GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Small ships dock at the Port of St. Petersburg quay near downtown Bayboro Harbor; within walking distance of the city core.

Best For: Art lovers (Dalí, Chihuly), waterfront strolls, Gulf beach day trips.

Walk to center: 5-15 min on foot to Beach Drive and St. Pete Pier from the Harborage/Municipal Marina area.

Don't Miss: The Salvador Dalí Museum — the largest Dalí collection outside of Europe, with stunning architecture.

Getting around: Taxi \$10–\$20 · Rideshare Uber, Lyft

- Salvador Dalí Museum** — The largest collection of Dalí's work outside Europe — over 2,000 pieces including major oil paintings — housed in a...
 - St. Pete Pier** — The reimagined 26-acre pier stretches into Tampa Bay with restaurants, a splash pad, Spa Beach, sweeping bay views, and...
 - Clearwater Beach Day Trip** — One of the US's top-rated beaches is just 40 minutes away.
- Egmont Key Catamaran Cruise** — A 4-hour catamaran excursion to Egmont Key — snorkel, explore the historic Fort Dade ruins and lighthouse, and watch...
 - Museum of Fine Arts & Waterfront Museum District** — Beach Drive clusters the Museum of Fine Arts (Monet, O'Keeffe, Wyeth), the Chihuly Collection, and the Morean Arts...

BEST WALKS

- Waterfront Museum District Loop** 2.5 miles · Easy · 60-90 min — From the pier area, walk south along Beach Drive past the Museum of Fine Arts, Vinoy Park, and the Chihuly Collection to the Dalí...
- Central Avenue Mural & Brewery Walk** 1 mile · Easy · 45-60 min — Stroll Central Avenue from 1st Street to 9th Street through the Central Arts District.

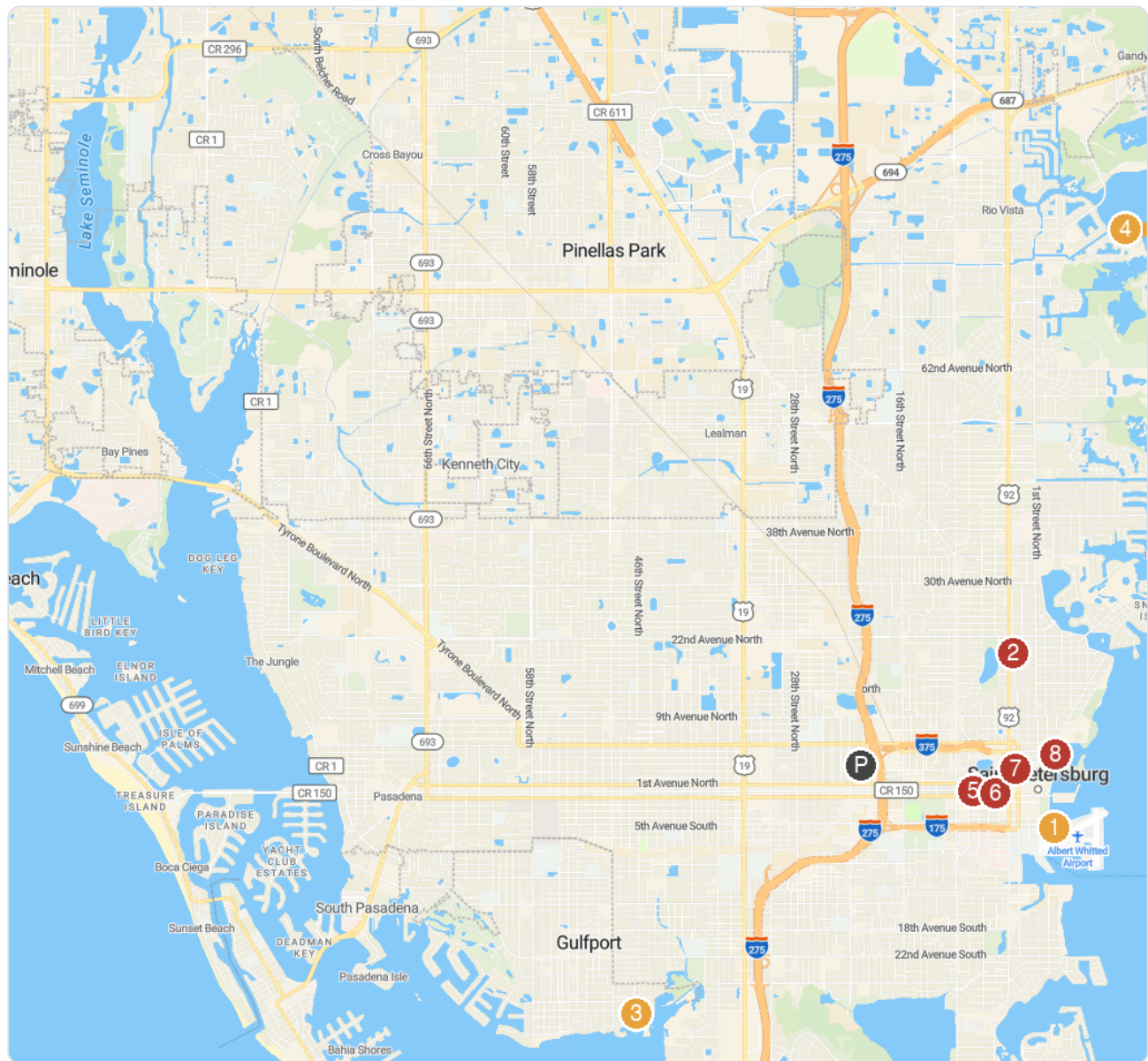
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
