

# Stavanger, Rogaland, Norway

One of Europe's most convenient cruise ports — dock steps from 18th-century white wooden cottages, then venture out to the dramatic fjord cliffs that define the Norwegian southwest coast.

## GETTING ASHORE

- Docking:** Pier — Strandkaien, Skagenkaien, or Konserthuskaien in Vågen harbor
- Walk to center:** 0–10 min — ships berth in the heart of the city
- Best For:** Old Town strolling, Lysefjord cruises, Pulpit Rock hike (full-day)
- Don't Miss:** Gamle Stavanger (Old Town) and the colorful Øvre Holmegate street

 Getting around:  **Taxi**  NOK 60–80 (~\$6–8) short trip ·  **Rideshare**  Uber, Bolt ·  **Hop-on hop-off**  Gray Line / HopOn Norway

## TOP THINGS TO DO

- Lysefjord Sightseeing Cruise** — Board a catamaran directly from the cruise harbor and sail into Lysefjord — past sheer cliff walls, Hengjanefossen...
- Pulpit Rock (Preikestolen) Hike** — Climb 604 m to the flat cliff plateau jutting over Lysefjord for one of Norway's great views.
- Gamle Stavanger (Old Town) Stroll** — Wander 173 white-painted 18th-century wooden cottages — northern Europe's largest surviving collection — along...
- Norwegian Petroleum Museum** — Interactive museum in a striking oil-platform-inspired building tracing how offshore oil transformed Norway from a...
- RIB Safari on Lysefjord** — Speed through the fjord on a rigid inflatable boat, close to cliff walls, waterfalls, and seabird colonies.

## BEST WALKS

- Old Town & Color Street Loop** 2–3 km • 1–1.5 hrs • Easy — From Strandkaien pier, walk two minutes to Gamle Stavanger and wander the white wooden cottage lanes.
- Harbor to Petroleum Museum** 1.5 km • 30 min • Easy — Head north along the Vågen waterfront from your ship, past the GeoPark (public art made from oil-industry hardware), to the Norwegian...

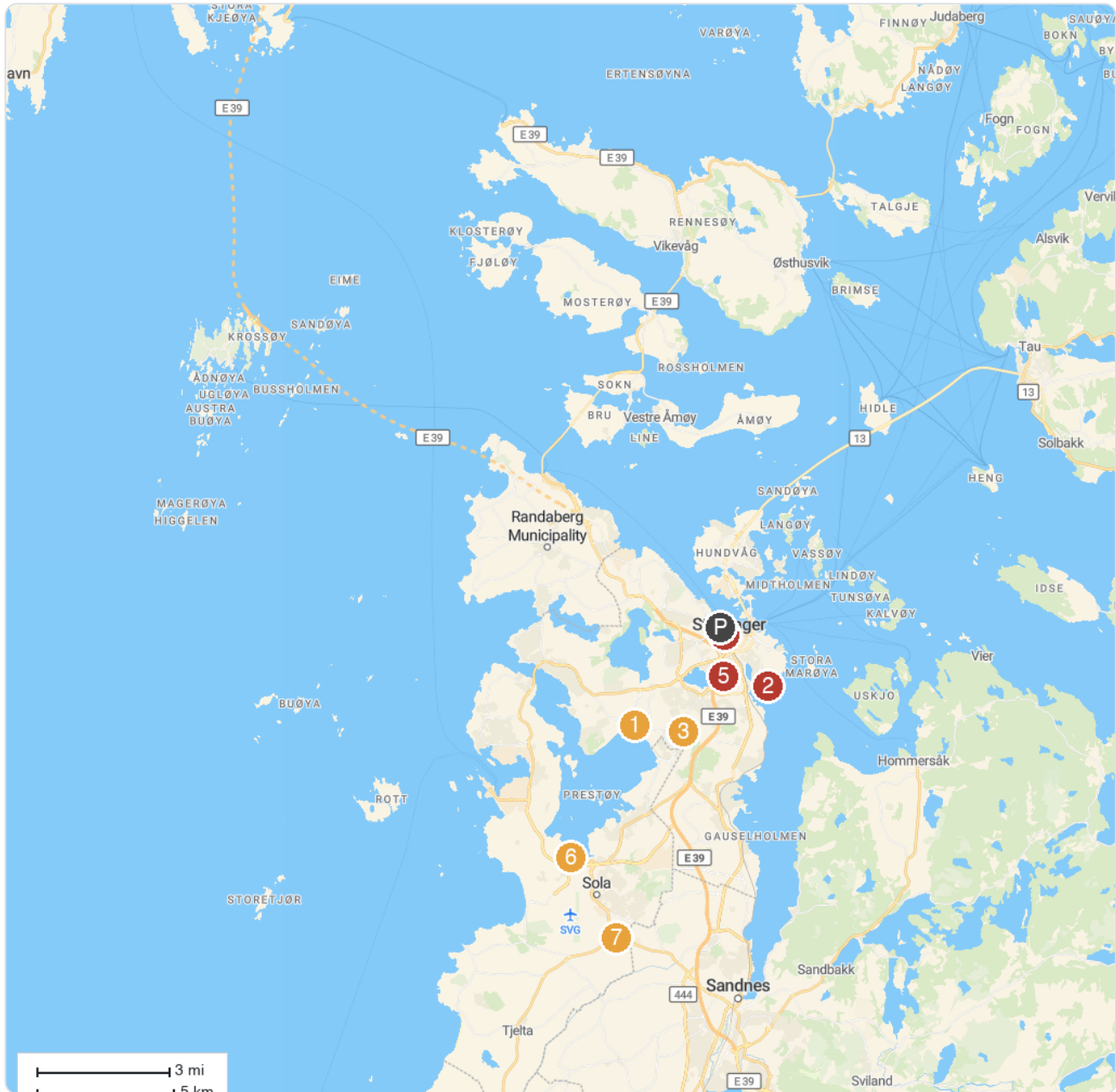
