GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Pier — ships dock directly at Chesapeake Bay Maritime Museum

Best For: Maritime history, Maryland seafood, boutique shopping, boat tours

Walk to center: 0.2 mi to Talbot Street (3-5 min flat walk)

Don't Miss: Hooper Strait Lighthouse climb + steamed blue crabs at The Crab Claw

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Chesapeake Bay Maritime Museum** — Eighteen waterfront acres covering Chesapeake oystering, crabbing, and boatbuilding heritage.
- **Patriot River Cruise** — A 75-minute narrated cruise on the Miles River aboard a steamboat-style vessel, departing from the CBMM dock.
- **Skipjack Sail on Rebecca Ruark** — Sail a National Historic Landmark — an 1886 wooden oyster-dredging skipjack, one of the oldest still sailing on the Bay.
- **Maryland Blue Crab Experience** — Steamed crabs piled high with Old Bay seasoning — eaten with a wooden mallet at The Crab Claw's outdoor waterfront deck.
- **Historic Downtown Walking Tour** — Wander Talbot Street and side streets (Green Street, Mulberry Street) past Federal, Colonial, and Victorian homes many...

BEST WALKS

- **Dock to Downtown Loop** 1.2 miles | ~25 min | Easy | Flat brick sidewalks — From the CBMM marina, walk up Mill Street to Talbot Street (the main drag), past shops and restaurants to St.
- **Waterfront Nature Trail** 1.5 miles | ~30 min | Easy | Waterside path — St.

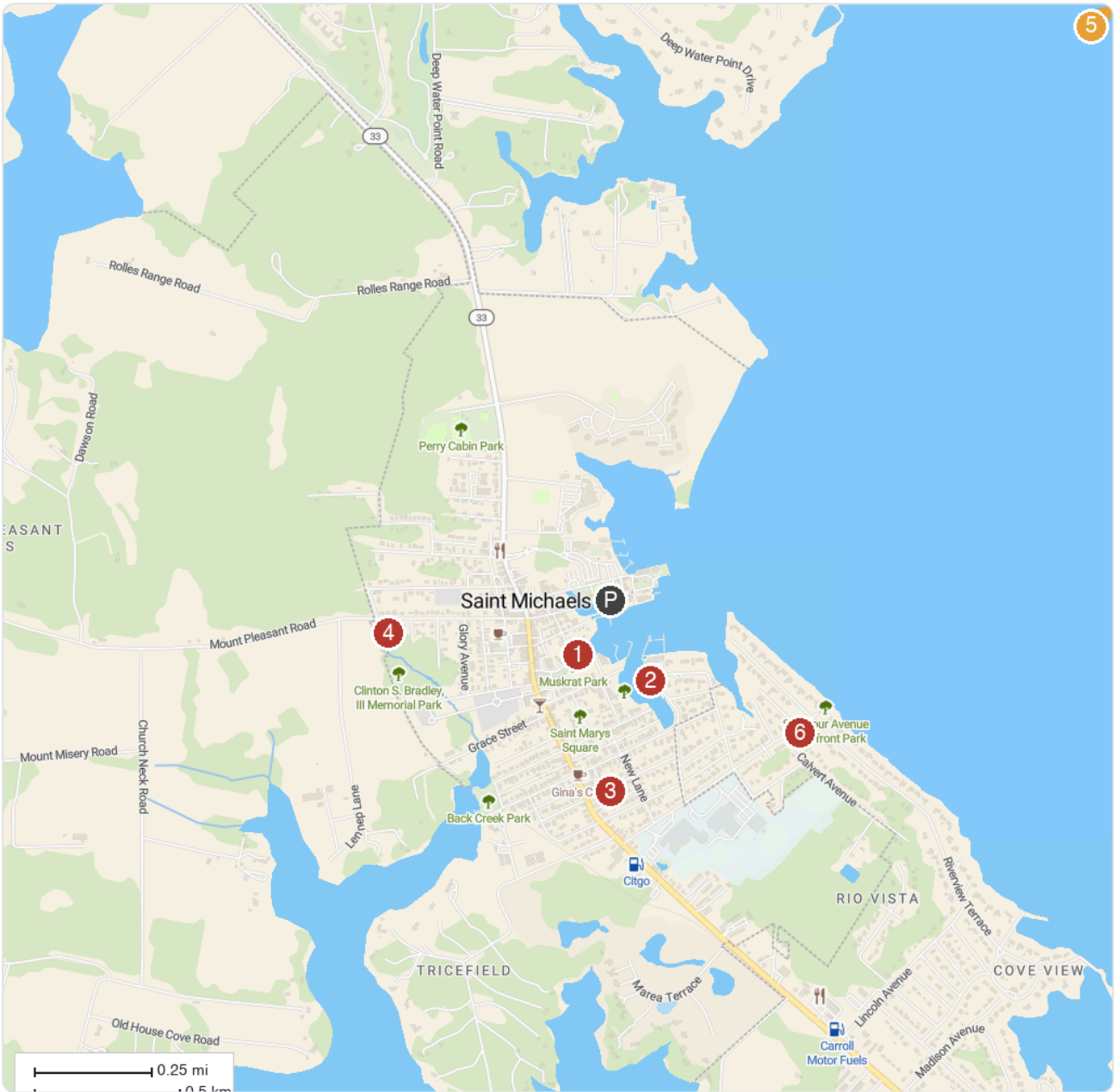
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Wear flat, comfortable shoes. Historic brick sidewalks are uneven in places. Skip the heels.
