GETTING ASHORE

Docking: River quay directly alongside Danube Park — no tender

Walk to center: 5–10 min (400 m) through the park to Freedom Square

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Roman Durostorum — Fortress Walls & Tomb** — Wander free through the excavated Roman fortress walls in Danube Park, then visit the 4th-century Roman Tomb with its...
- **Medzhidi Tabia Ottoman Fortress** — A hexagonal 19th-century Ottoman fort built 1841–1853, with 8-metre walls and a small military history museum inside.
- **Archaeological Museum** — The town-centre museum holds Roman armour, a detailed Durostorum fortress model, medieval artifacts, and finds from the...
- **Srebarna Nature Reserve (UNESCO)** — A freshwater lake 16–20 km west of Silistra, listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site and Ramsar wetland.
- **Danube Park & Ethnographic Museum Walk** — Stroll Bulgaria's oldest public park (est.

BEST WALKS

- **Danube Park to Freedom Square** 0.8 km · 15 min · Flat · Free — Step off the ship into Danube Park, pass the Roman fortress wall sections and early-Christian basilica ruins, then continue to the...
- **Town Centre Loop — Museums & Market** 1.5 km · 25 min · Flat — From Freedom Square walk to the Archaeological Museum, continue past the Art Gallery (housed in a former Romanian military school)...
