## TOP THINGS TO DO

- **UNESCO Old Town Walking Tour** — Wander King's Square, duck into St Peter's Church (oldest Anglican church in the Western Hemisphere), visit the...
  - **Tobacco Bay Beach** — A sheltered volcanic cove 20 minutes' walk from the pier — the best snorkeling in the St George area.
- **Fort St Catherine** — Bermuda's largest fort commands sweeping ocean views from the island's northeastern tip.
  - **Lili Bermuda Perfumery** — Free guided tour of the perfume studio in historic Stewart Hall, where local flowers — Easter lily, oleander, jasmine...
  - **Dunking Stool Reenactment** — On weekday middays in cruise season, the Town Crier stages a mock 18th-century trial in King's Square ending in a...

## BEST WALKS

- **Old Town Heritage Loop** 1.5 km · 45 min · Easy — From Ordnance Island, cross to King's Square, then wind up to St Peter's Church, through Somers Garden, up to the Unfinished Church...
- **Pier to Tobacco Bay** 1.8 km · 20 min · Moderate (hilly) — Head north along Coot Pond Road and Barry Road to reach Tobacco Bay — the most spectacular swimming spot near the old town.
- **Tobacco Bay to Fort St Catherine** 1.2 km · 15 min · Easy — Continue past Tobacco Bay along the coast path to Fort St Catherine Beach and the fort itself for dramatic ocean views.

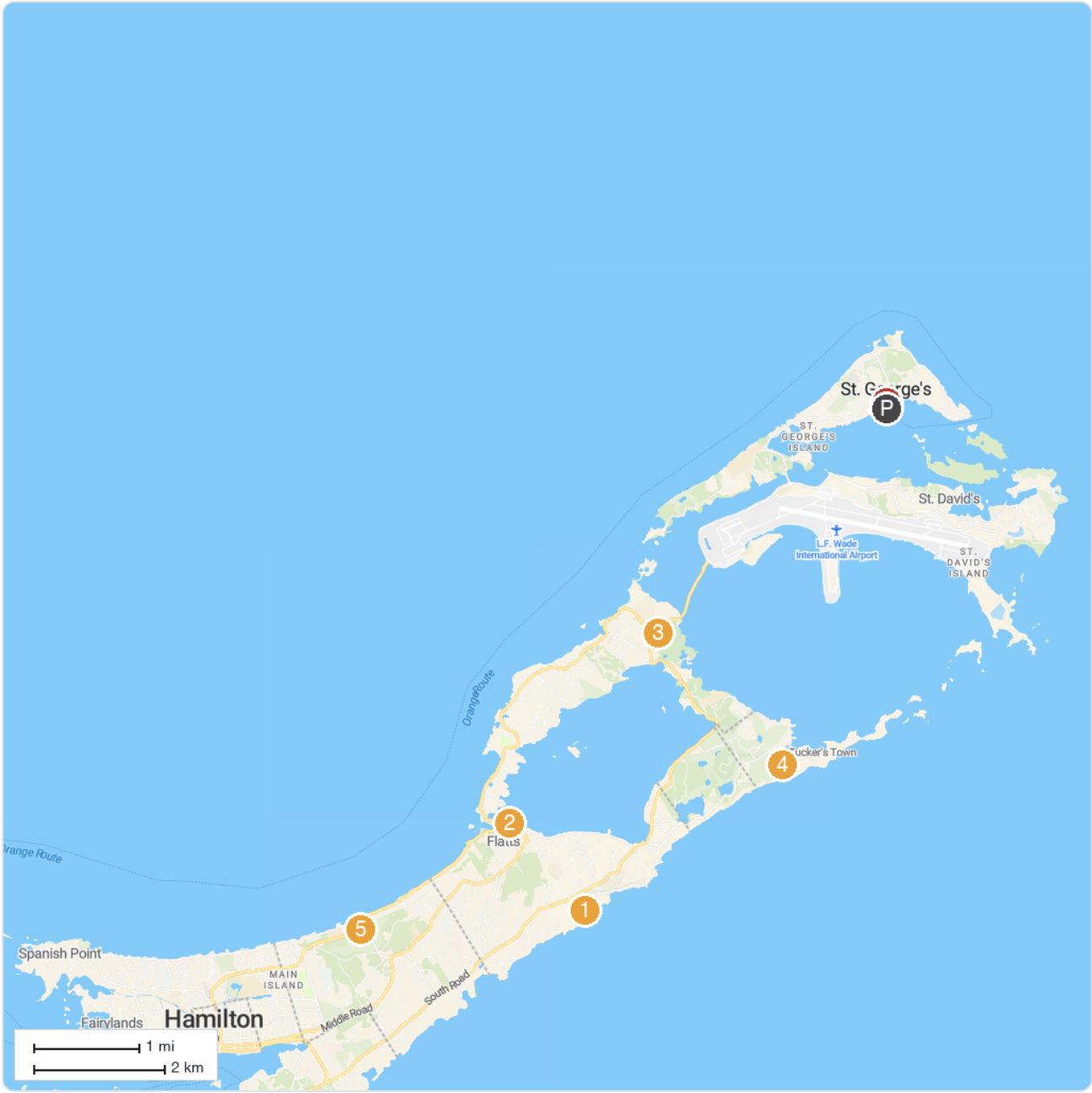
