GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Docked — cruise piers 9/10 in working harbour, ~1.6 km to town centre; free shuttle bus provided

Best For: Grenen two-seas spit, Skagen Painters museum, cycling to sand-buried church

Walk to Centre: ~20 min on foot from cruise quay, or take free shuttle

Don't Miss: Standing at Grenen where Skagerrak and Kattegat collide — unique in the world

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Grenen — Where Two Seas Meet** — Walk or ride the Sandormen tractor-wagon to Denmark's northernmost point where Skagerrak and Kattegat collide in a...
- Skagens Museum — The Skagen Painters** — Denmark's most celebrated artist colony descended on Skagen in the 1870s-1900s, captivated by its extraordinary...
- Den Tilsandede Kirke — The Sand-Buried Church** — A 14th-century church swallowed by migrating dunes — abandoned in 1795 when sand reached the windows.
- Råbjerg Mile — Northern Europe's Migrating Dune** — A vast inland sand dune up to 40 m high and 1 km wide that migrates ~15 m eastward every year.
- Anchers Hus & Drachmanns Hus** — Visit the preserved homes of the Skagen Painters' most famous residents — Anna and Michael Ancher's house with 250+...

BEST WALKS

- Town Centre Stroll** 1.5 km loop • Easy • ~30 min — Wander Skagen's distinctive yellow-painted houses, ducking into galleries and amber jewellery shops on the pedestrian street.
- Grenen Point Walk** 3 km from town • Easy on sand • ~45 min each way — Cycle or walk the coast path from town to the Grenen car park, then continue on foot (or by Sandormen tractor) to the very tip of...
- Buried Church & Lighthouse Loop (Bike)** ~10 km loop • Easy cycling • ~1.5 hrs — Classic Skagen cycling route.

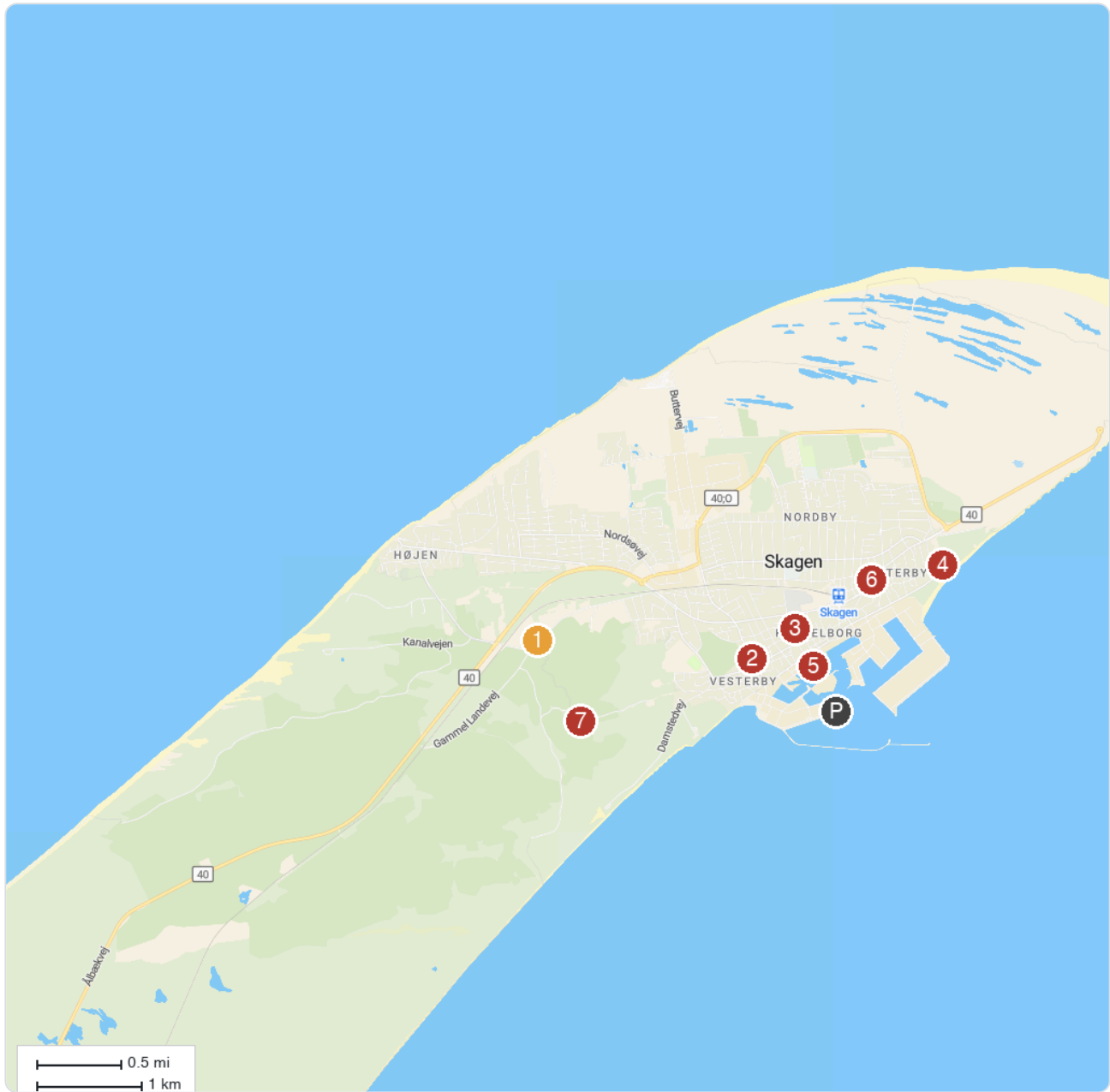
