GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Pier — Quai d'Alger or Quai du Maroc for most ships; Epi Dellon dolphin berth (tender shuttle) for mega-ships

Best For: Authentic French markets, seafood, canal walks, day trip to Montpellier or Carcassonne

Walk to center: 5–10 min from Quai d'Alger to Canal Royal

Don't Miss: La Tielle Sétoise (octopus pie) at Les Halles, panoramic views from Mont Saint-Clair

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Montpellier by Train — DIY Half-Day** — Catch a direct train from Gare de Sète (20 min, ~€6 return) to Montpellier's vibrant medieval old town.
- Carcassonne — Medieval Fortress City** — The double-walled UNESCO fortress of Carcassonne is ~90 min by car or train.
- Canal Royal & Old Town Walking Tour** — The heart of Sète on foot: the Canal Royal, La Pointe Courte fishing district, the Cimetière Marin with its sea views...
- Market & Culinary Tour — Tielle, Oysters & Picpoul** — Visit Les Halles de Sète (open to 1:30 PM) for warm tielle sétoise, fresh Bouzigues oysters from the Étang de Thau...
- Mont Saint-Clair Panorama** — At 183m, the top of Mont Saint-Clair delivers 360° views over the canals, the Mediterranean, the Étang de Thau lagoon...

BEST WALKS

- Canal Royal Loop** 1.5 km · 25 min · Easy · Free — From the cruise dock, walk along the quay to the Canal Royal.
- La Pointe Courte & Cimetière Marin** 3 km · 45 min · Easy–Moderate · Free — Head northeast from the canal to the La Pointe Courte fishing quarter — a labyrinth of tiny lanes, drying nets, and cats.

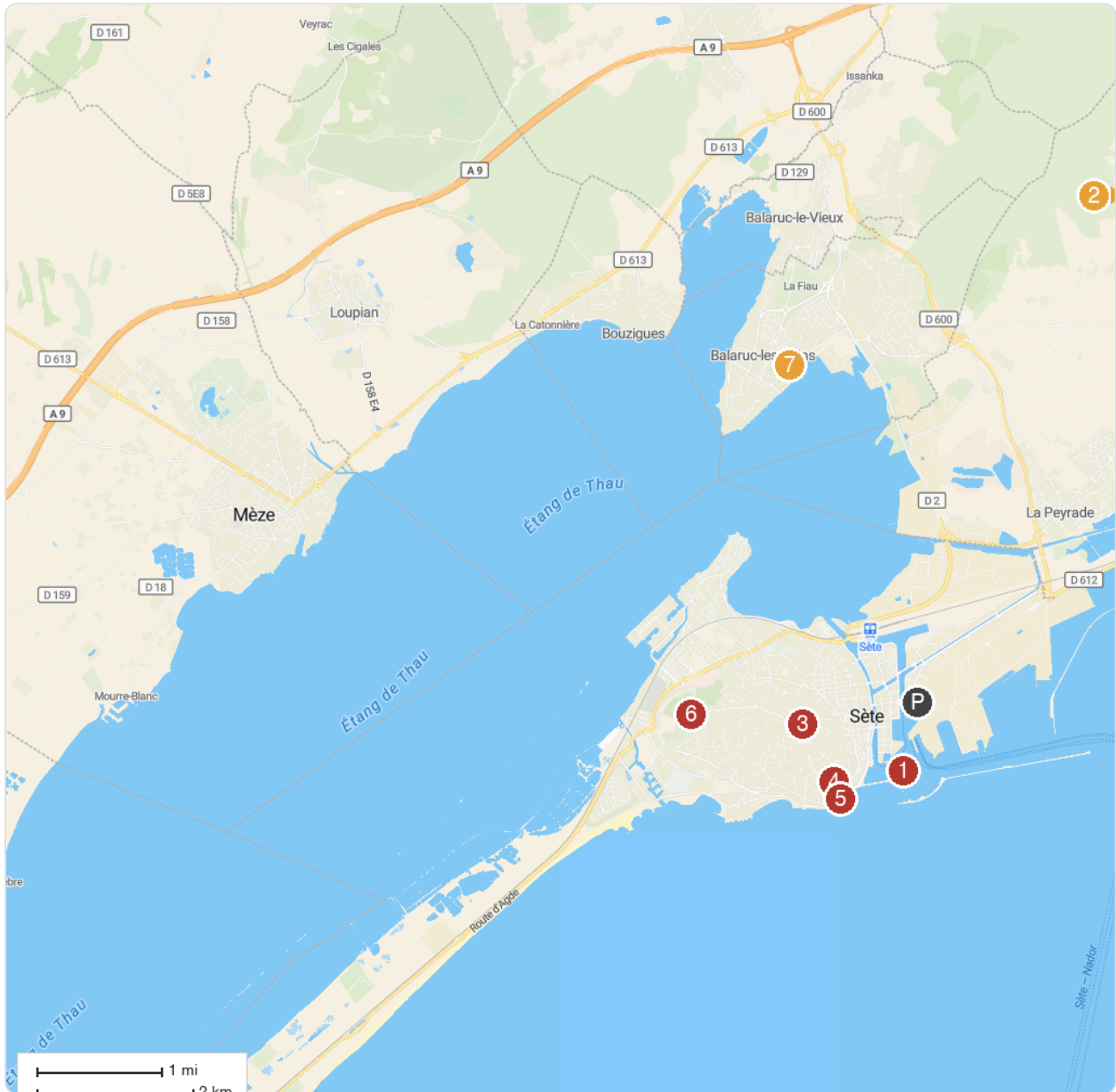
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
