TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Museu do Café — Coffee Exchange Palace** — The star of Santos.
- **Monte Serrat Funicular & Viewpoint** — A 1920s funicular climbs Monte Serrat to a hilltop chapel and casino ruins with sweeping 360° views over the port...
- **Museu Pelé — Football Royalty** — A sleek modern museum in the Valongo district dedicated to Pelé, who spent most of his career at Santos FC.
- **Beachfront Gardens & Gonzaga Beach** — The Jardins da Orla stretches 7 km along Santos' beach — Guinness-certified as the world's longest beachfront garden.
- **Guarujá Beach Day** — Cross the channel by ferry to Guarujá for cleaner, more sheltered beaches like Praia das Pitangueiras and Praia da...

BEST WALKS

- **Historic Centre Coffee Trail** 1.5 km · 30–45 min · Flat — Walk from the Coffee Museum through the Valongo neighbourhood past the Igreja do Valongo (17th-century Baroque church with azulejo...
- **Gonzaga Beach Promenade** 2 km · 30 min · Flat — Stroll the Jardins da Orla beachfront gardens between Canal 2 and Canal 4, then grab a pastel and caldo de cana from a street vendor.

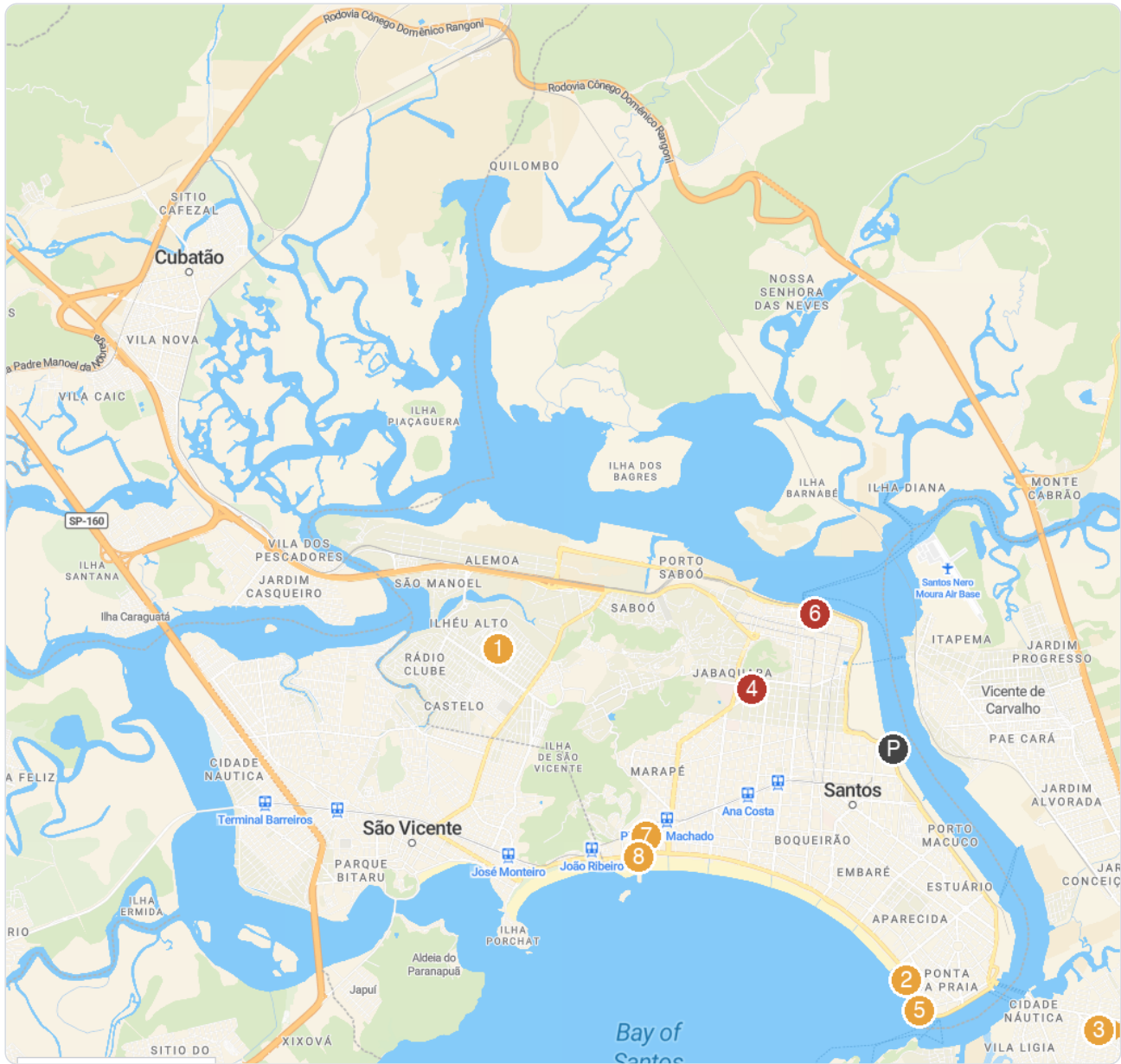
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Uber is your best friend. The port cannot be exited on foot — download Uber before docking. Rides to the Historic Centre cost under R\$20 and take 10–15 min.
- Check museum days. The Coffee Museum and Pelé Museum are closed Mondays. On Sundays the Historic Centre is quiet and
