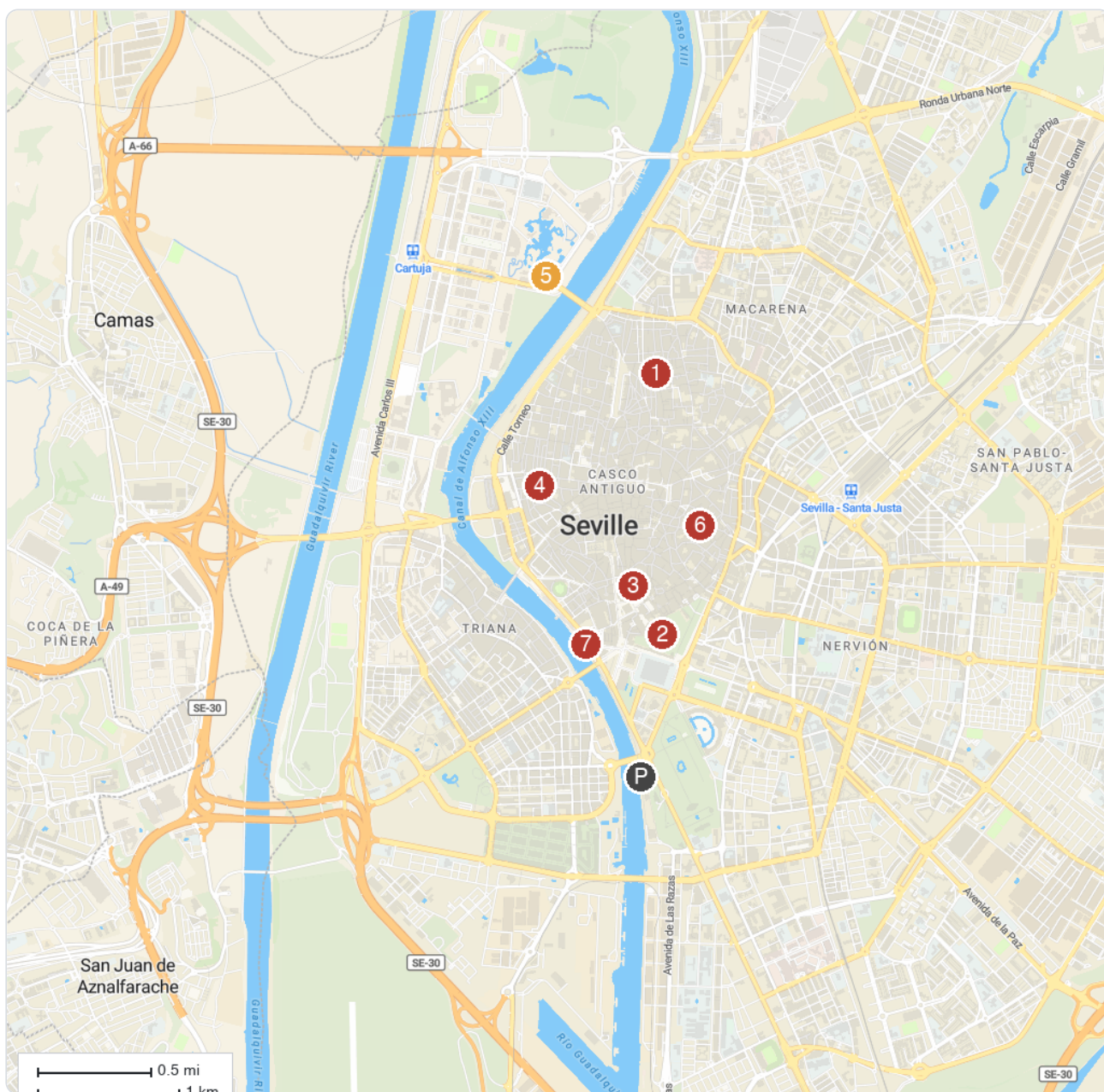
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Book the Alcázar in advance. Timed-entry tickets sell out days ahead, especially in spring and autumn. Buy online before your cruise or queue early.
- Summer heat is serious. June–September temperatures regularly top 38°C (100°F). Start early, carry water, wear a hat, and plan a midday break in the shade.
- Cash and card both work. Most Seville restaurants and shops accept cards. Some traditional tapas bars prefer cash — keep small bills for drinks and snacks.
