Tucked into a sheltered bay at the foot of the Serra de Tramuntana, Port de Sóller trades on orange groves, a vintage tramway, and one of Mallorca's prettiest mountain towns — all within easy reach of the pier.

GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Cruise ships anchor in Port de Sóller bay and tender passengers ashore to the marina

Best For: History, mountain scenery, beaches, and local cuisine

Walk to centre: Port de Sóller seafront is steps from the tender landing; vintage tram to Sóller town (~15 min)

Don't Miss: The 1913 electric tram ride up to Sóller's market square

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Vintage Train Palma–Sóller Round Trip** — The wood-panelled 1912 train climbs through orange groves and mountain tunnels from Palma to Sóller station — one of...
- **Cap de Formentor & Lighthouse** — A guided full-day tour or taxi excursion to Mallorca's dramatic northern headland, roughly 80 km (about 1¼ hours' drive...
- **Sóller Market & Orange Grove Walk** — Sóller's weekly market (Saturdays) fills Plaça de la Constitució with local oranges, olive oil, and crafts.
- **Serra de Tramuntana Hiking** — The UNESCO-listed mountain range rises steeply behind the port.
- **Fornalutx & Biniaraix Villages** — Often ranked among Spain's most beautiful villages, Fornalutx is a 15-minute taxi ride from Sóller.

BEST WALKS

- **Port de Sóller Seafront Loop** 2 km · 30–40 min · flat · no shade midday — Walk the promenade from the cruise pier along the bay to the beach, past cafés and the naval museum (Museu de la Mar), and return...
- **Sóller Town Centre Walk** 1.5 km · 20–30 min · gentle slopes · historic centre — From Sóller tram station, stroll to Plaça de la Constitució to see the modernista church of Sant Bartomeu, the Can Prunera Museum of...

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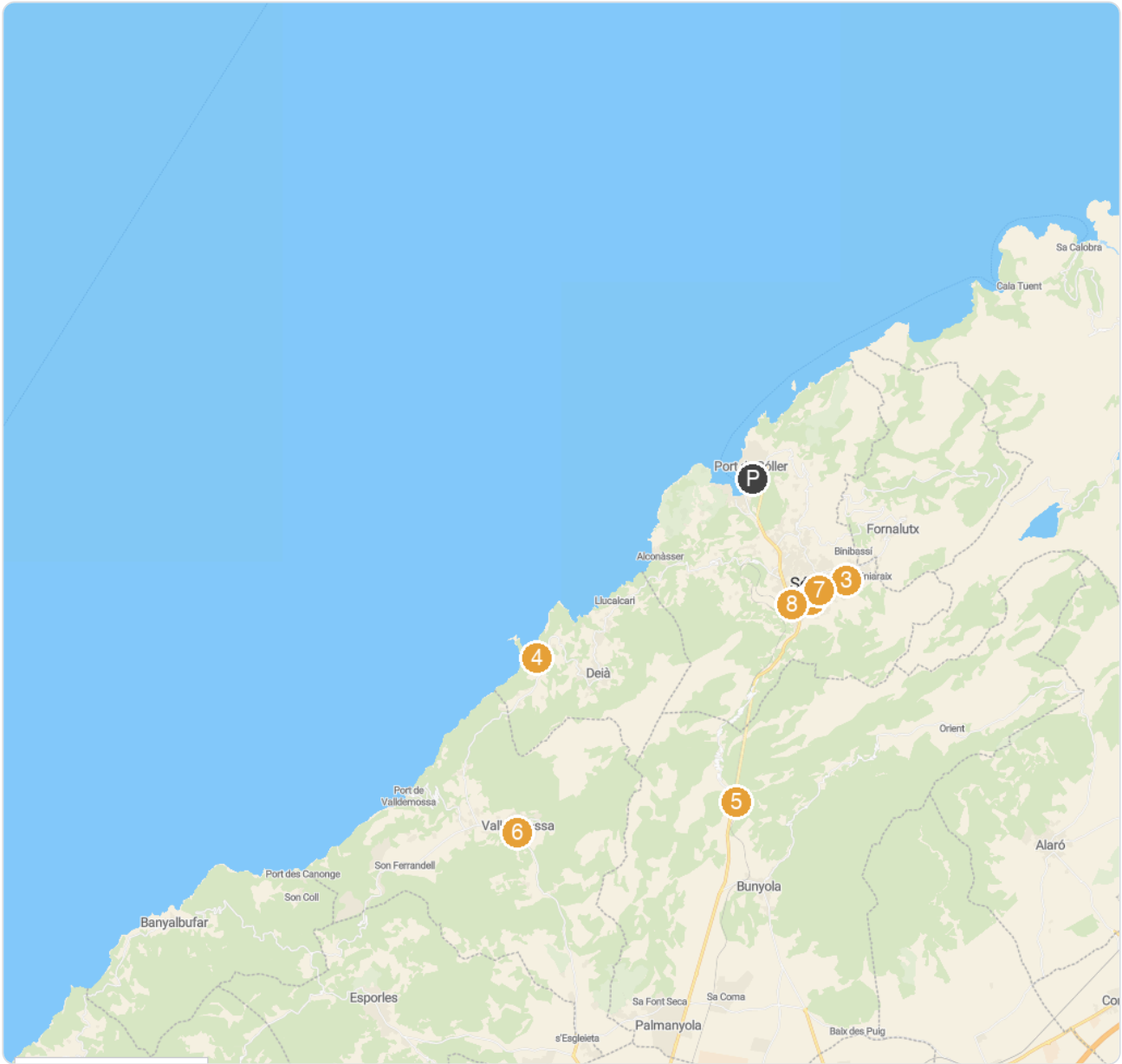
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Tram timing matters. The tram runs roughly every 30 minutes from Port de Sóller. If multiple ships are in port, the queue at the tram stop fills fast — head there soon after...
Bring euros in cash. Tram tickets (around €9 each way) are often paid onboard, and small vendors in Sóller market and some
