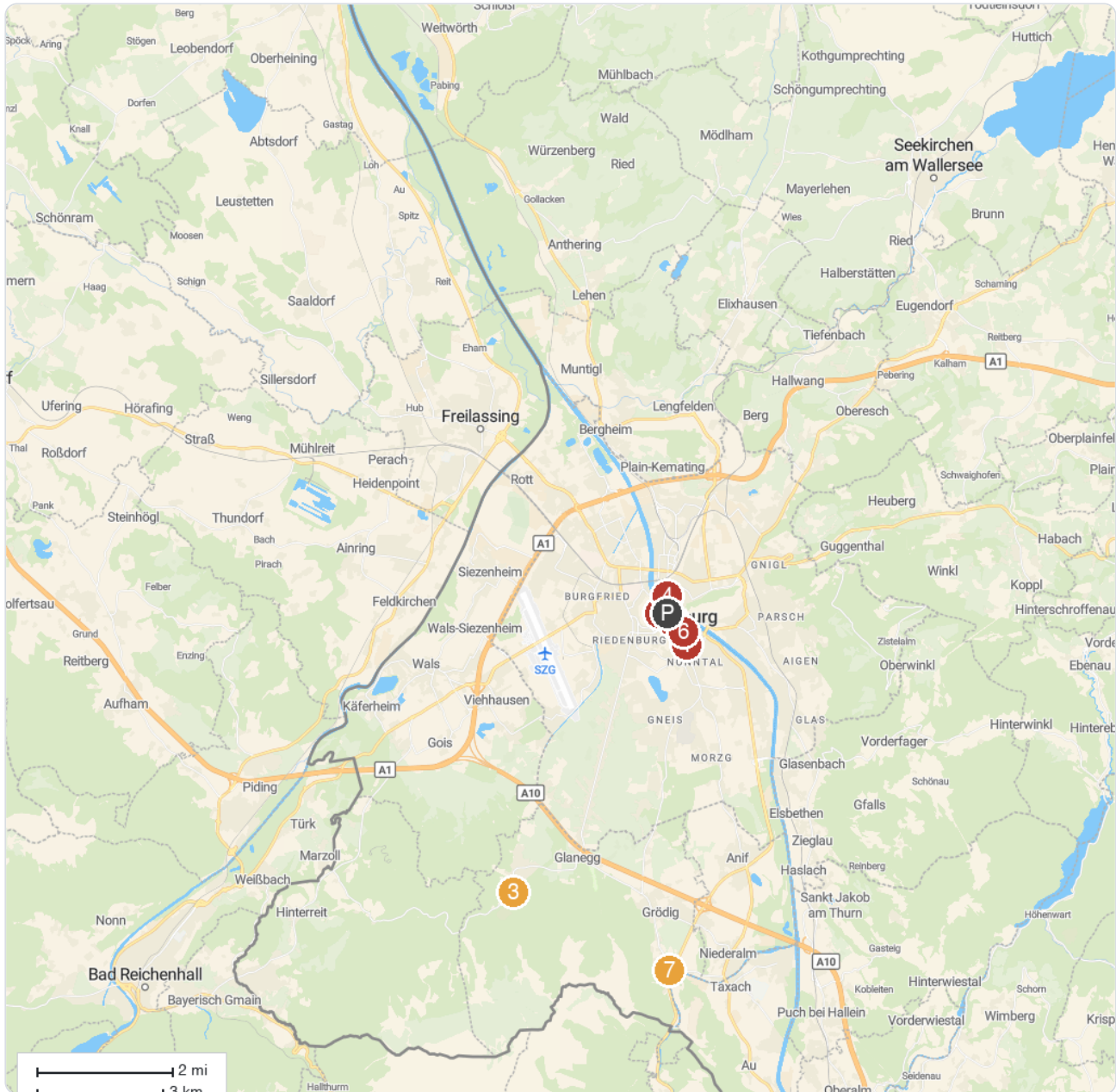
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Watch the clock. River cruise ships depart on strict schedules to meet lock transit windows. Know your return bus/train time and add a 30-minute buffer.
- Salzburg Card is worth it if you visit the Fortress and Mozart's Birthplace. The 24-hour card (~€30) covers both, the funicular, and all city transit
