Docking: Wusongkou International Cruise Terminal, Baoshan — 25–30 km from city center

Best For: History, street food, contrasting architecture, day trips

Walk to center: Not walkable; taxi or ship shuttle ~45–60 min to The Bund

Don't Miss: The Bund waterfront promenade and Yu Garden bazaar

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **The Bund & Pudong Skyline** — Stroll the 1.5 km Bund promenade along the Huangpu River, soaking up the colonial-era banking facades opposite the...
- **Yu Garden & Old Town Bazaar** — Yu Garden (Yuyuan) is a 16th-century Ming Dynasty classical garden of rockeries, pavilions, and koi ponds.
- **French Concession & Tianzifang** — The former French Concession retains tree-lined avenues, 1930s villas, and art galleries.
- **Zhujiajiao Water Town Day Trip** — About 50 km southwest of Shanghai, Zhujiajiao is an 1,700-year-old canal town with 36 stone bridges, riverside...
- **Jade Buddha Temple** — One of Shanghai's most celebrated Buddhist temples, housing two carved white jade Buddha statues brought from Myanmar...

BEST WALKS

- **The Bund to Yu Garden** 3–4 km | 1.5–2 hrs | Easy flat terrain — Start at the northern end of the Bund near Waibaidu Bridge, walk the full promenade south past the Peace Hotel and Customs House, then...
- **French Concession Stroll** 2–3 km | 1–1.5 hrs | Easy — Start at Fuxing Road Metro Station and wander west along Fuxing Middle Road past garden villas and plane trees.

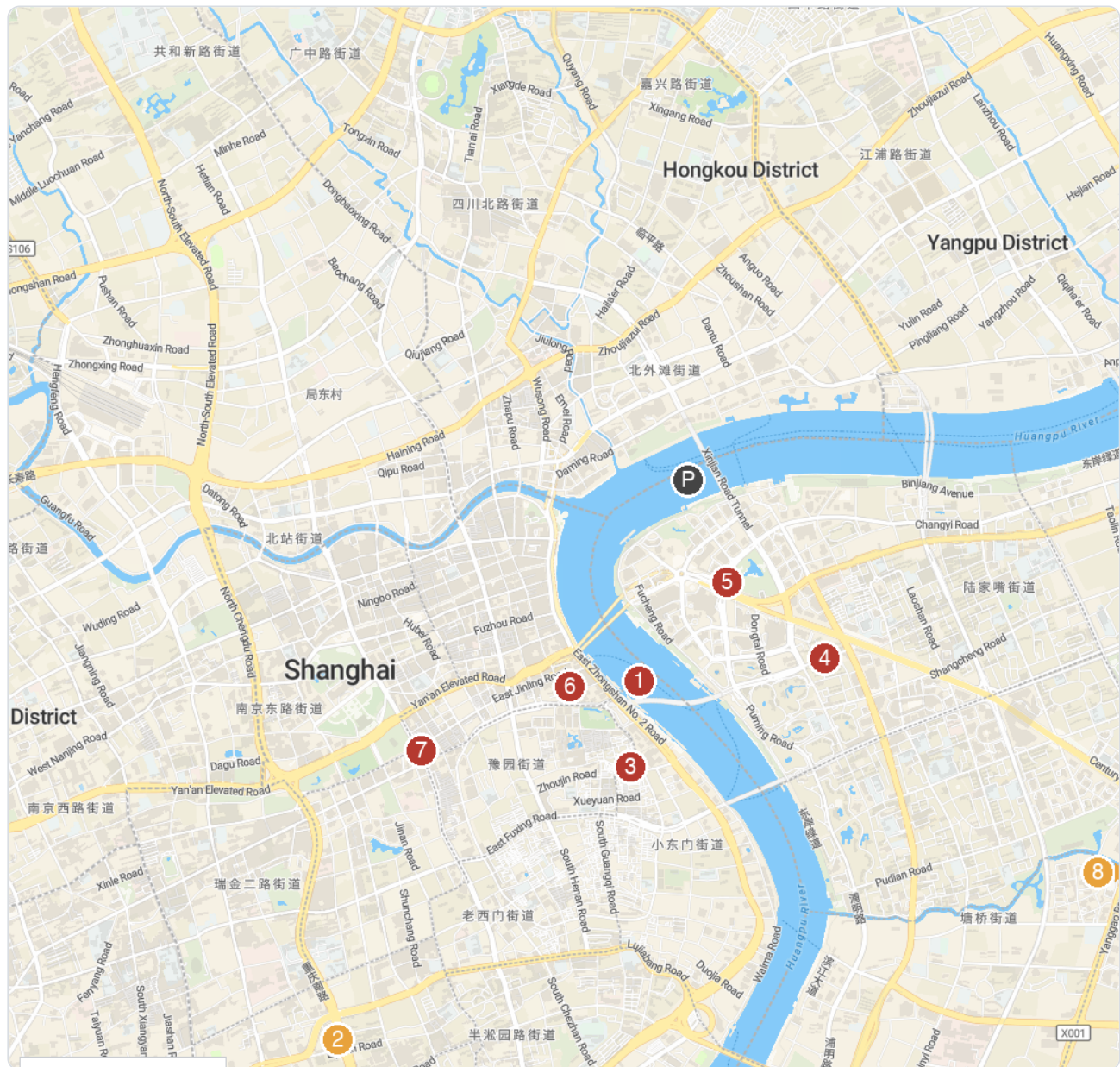
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- 1 Waitan** Historic waterfront promenade with colonial architecture and city views.
- 2 Tianzifang** Labyrinthine alleyways with art studios, cafes, and craft shops.
- 3 Yu Garden** Exquisite classical Chinese garden with pavilions, rockeries, and ponds.
- 4 Shanghai World Financial Center** Iconic skyscraper offering breathtaking city views from its observation deck.
- 5 Oriental Pearl TV Tower** Iconic TV tower with unique spheres and observation decks.
- 6** Modern skyscraper on the Bund with offices and a hotel.
- 7 Shanghai Museum** Grand museum showcasing ancient Chinese art and artifacts.
- 8 Century Square** Large public square in Pudong, often hosting events.
