TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Grand Anse Beach** — Two miles of powder-white sand and calm turquoise water, consistently ranked among the Caribbean's finest.
 - **Fort George Walk** — Built by the French between 1706 and 1710, Fort George tops the hill above the Carenage with sweeping views of the...
- **Grand Etang National Park** — A volcanic crater lake surrounded by lush rainforest about 35 minutes from port.
 - **Molinière Underwater Sculpture Park** — The world's first underwater art gallery, created by sculptor Jason deCaires Taylor.
 - **Spice Plantation & Market Tour** — Grenada is the world's second-largest nutmeg producer.

BEST WALKS

- **Carenage Waterfront & Market Square Loop** 1.5 km · 30-45 min · Easy — Walk from the Melville Street terminal through the Esplanade Mall to the Carenage waterfront promenade, then cut through Sendall...
- **Fort George Climb** 2 km round-trip · 45-60 min · Moderate (steep uphill) — From the Carenage, climb Church Street up to Fort George, a well-preserved French fort built in 1706 with cannons still in place and...

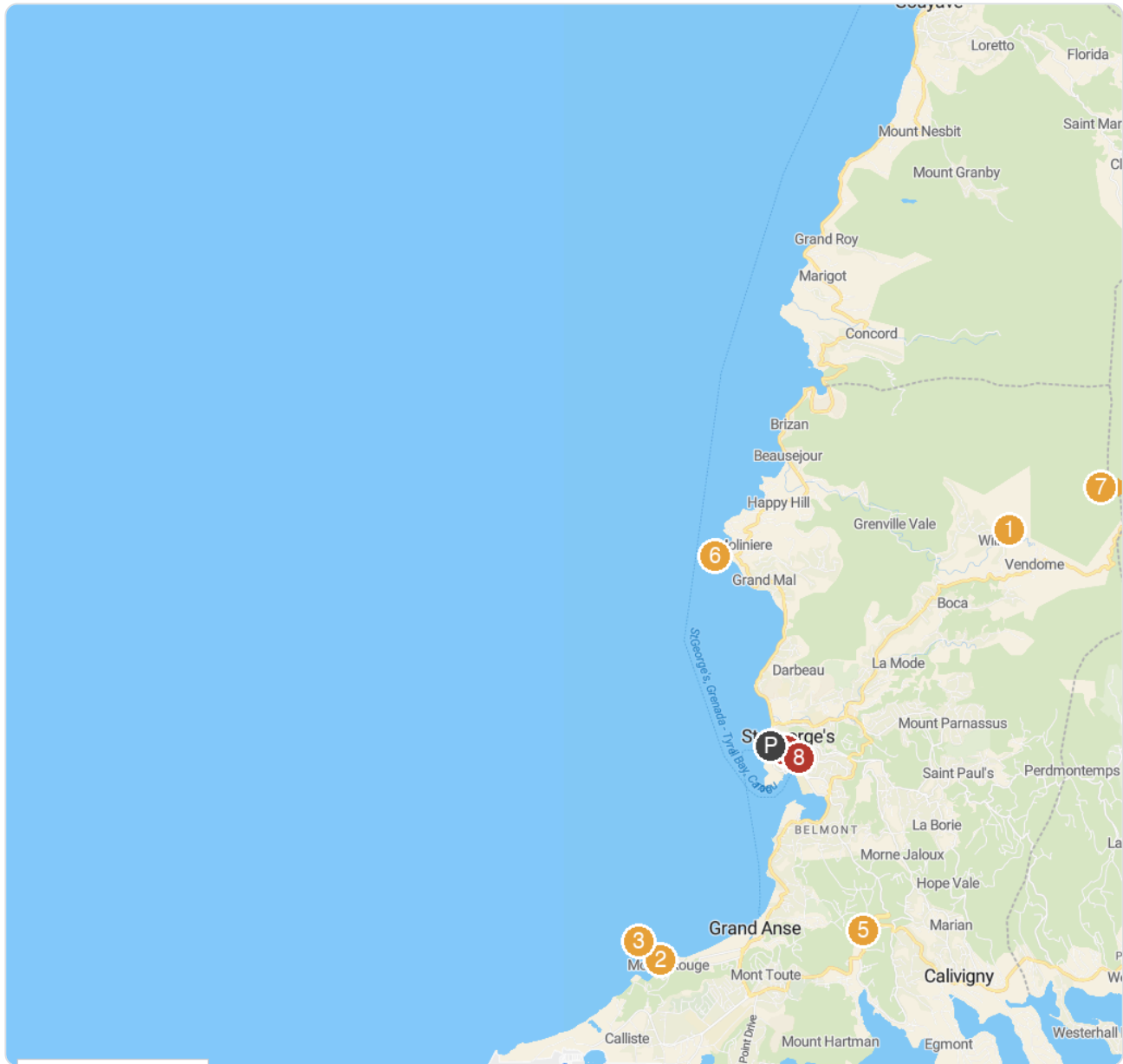
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Water taxis to Grand Anse are faster and cheaper than taxis (~\$8 each way) and depart regularly from the Carenage waterfront.
- Buy spices at Market Square, not the cruise terminal shops — prices are lower and you're buying direct from local vendors.
