GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Pier 91 (Smith Cove) for most ships; Pier 66 (Bell Street) for Norwegian, Oceania, and select others — both docked, no tendering

Best For: Pre/post-cruise city days, Pacific Northwest seafood, iconic landmarks, Alaska adventure planning

Walk to center: Pier 66 is steps from downtown; Pier 91 is 3–4 miles away — take the free shuttle to Seattle Center then the \$4 monorail

Don't Miss: Pike Place Market before 10am — fish toss, flower stalls, and the original Starbucks without the line

Getting around: Taxi \$20–55 · Rideshare Uber, Lyft · Hop-on hop-off City Sightseeing Seattle

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Space Needle & Seattle Center** — Ride to the revolving glass floor at 605 feet for panoramic views of Puget Sound, Mount Rainier, and the city skyline.
- Pike Place Market Deep Dive** — America's oldest continuously operating public market is a sensory feast — flying fish, fresh flower bouquets, artisan...
- Underground Seattle Tour** — Walk the buried city beneath Pioneer Square — original 1889 storefronts preserved one level below modern streets after...
- Museum of Pop Culture (MoPOP)** — Frank Gehry's wild titanium building houses hands-on exhibits on rock 'n' roll history, Nirvana, Jimi Hendrix, sci-fi...
- Puget Sound Whale Watching** — Orcas, minke whales, and harbor porpoise are regularly spotted in Puget Sound.

BEST WALKS

- Waterfront to Pike Place Loop** 1.5 miles · 45 min · Easy — Start at the Seattle Aquarium, walk north along Alaskan Way, climb the Pike Place Market hillclimb escalators, wander the market...
- Pioneer Square & Waterfall Garden** 1 mile · 30 min · Easy — Explore cobblestone Pioneer Square, duck into the hidden Waterfall Garden Park (built on the birthplace of UPS), check out the totem...

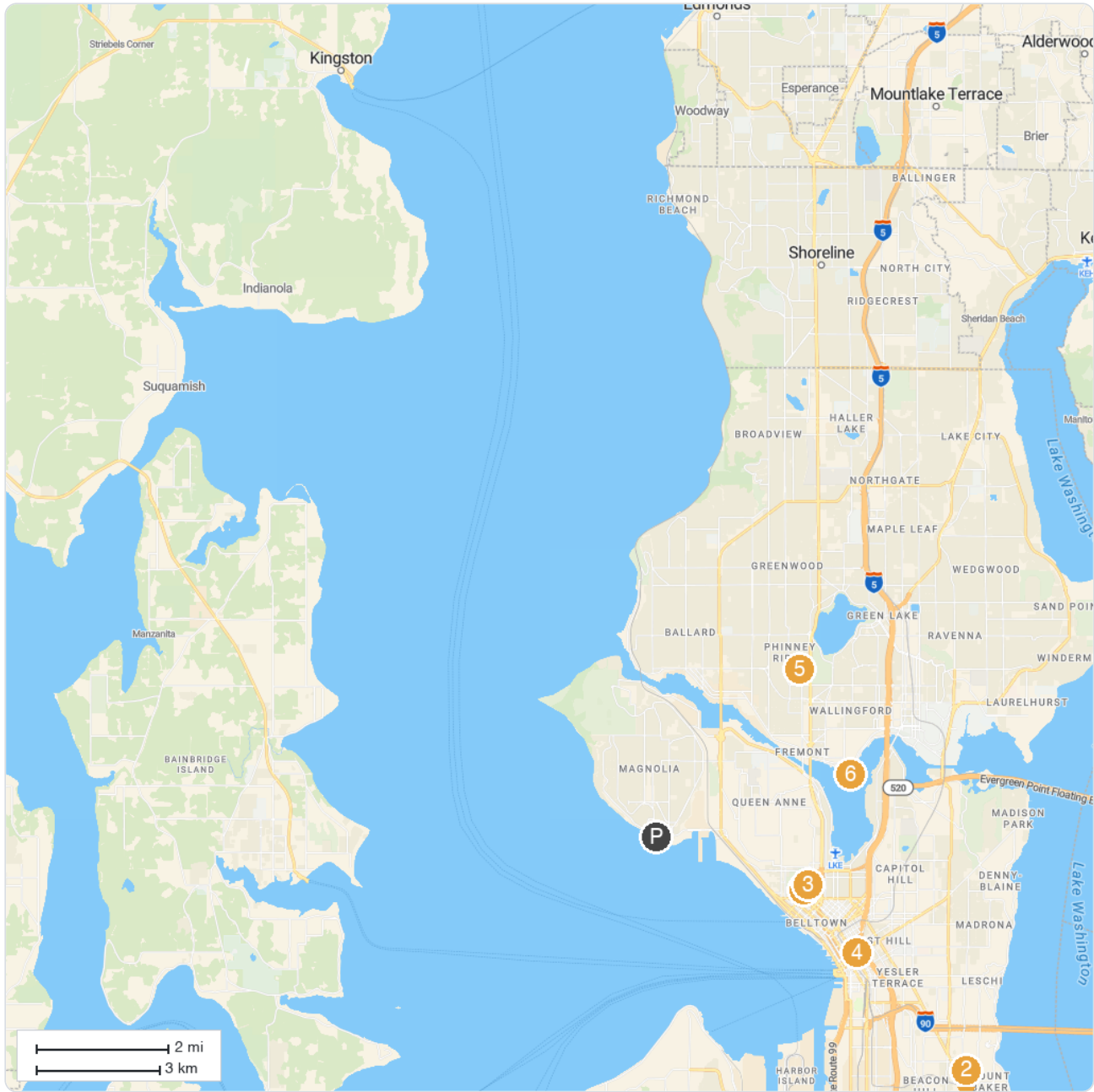
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
