GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tender only — small/expedition ships anchor offshore; guests tender ashore to the beach

Best For: Snorkeling the barrier reef, diving, wildlife spotting, total relaxation

Walk to center: Island is walkable end-to-end in ~10 min; very little onshore infrastructure

Don't Miss: Reef snorkeling directly off the beach — the coral is minutes from shore

Getting around: **Rideshare** ❌ not available

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Snorkeling the Belize Barrier Reef** — The reef is minutes from shore.
- **Scuba Diving — Curlew Wall & Paradise** — Wall dives along the outer barrier reef drop into deep blue water.
- **Sea Turtle & Manatee Watch** — The South Water Caye Marine Reserve protects nesting hawksbill and loggerhead sea turtles, and is one of the last...
- **Man-O-War Caye Frigatebird Colony** — A short boat ride brings you to Man-O-War Caye, a protected nesting colony for magnificent frigatebirds and brown...
- **Beach Day at the Caye** — With calm, clear water, white sand, and a horizon of nothing but reef, South Water Caye is one of the best simple beach...

BEST WALKS

- **Island Perimeter Stroll** ~20 min | Flat sand | All abilities — Walk the full perimeter of South Water Caye along the beach.

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KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Bring your own snorkel gear. Mask, fins, and a rash guard are worth packing — reef entry is steps from the beach and gear rental can run short during busy calls.
- Reef-safe sunscreen only. The South Water Caye Marine Reserve bans oxybenzone and octinoxate sunscreens. Bring mineral (zinc oxide) sunscreen or buy it before the trip.
- USD is widely accepted, but the island has very limited commercial activity. Bring cash for any tips or fees — there are no ATMs on
