GETTING ASHORE

Docking: River dock at Wayne Jerrolds River Park on the Tennessee River — ships tie up dockside, no tendering

Best For: Civil War history, river scenery, small-town Southern culture, catfish dining

Walk to center: Downtown Savannah is a short walk (~5 min) from the river park

Don't Miss: Shiloh National Military Park — one of the best-preserved Civil War battlefields in the US

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Shiloh National Military Park** — One of the Civil War's bloodiest two-day battles (April 1862) is preserved across nearly 4,000 acres.
 - **Tennessee River Museum** — Traces the Tennessee River Valley from prehistoric Native Americans and the Trail of Tears through the Civil War...
 - **Savannah Historic District Walk** — A self-guided 2-mile loop through 41 preserved historic homes and structures, the
- downtown Savannah Theater, and the...

 - **Pickwick Landing State Park** — A recreation hub on Pickwick Lake — roughly 43,000 acres of clear TVA reservoir water with fishing, hiking...
 - **Catfish Country Dining** — Savannah bills itself the "Catfish Capital of the World." Hagy's Catfish Hotel — a Tennessee institution since 1938...

BEST WALKS

- **Riverfront to Historic Downtown** 0.5 miles · Easy · 15-20 min — Stroll from Wayne Jerrolds River Park along the Tennessee River bank, past the riverfront park, into downtown Savannah's courthouse...
- **Savannah Historic District Loop** 2 miles · Easy · 45-60 min — Pick up the self-guided brochure at the Tennessee River Museum and walk past 41 historic homes, Cherry Mansion (Grant's Civil War...

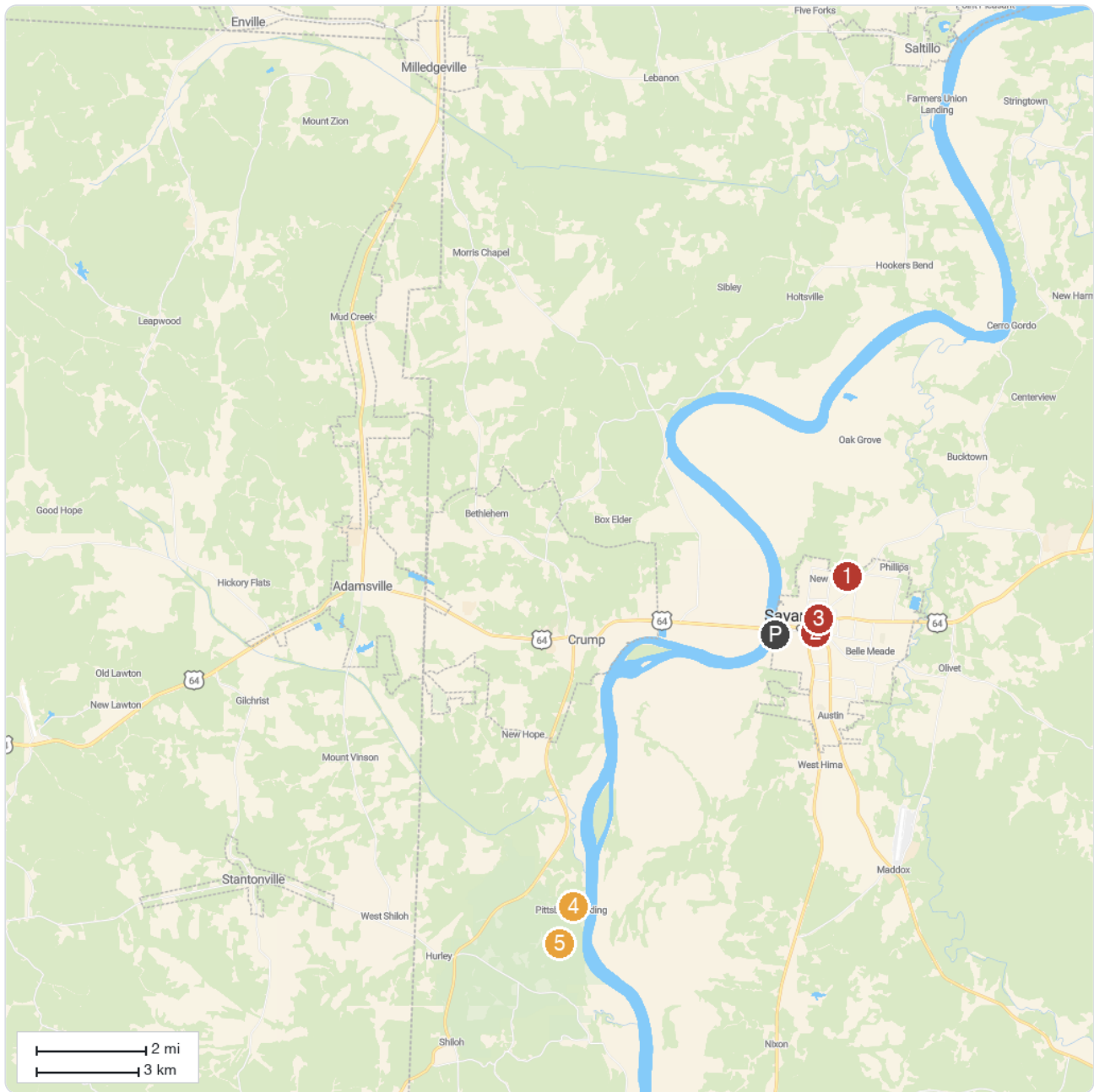
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
