

Speightstown, St. Peter, Barbados

Known as 'Little Bristol' for its 17th-century trade links with England, Speightstown skipped the tourist-resort makeover and kept its soul — colonial jetty-houses, a brilliant interactive museum, and calm platinum-coast beaches all within a short stroll of the tender jetty.

- Arlington House Museum** — Three floors of immersive exhibits inside a restored 18th-century merchant's home trace Speightstown's days as a major...
- Barbados Wildlife Reserve** — Walk freely among free-roaming green monkeys, red-footed tortoises, pelicans, and deer in a mahogany forest.
- St. Nicholas Abbey & Steam Train** — One of the Western Hemisphere's oldest plantation houses — a stunning 350-year-old Jacobean manor with a working rum...
- Mullins Beach** — Active and lively platinum-coast beach with calm turquoise water, lounge chair rentals, watersports, and the Mullins...
- Bajan Lunch & Street Food Walk** — Speightstown is a foodie's secret — flying fish & cou-cou at Fisherman's Pub, gourmet pizza at The Orange Street...

BEST WALKS

- Town History Walk** 0.5 mi · 30-45 min · Easy — From the jetty, stroll Queen Street past the overhanging 'jetty-house' balconies and St.
- Esplanade to Heywoods Beach** 1 mi · 20-30 min · Easy — Walk north along the esplanade boardwalk, past the fish market and Port St.

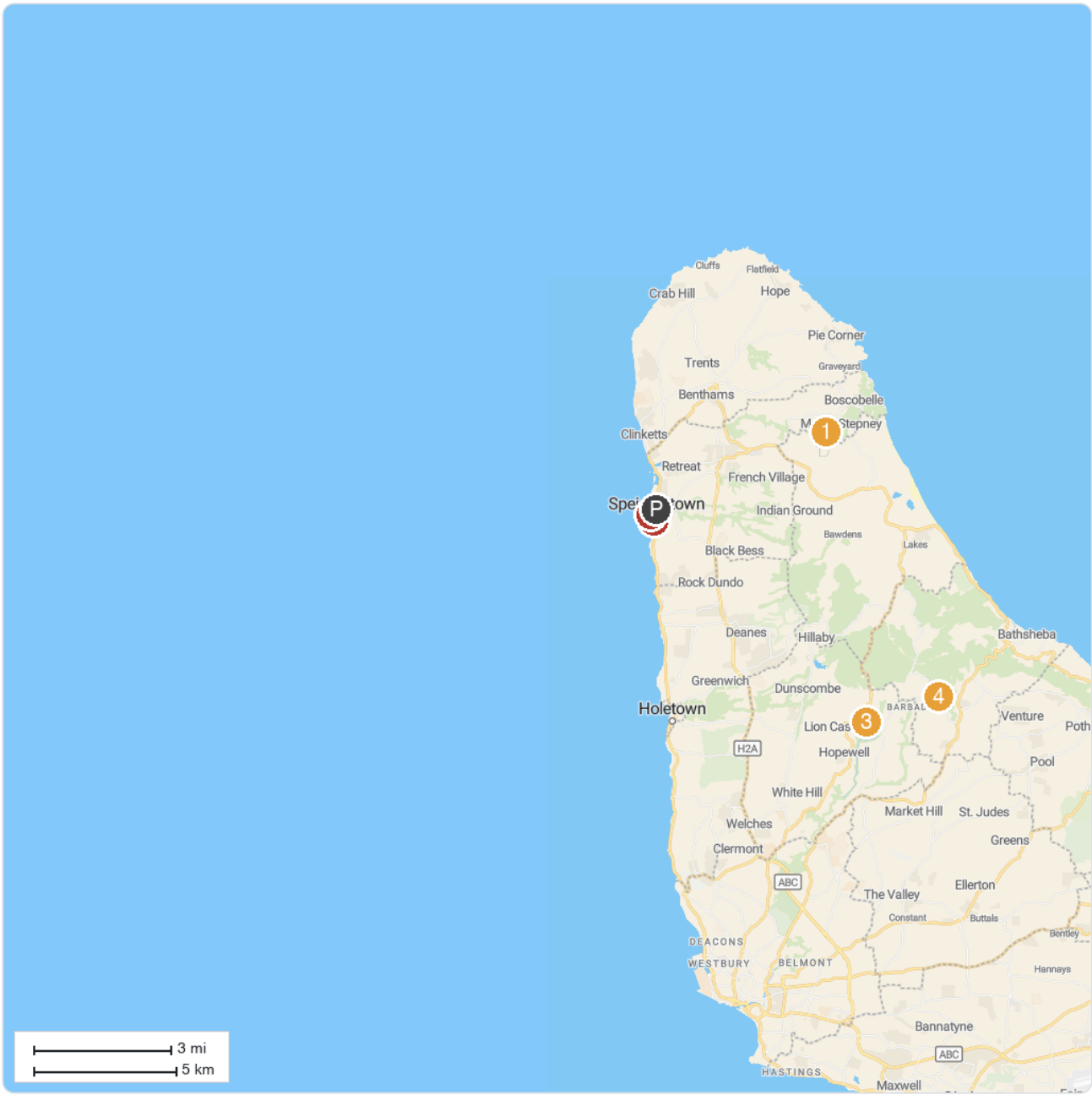
