TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Historic District Trolley Tour** — Hop-on hop-off narrated trolley routes cover all 22 squares, Forsyth Park, Juliette Gordon Low's birthplace, and the...
- **Bonaventure Cemetery Walk** — Made famous by 'Midnight in the Garden of Good and Evil,' this Victorian-era cemetery along the Wilmington River is...
- **Wormsloe Historic Site** — A breathtaking 1.5-mile avenue of live oaks leads to the ruins of colonial Georgia's oldest standing structure.
- **Tybee Island Beach Day** — Just 18 miles east of downtown, Tybee Island has sandy Atlantic beaches, a historic lighthouse, and dolphin eco-tours.
- **Southern Food & Squares Self-Walk** — Grab a to-go cup (Savannah allows open containers in the Historic District) and graze your way through City Market...

BEST WALKS

- **River Street to Forsyth Park** 1.5 miles one-way · ~35 min · flat — Start on cobblestone River Street at the waterfront, climb to Bay Street, then stroll south through Reynolds Square, Chippewa Square...
- **City Market & Cathedral Loop** 0.8 miles · ~20 min · flat — A short loop from the waterfront to City Market (galleries, restaurants, live music courtyard), past the Cathedral of St.

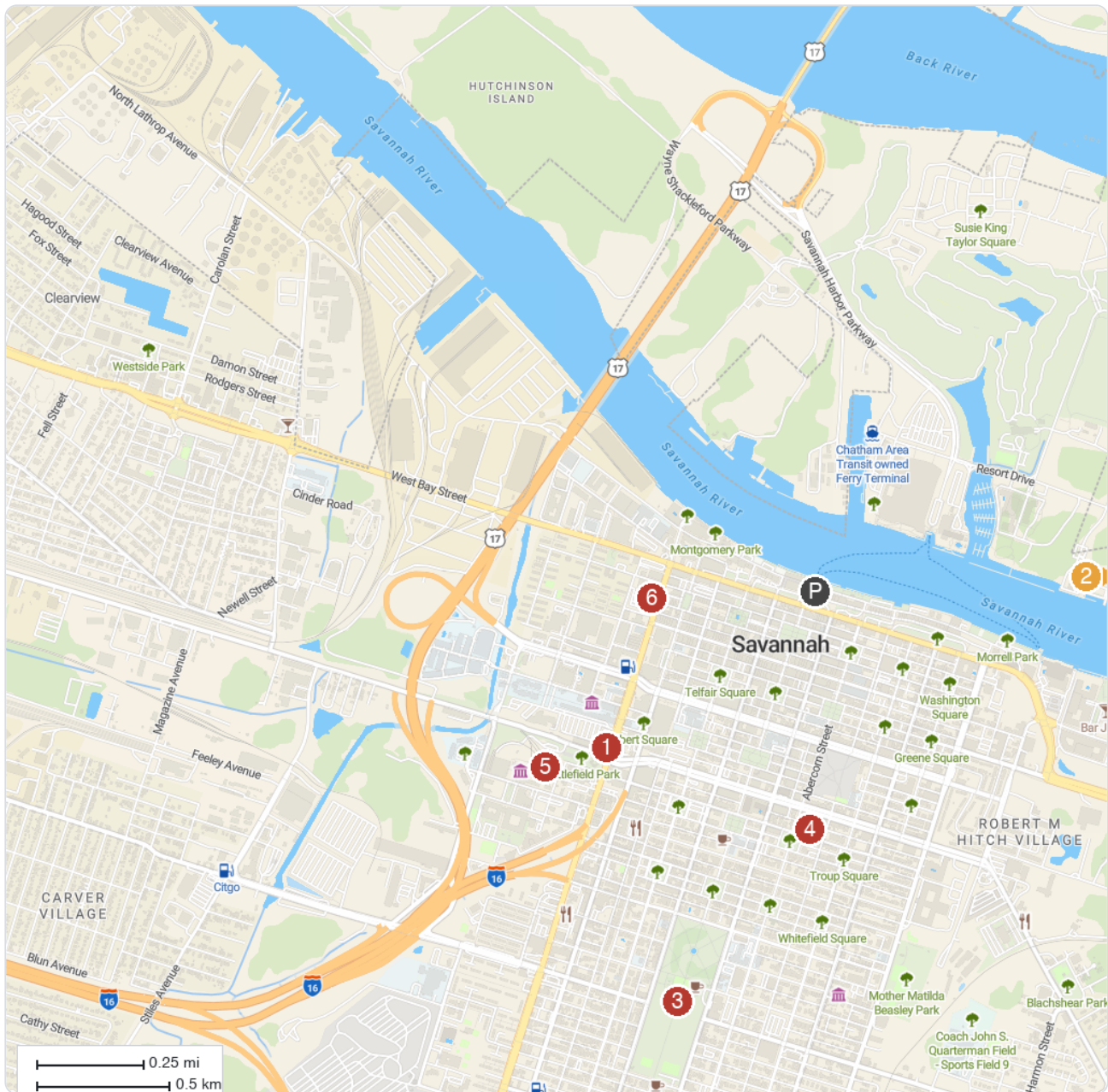
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
