TOP THINGS TO DO

- Oia Village & Blue Domes** — The postcard Santorini — whitewashed lanes, blue-domed churches, the world-famous caldera view.
 - Caldera Catamaran & Hot Springs** — Sail inside the caldera, hike the active volcanic islet of Nea Kameni, then swim in the warm sulfur hot springs.
- Volcanic Wine Tasting** — Santorini's Assyrtiko grapes grow in basket-woven vines in volcanic ash — unlike any other wine on earth.
 - Akrotiri — Pompeii of the Aegean** — A Minoan city buried 3,600 years ago, now under a climate-controlled enclosure.
 - Fira to Oia Caldera Hike** — The 10 km clifftop trail from Fira to Oia is one of the great walks of the Aegean — caldera views the entire way.

BEST WALKS

- Fira Caldera Rim Stroll** 1–2 km · 30–45 min · easy — Walk the paved clifftop path through Fira past boutiques, cafes, and dramatic caldera overlooks.
- Fira → Firotstefani → Imerovigli** ~2 km · 45 min one-way · easy — The caldera-edge promenade north from Fira.
- Fira → Oia Caldera Trail (Route 9)** ~10 km · 3.5–4.5 hrs · moderate — The classic clifftop hike north along the caldera rim to Oia.

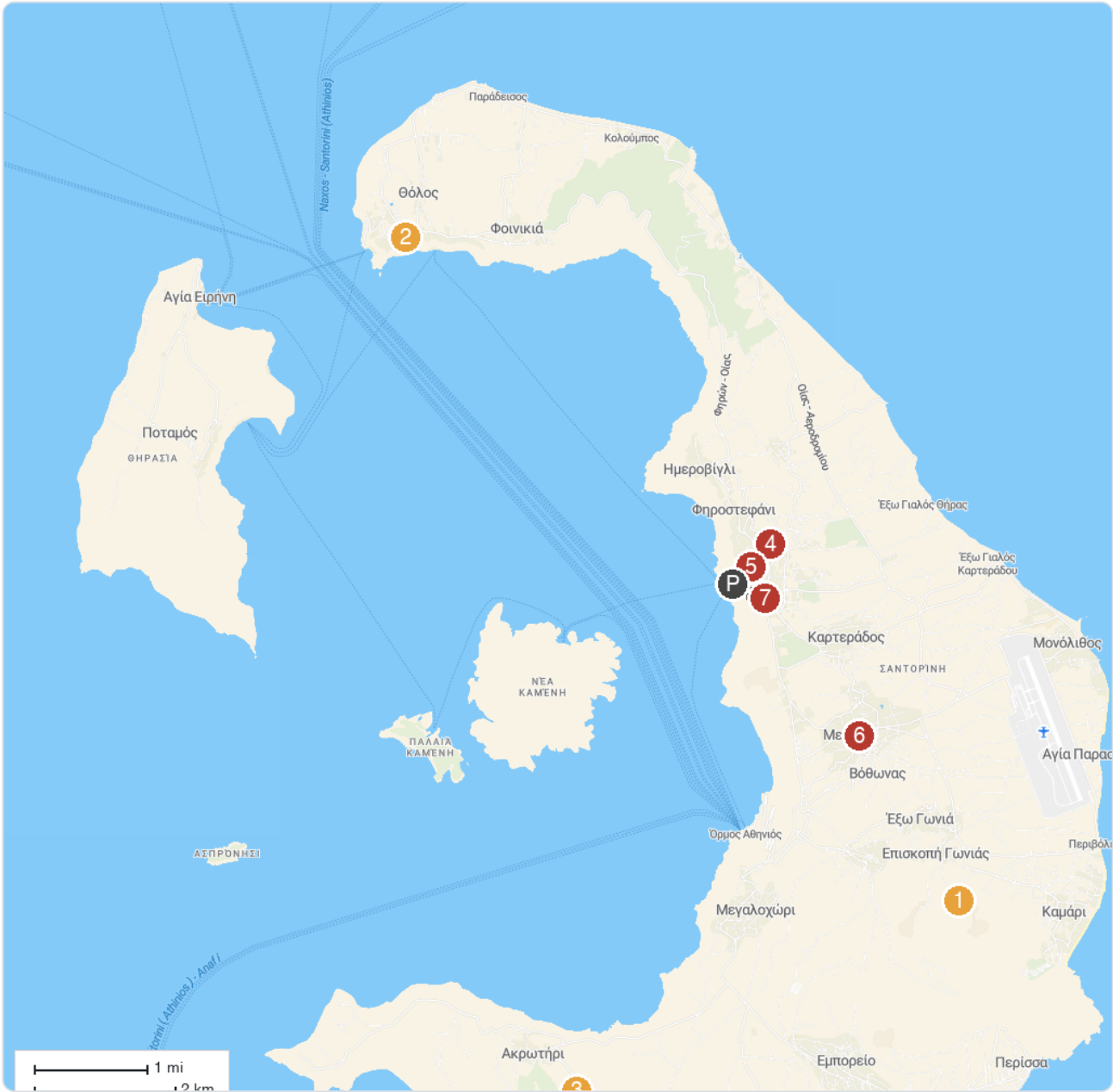
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- New €20 cruise tourist fee (2025+). Collected at the tender landing on arrival — carry cash or a card. Separate from cable car fare and excursion costs.
- Plan your return early. Budget 90–120 min before all-aboard. On multi-ship days the cable car return queue hits 2 hours. Walk the 588 steps down (20–25 min) rather than wait in a...
