- **Signal Hill & Cape Spear Tour** — Visit iconic Signal Hill, site of Marconi's first transatlantic wireless signal, then continue to Cape Spear, the...
- **Coastal Wildlife Boat Tour** — Head out on the Atlantic for chances to spot puffins, whales, and icebergs along the rugged coastline.
- **Jellybean Row Walk** — Stroll the vibrant downtown streets lined with colorful Victorian row houses and learn their unique history.
- **The Rooms Museum Visit** — Explore Newfoundland and Labrador's art, artifacts, and stories at this striking hilltop cultural complex.

BEST WALKS

- **Signal Hill Walk** Panoramic harbor and city views. — Climb from downtown to the historic signal station where the first transatlantic wireless message was received.
- **Waterfront Promenade** Easy harbor stroll. — Stroll the waterfront path past fishing boats, seafood spots, and local shops.
- **Jellybean Row Walk** Colorful houses and local charm. — Wander the steep, narrow streets lined with the city's signature painted row houses.
