- **Wednesday Harbor Market** — Voted France's most beautiful market, the Wednesday market stretches the full length of the harbor offering local...
- **Tour Romane & Underwater Archaeology Museum** — Climb the c.
- **Plage de Portissol** — A sheltered sandy bay 15 minutes west of the harbor with lifeguards, showers, a marked snorkeling trail, and beachfront...
- **Calanques Boat Excursion** — Local operators depart from the harbor for the dramatic limestone inlets near Cassis — sheer white cliffs, turquoise...
- **Bandol Wine & Village** — The world-famous Bandol AOC wine region — best known for its Mourvèdre reds and bone-dry rosé — begins just 10 minutes...

BEST WALKS

- **Harbor to Chapel Panorama** 2.5 km round trip · Easy–Moderate · ~1 hr — From the harbor, follow the waterfront west past the Tour Romane, then head uphill to Chapelle Notre-Dame-de-Pitié (1560) via the...
- **Harbor Stroll to Portissol Beach** 1.5 km one way · Easy · ~15 min — Walk west along the seafront promenade from the harbor past the Esplanade beach, continuing to the sheltered cove at Portissol.

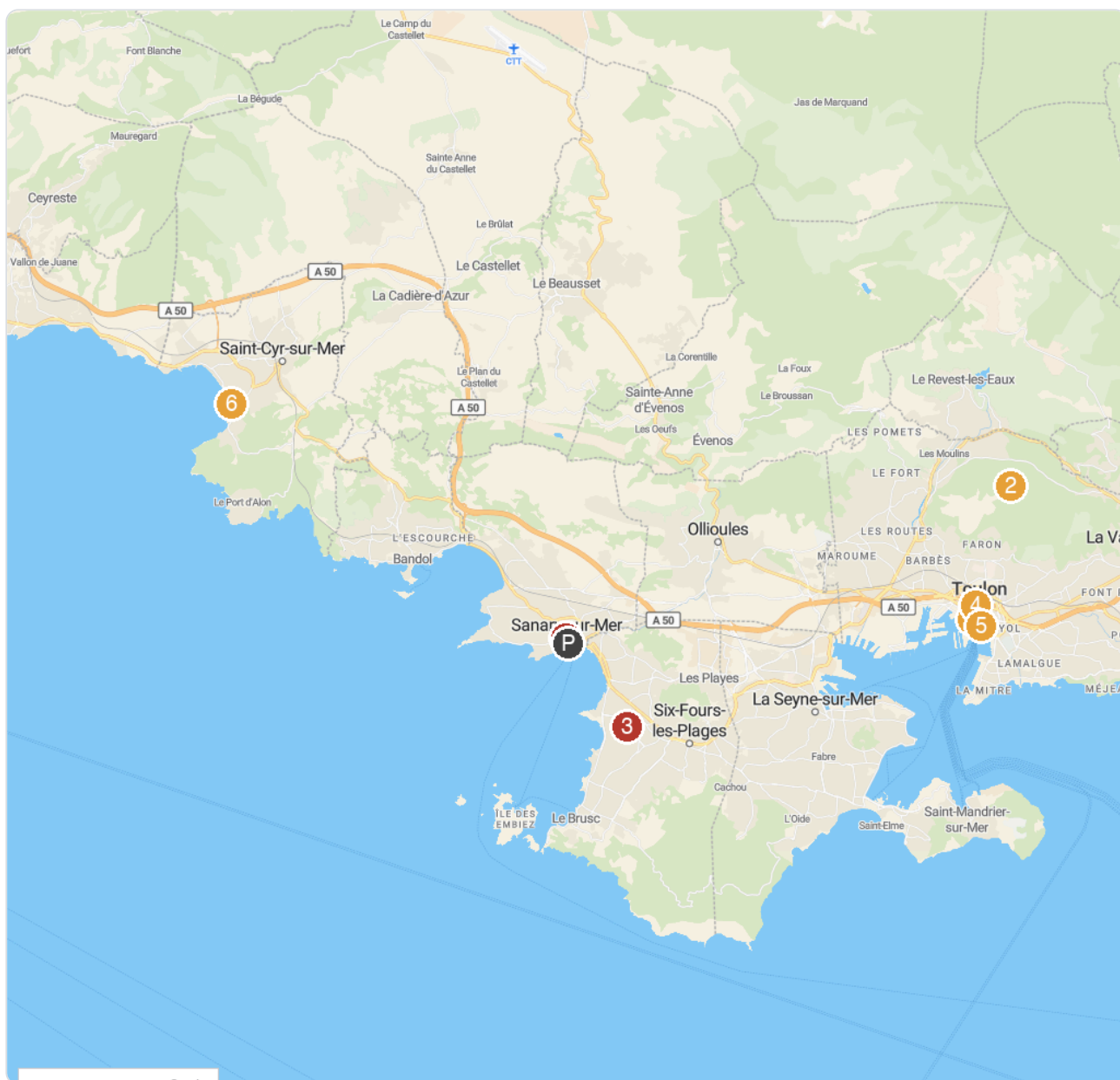
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
