- Sentosa Island: Universal Studios & Beaches** — Singapore's dedicated resort island — walk or cable car from HarbourFront.
- Singapore Zoo, River Wonders & Night Safari** — One of the world's finest zoo complexes: open-concept enclosures, giant pandas at River Wonders, and the Night Safari...

BEST WALKS

- Marina Bay Waterfront Loop** ~4 km · 2 hrs · easy (mostly covered walkways) — Singapore's showpiece walk: Merlion Park, the Esplanade Theatres on the Bay, the ArtScience Museum, Marina Bay Sands boardwalk, and...
- Chinatown to Kampong Glam Heritage Walk** ~3.5 km · 2 hrs · easy — From the colourful shophouses of Chinatown (Sri Mariamman Temple, Maxwell Food Centre) north through the CBD and into Kampong Glam's...
- HarbourFront to Sentosa Boardwalk** ~1 km · 15 min · very easy (shaded, flat) — From the Singapore Cruise Centre at HarbourFront, walk the pedestrian boardwalk straight onto Sentosa Island — no shuttle or cable car...

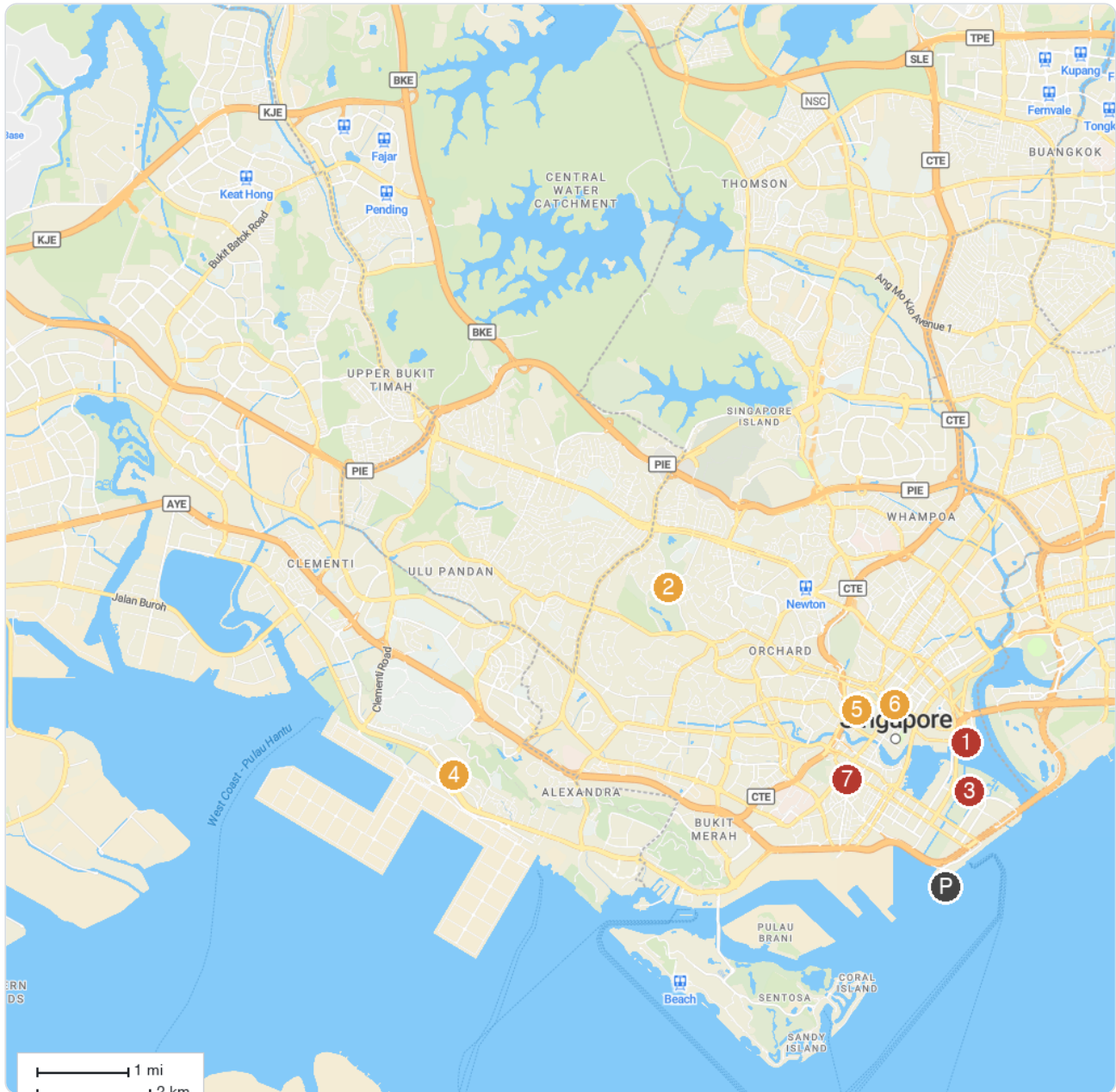
