GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Deep-water pier in town center — no tendering for most ships

Best For: Snorkeling Buccoo Reef, Pigeon Point beach, colonial fort views

Walk to center: 5–10 min on foot to shops, market, and Fort King George taxi stand

Don't Miss: Nylon Pool glass-bottom boat tour and the Scarborough Municipal Market

Getting around: **Taxi** USD \$15–25 to Pigeon Point; negotiate beforehand · **Rideshare** not available

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Buccoo Reef & Nylon Pool Glass-Bottom Boat** — A classic Tobago excursion: snorkel the living coral of Buccoo Reef then wade in the shallow, milky-clear Nylon Pool...
 - **Pigeon Point Heritage Park** — Tobago's postcard beach: a thatched-roof jetty, calm turquoise water, and powdery white sand.
- **Fort King George** — 18th-century British fortification perched above Scarborough with sweeping views of the Caribbean.
 - **Argyle Waterfall Hike** — Tobago's tallest waterfall cascades in three tiers through rainforest.
 - **Main Ridge Forest Reserve Birdwatching** — The oldest protected rainforest in the Western Hemisphere is a birdwatcher's paradise — motmots, toucans, and...

BEST WALKS

- **Town Center & Market Stroll** 1 km · 20 min · Easy · Flat — Exit the cruise terminal gate onto Carrington Street, walk through the downtown grid to the Scarborough Municipal Market, then...
- **Up to Fort King George** 1.5 km · 30 min · Moderate · Uphill — From the market, follow Fort Street uphill to Fort King George.

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- USD widely accepted: Most vendors, taxis, and beach bars accept US dollars alongside TTD. Change may come back in TTD.
- Negotiate taxi fares before you ride: Official taxis have 'H' plates. Agree the price upfront — no meters operate. Pigeon Point costs roughly USD 15 each way.
