TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Funk Zone Wine Trail** — Santa Barbara County is famed for Pinot Noir and Chardonnay, and the Funk Zone — a converted industrial neighborhood...
- **Santa Barbara County Courthouse & El Mirador** — Built after the 1925 earthquake in stunning Spanish-Moorish style, this working courthouse is free to explore.
- **Stearns Wharf & Sea Center** — California's oldest operating wharf (1872) stretches 2,300 feet into the harbor.
- **Old Mission Santa Barbara** — The 'Queen of the Missions' (1786) sits in the foothills about 2.5 miles from the harbor.
- **Channel Islands & Whale Watch** — The Santa Barbara Channel is a Marine Sanctuary.

BEST WALKS

- **Harbor to Stearns Wharf Beach Stroll** 1.2 miles / 25 min / flat — From Sea Landing, head east along Cabrillo Boulevard's palm-lined path.
- **Funk Zone & Lower State Street** 0.8 miles / 15-20 min / flat — From Stearns Wharf walk up State Street into the Funk Zone — wine tasting rooms, surf shops, and galleries occupy converted warehouses.

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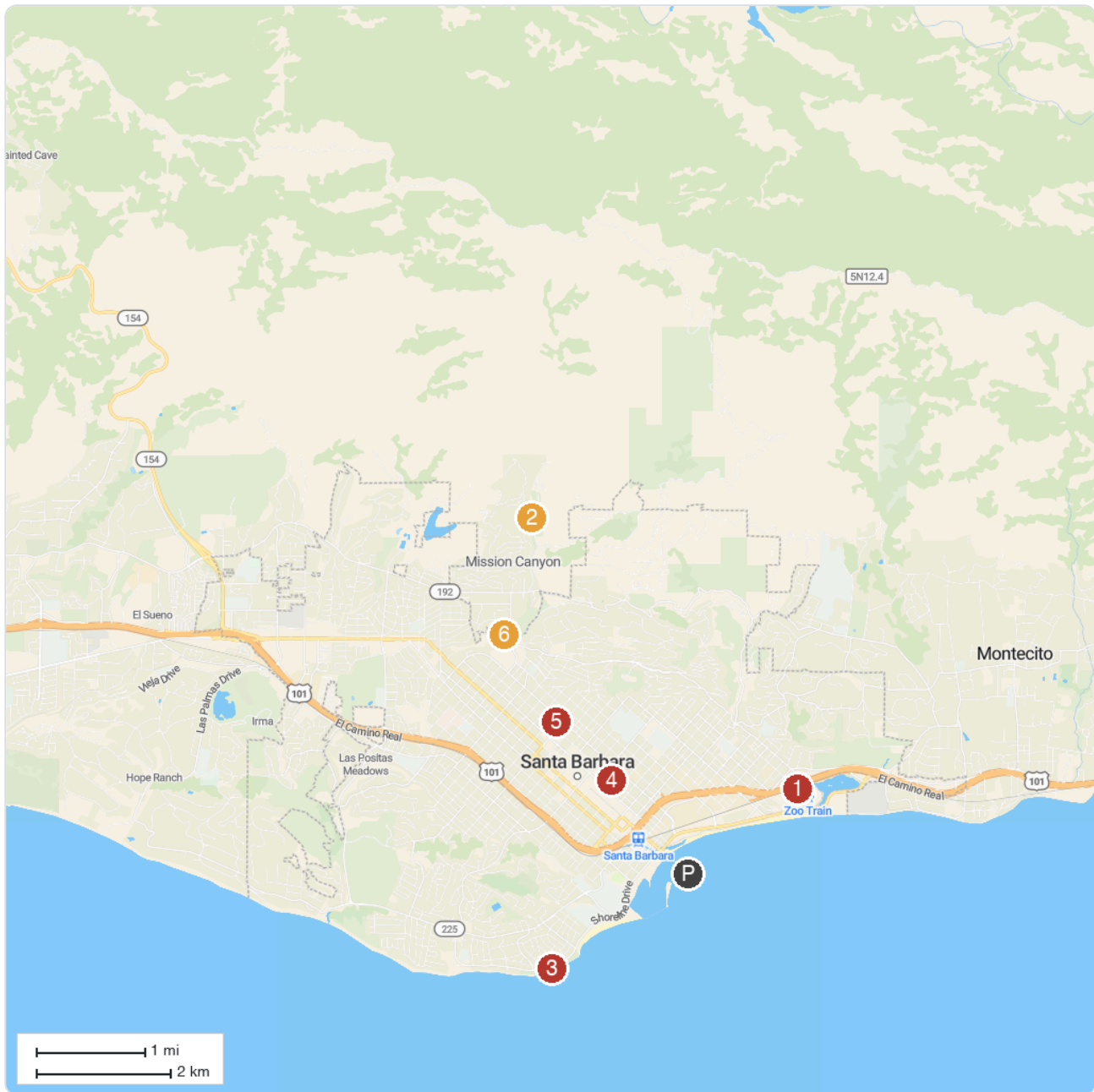
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Join the early tender queue if you have independent plans — the line can take 45+ min on busy ship days.
- 'June Gloom' is real: May-July mornings are often foggy and cool. Bring a light jacket — it usually burns off by noon to glorious sunshine.
- Tar on the beach: Natural oil seeps leave black tar spots on the sand and your feet. Use baby oil or olive oil to remove it — soap won't work.
