GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tender to Porto Vecchio (large ships); smaller vessels dock at Porto Sole

Best For: Belle Époque architecture, cycling path, medieval quarter, day trips to Monaco

Walk to Center: 5–10 min from tender pier to Piazza Colombo / Via Matteotti

Don't Miss: La Pigna medieval quarter, Casino di Sanremo, Villa Nobel, sardenaira pizza

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **La Pigna Medieval Quarter Walk** — Explore the labyrinth of covered alleyways, archways, and tiny piazzas of San Remo's medieval heart, climbing to the...
- **Casino di Sanremo & Belle Époque Promenade** — Stroll Corso dell'Imperatrice — the palm-lined seafront promenade — to the magnificent 1905 Art Nouveau Casino.
- **Villa Nobel Museum** — Alfred Nobel spent his final years here.
- **Coastal Cycling Path (La Pista Ciclabile)** — A 24-km flat bike path built on a former railway line hugs the coast from San Remo toward Ospedaletti and beyond.
- **Day Trip to Monaco by Train** — San Remo's train station connects to Ventimiglia, where you cross into France and reach Monaco in about 25 minutes more.

BEST WALKS

- **Harbor to La Pigna & Madonna della Costa** 2.5 km | ~1.5–2 hrs | Moderate (steep upper section) — Walk from the tender pier along Via Nino Bixio into the city center, then climb the stepped lanes of the medieval La Pigna quarter to...
- **Seafront Promenade & Casino Walk** 3 km round trip | ~1 hr | Easy flat — From the old port, walk west through the center toward Corso dell'Imperatrice's towering palm-lined boulevard and the grand Casino di...

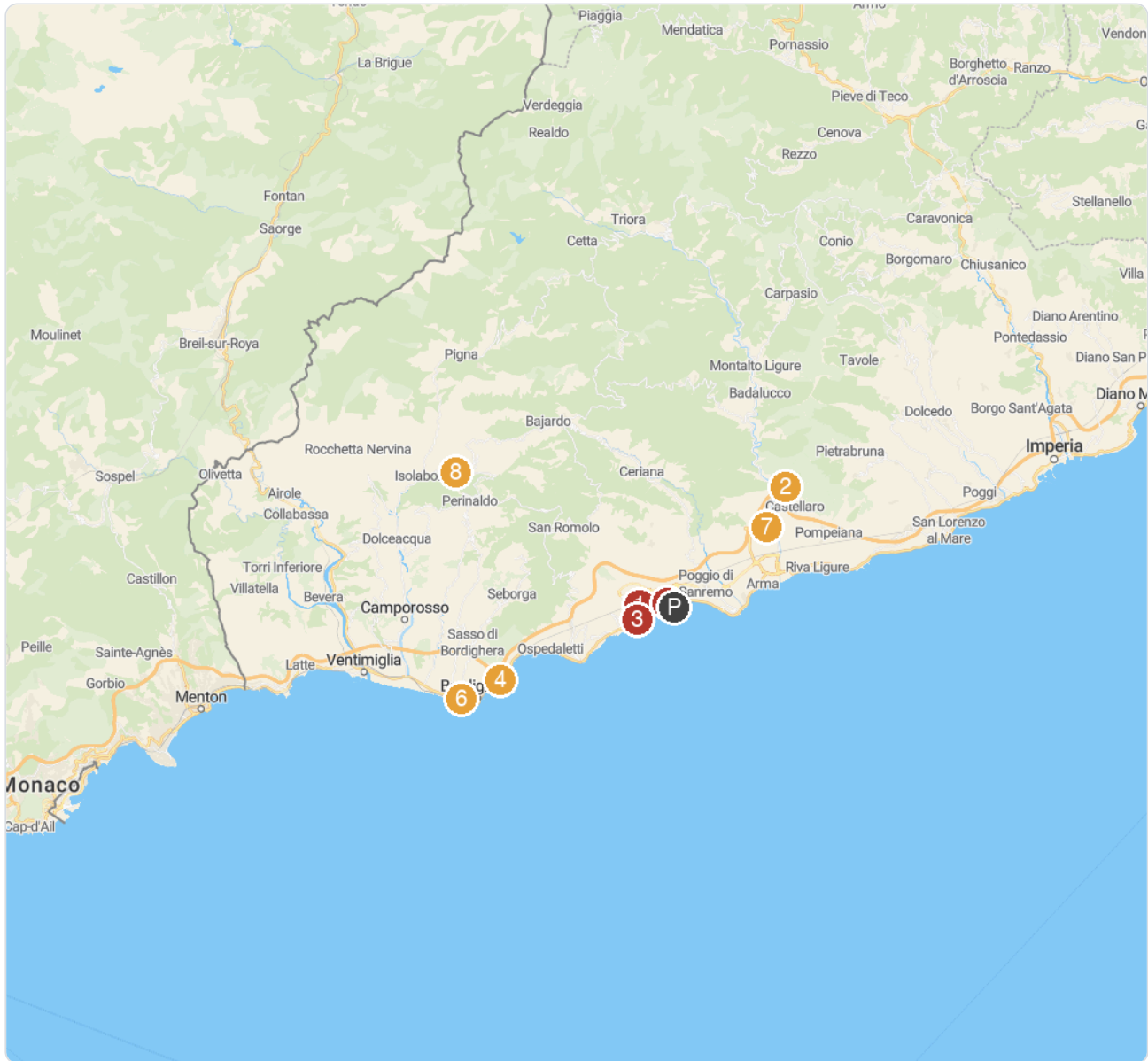
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
