GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Always pier — Palacrociere Terminal, Berths 1 & 2

Best For: Authentic Italy, local food, day trips to Genoa or Cinque Terre

Walk to center: 10 min to Via Paleocapa; 5 min to Old Harbor

Don't Miss: Farinata & Panissa street food; Priamar Fortress views

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Priamar Fortress** — Walk up to this massive 16th-century Genoese fortress that dominates the seafront.
- **Savona's Sistine Chapel** — Pope Sixtus IV — who commissioned the Roman original — built this Baroque mausoleum in Savona for his parents.
- **Day Trip to Genoa** — Board a direct train and reach Europe's largest medieval historic center in under an hour.
- **Finale Ligure & Finalborgo** — A 20-minute train ride brings you to one of Italy's most beautiful medieval walled villages, set above a good beach...
- **Fornaci Beach** — Savona's Blue Flag city beach is a 15-20 minute walk west from the terminal along the Corso Colombo promenade.

BEST WALKS

- **Old Harbor & Historic Center Loop** 2.5 km · 45-60 min · flat — Cross the drawbridge to the Vecchia Darsena, then walk past the Torre Leon Pancaldo to Via Paleocapa (the main arcade).
- **Priamar Fortress Walk** 1.5 km · 30-40 min · gentle uphill — From the Old Harbor, follow the seafront promenade east to the base of the Priamar headland.

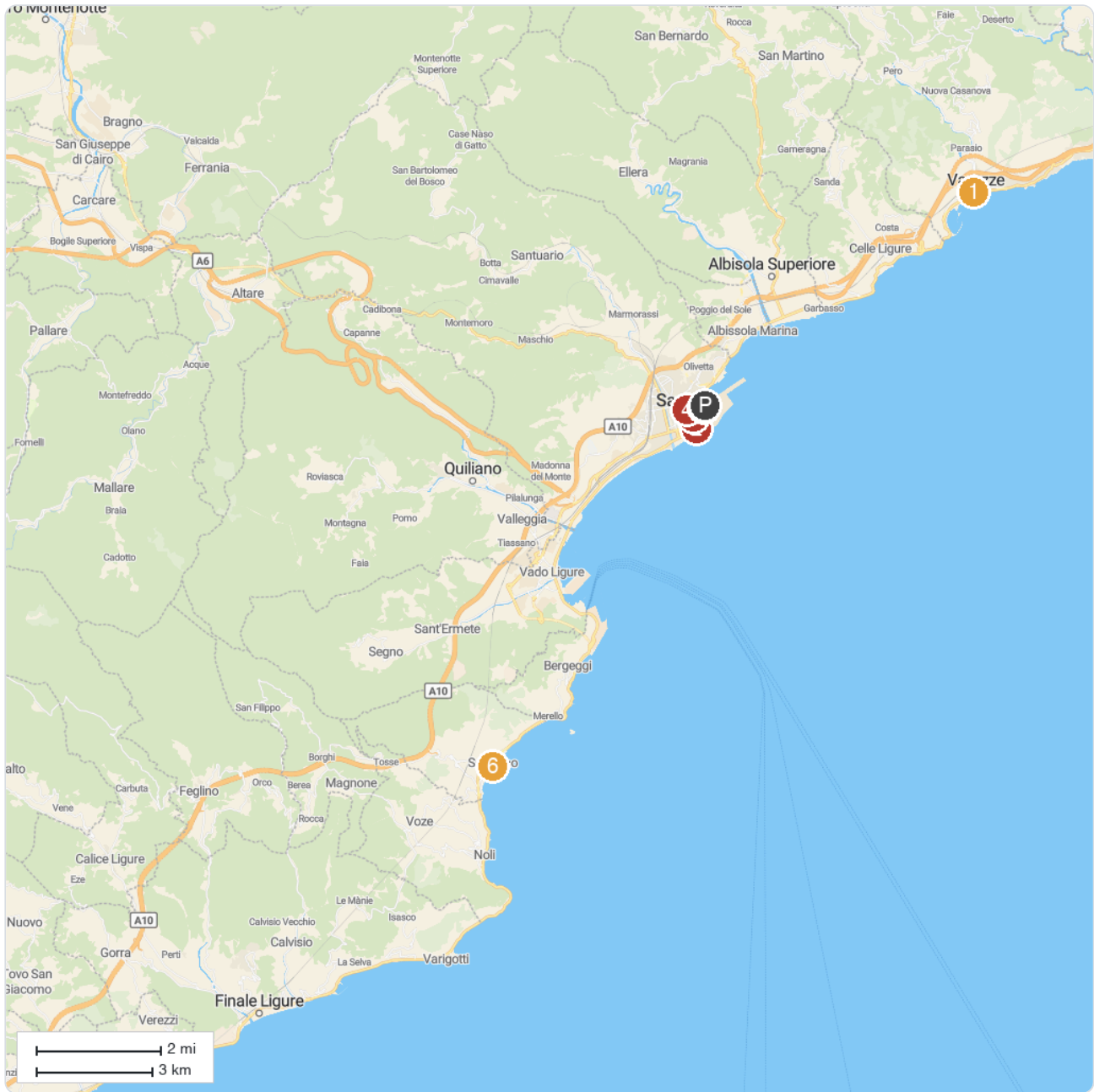
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Watch the drawbridge. The Ponte Mobile lifts occasionally for boat traffic. Allow 10-15 extra minutes before all-aboard — being stuck on the wrong side is a real risk.
- Eat farinata and panissa. These chickpea-flour specialties are Savona's signature street foods. Try Fetta d'Oro near the Darsena for the real thing — cheap and delicious.
