TOP THINGS TO DO

- **USS Midway Museum** — The world's longest-serving 20th-century naval aircraft carrier is moored steps from the pier.
 - **San Diego Zoo & Balboa Park** — Widely considered one of the world's best zoos, with 4,000+ animals in open-air habitats across 800 species.
 - **Coronado Island & Hotel del Coronado** — Take the 15-minute ferry from Broadway Pier to Coronado.
- **Gaslamp Quarter & Downtown Walk** — San Diego's historic 16-block Victorian district buzzes with restaurants, galleries, and rooftop bars.
 - **Maritime Museum of San Diego** — A fleet of historic vessels moored on the Embarcadero, including the Star of India (1863), the world's oldest active...

BEST WALKS

- **Embarcadero Waterfront Walk** 3 miles round-trip · Flat · 60-90 min — The classic San Diego cruise walk: head south from the pier past the USS Midway, Seaport Village, and the bay promenade.
- **Gaslamp Quarter History Stroll** 1.5 miles · Flat · 45-60 min — Walk southeast from the pier into the Gaslamp Quarter's 16-block Victorian Historic District.

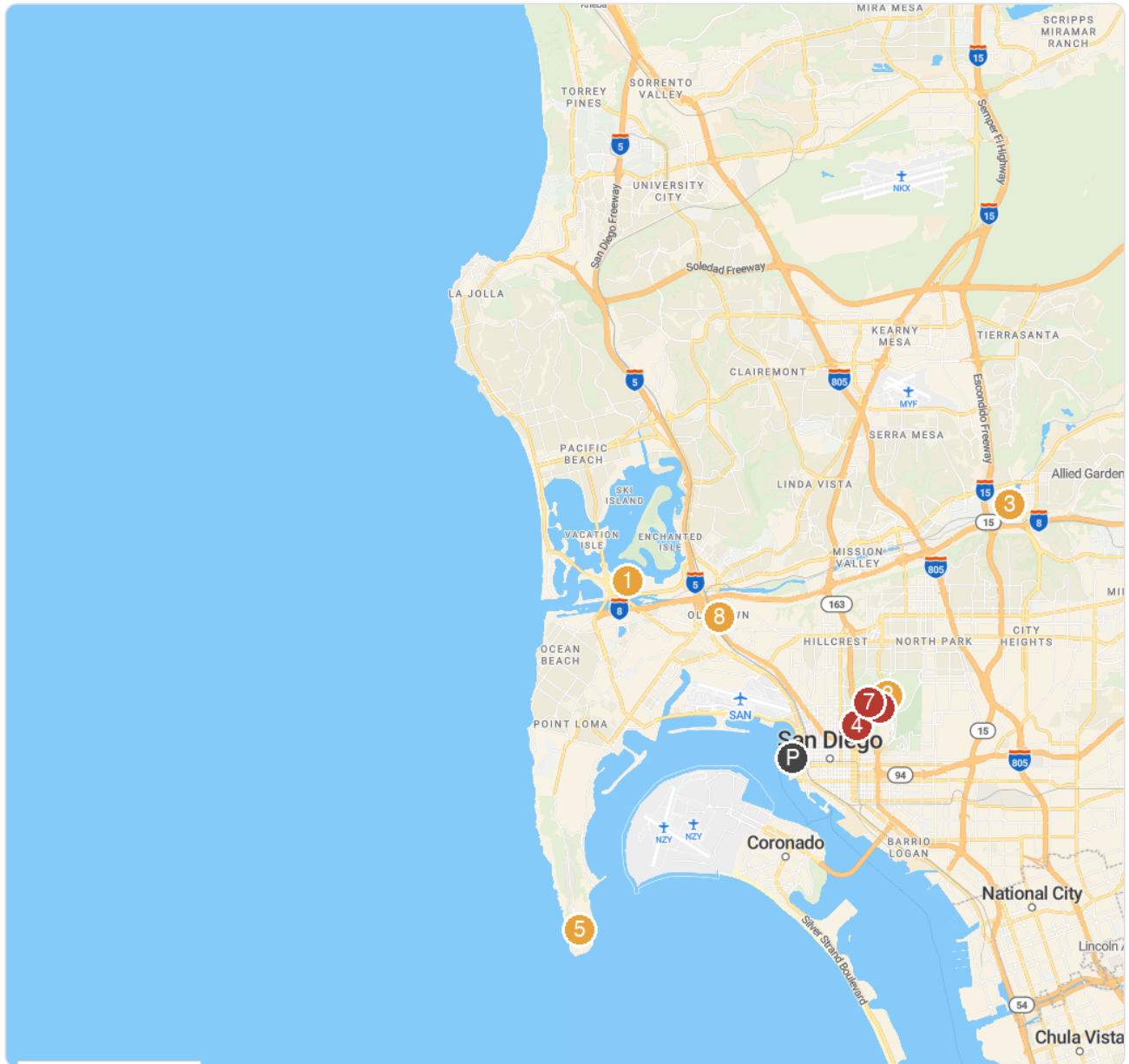
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
