Docking: Pier — Maritime Station, central waterfront

Best for: Beaches, modern art, tapas, bay ferry hop

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Bilbao & the Guggenheim** — Ride 1 hr east to Bilbao's titanium Guggenheim Museum — one of the most spectacular buildings on Earth — plus the...
 - Altamira Cave Replica & Santillana del Mar** — The Altamira 'Sistine Chapel of prehistory' is now preserved behind glass; the museum's replica lets you walk among...
- Centro Botín Art Walk** — Renzo Piano's striking cultural centre floats over the bay on stilts just 8 min from the ship.
 - Magdalena Peninsula Walk** — A 30-min walk or quick bus ride brings you to the Magdalena Palace grounds — a former royal summer residence with free...
 - El Sardinero Beach** — Santander's grand 19th-century casino overlooks Primera and Segunda beaches at El Sardinero — 2.5 km of fine sand...

BEST WALKS

- Waterfront to Magdalena Peninsula** 3.5 km · ~45 min · easy coastal path — From the Maritime Station, walk east along Paseo de Pereda past Centro Botín, up through Jardines de Piquío, and onto the Magdalena...
- Old Town & Cathedral Loop** 1.5 km · ~25 min · easy — Head uphill from the Botín to the twin-naved Catedral de Santander, then wander the pedestrian lanes of Calle Juan de Herrera and...

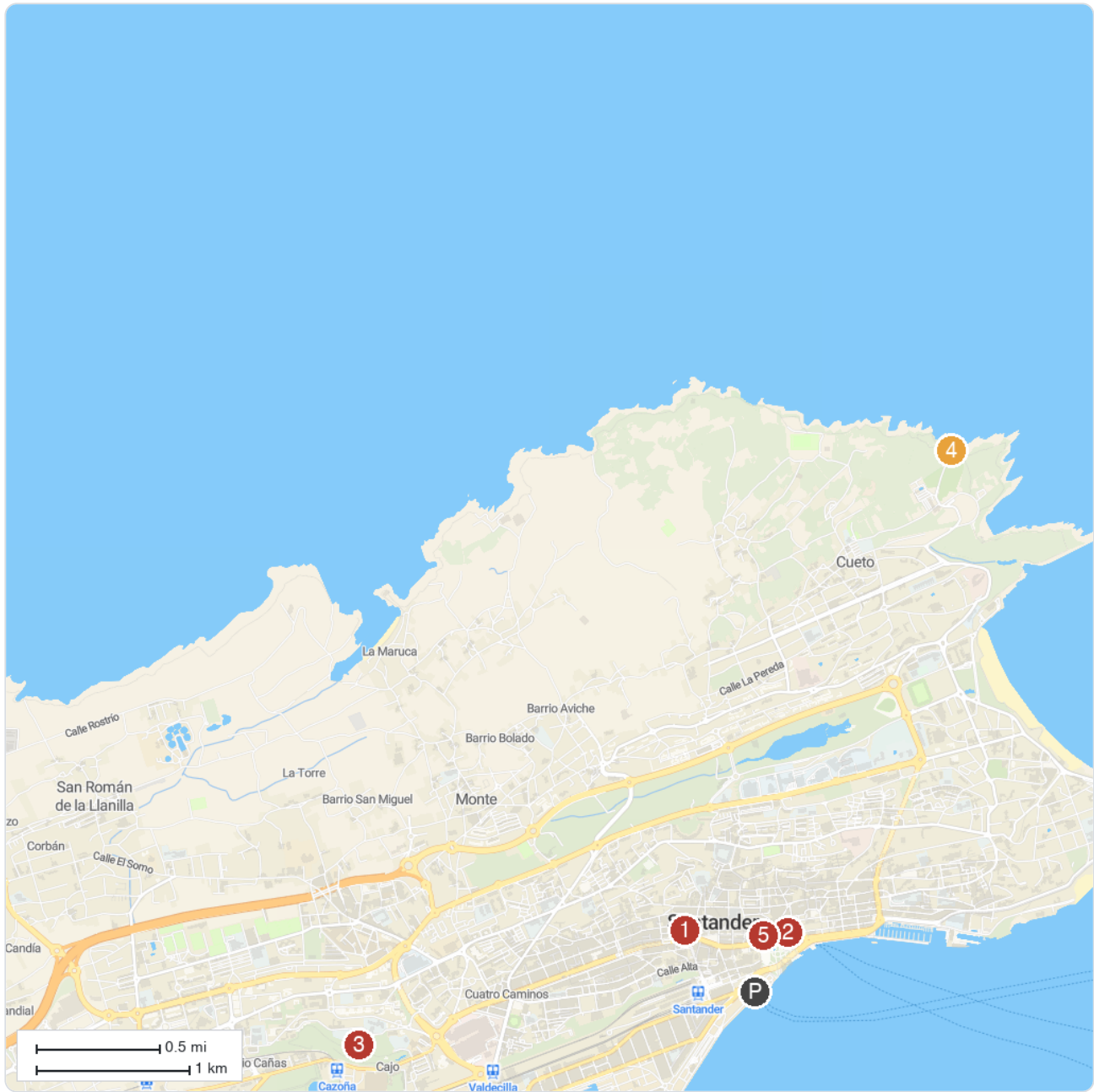
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
