

St Eustatius, Caribbean Netherlands

Tiny, tranquil, and loaded with history — Statia was once the 'Golden Rock' of the Atlantic trade and the first foreign territory to salute the American flag. Cruise ships anchor offshore and tender in to Lower Town, a short walk from Fort Oranje and a trove of 18th-century ruins.

GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tender — ships anchor in Oranje Bay; boats land at Lower Town pier

Best For: History buffs, divers, hikers, and travelers seeking off-the-beaten-path Caribbean

Walk to center: Lower Town pier to Fort Oranje (Upper Town): ~10-min uphill walk

Don't Miss: Fort Oranje, Honen Dalim Synagogue ruins, The Quill volcano hike

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Fort Oranje & Historical Museum** — Built in 1636, Fort Oranje overlooks Oranje Bay with a row of old cannons and a plaque commemorating the first foreign salute to the American flag...
- Honen Dalim Synagogue Ruins** — One of the oldest Jewish synagogue ruins in the Western Hemisphere (1738), located in Upper Town.
- The Quill Volcano Hike** — A 2,000-foot dormant volcano covered in lush rainforest — the crater interior shelters rare bird species including the red-necked pigeon.
- Scuba Diving — St Eustatius National Marine Park** — The entire island is ringed by a protected marine park with pristine reefs, volcanic fissures, and historic shipwrecks down to 100 feet.
- Miriam C. Schmidt Botanical Garden** — A 52-acre garden on the Atlantic slope of The Quill, showcasing native flora and fauna with ranger-led tours available.

BEST WALKS

- Lower Town to Fort Oranje** 0.5 km · 10 min · Easy uphill — From the tender landing pier, follow the waterfront north past dive shops and the Old Gin House, then take the Bay Path (Slave Path) up the cliff to Upper Town.
- Upper Town History Loop** 1.5 km · 30-40 min · Easy — From Fort Oranje, walk Kerkweg to the Dutch Reformed Church ruins and cemetery, then continue to the Honen Dalim Synagogue ruins and Three Widows' Corner.

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Tender-only port:** No pier exists — all passengers tender. In rough swells, calls can be delayed or cancelled. Check conditions and don't book non-refundable excursions far from the pier.
- Sunday warning:** If your ship visits on a Sunday, Upper Town shops and the museum are typically closed. Waterfront restaurants and dive operators usually stay open for cruise passengers.
- Currency:** US Dollars are the official currency, accepted everywhere. ATMs are available in Upper Town near the square.
- The Quill hike:** Requires a trail tag (purchase at hotels or tourist board before heading out). Bring water and sturdy footwear — the crater path is steep and can be muddy.
- Divers:** Book your dive in advance — Golden Rock Dive Center and Scubaqua are both in Lower Town, steps from the tender pier. The marine park is world-class and rarely crowded.
- Beaches:** Oranje Bay Beach (calm, swimmable) is near Lower Town. Zeelandia Beach on the Atlantic side has dramatic surf but strong currents — not suitable for swimming.

Fort Oranje Clifftop Dutch fort dating to 1636, site of the 1776 'First Salute' to the American flag, with cannons and bay views.

Honen Dalim Synagogue Ruins Roofless 1739 yellow-brick synagogue, one of the oldest Jewish house-of-worship ruins in the Western Hemisphere.
